About the 360 Report

The 360 Report is published quarterly to provide CYFD management, staff, and external partners with data on:

- Reports of child abuse and neglect
- Investigations of child abuse and neglect
- Substantiated cases
- Permanency plans for youth in custody
- Plans for reunifications
- Number of youth in foster care

These data can be used to inform New Mexicans of trends in a particular area and where support may be needed. Data can also indicate positive outcomes in an aspect of the system in a particular county or region. The 360 Report is a tool that can bring science to inform the prevention and treatment process.

About the Data

Data for the County Profiles is prepared through the collaborative efforts of the Data Evaluation Unit and FACTS Unit within the Research, Assessment, and Data Bureau and Information Technology Services, with the assistance and guidance of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration For Children and Families, Administration on Children, Youth and Families, Children's Bureau.

About Protective Services

Protective Services strives to enhance the safety, permanency and well-being of children and families in New Mexico.

Protective Services workers investigate reports of child maltreatment and intervene to keep New Mexico's children safe. We provide foster care to approximately 2,500 children each day and work with families to enable parents to safely care for their children. When that cannot be accomplished, Protective Services workers find safe, permanent families for children through adoption or permanent guardianship.

Protective Services also works with youth emancipating from the foster care system to assist them in successfully transitioning into adulthood.

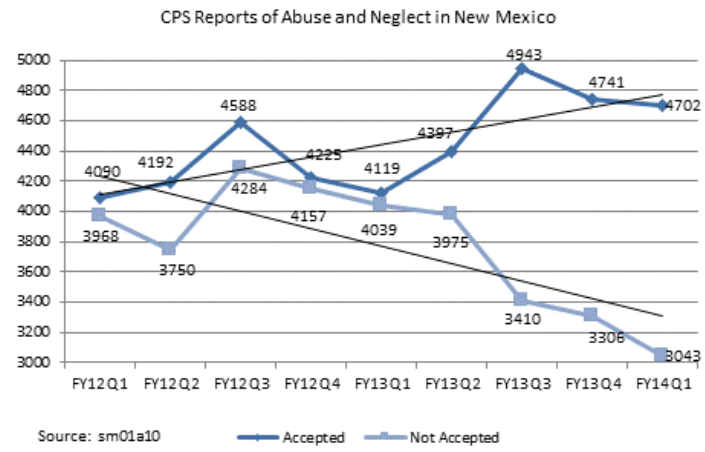

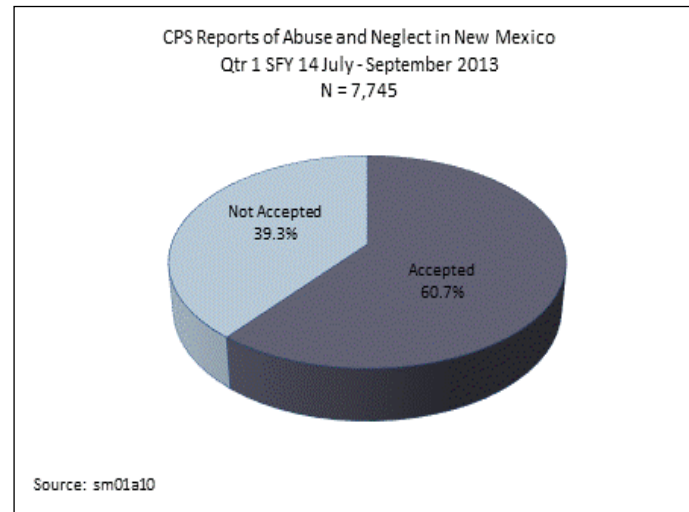

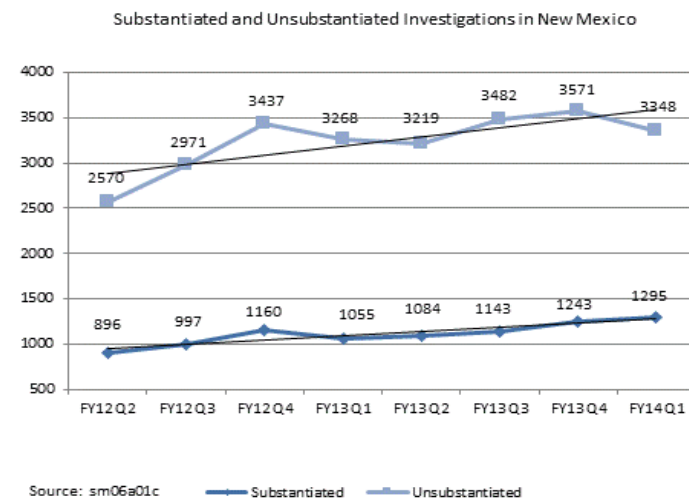

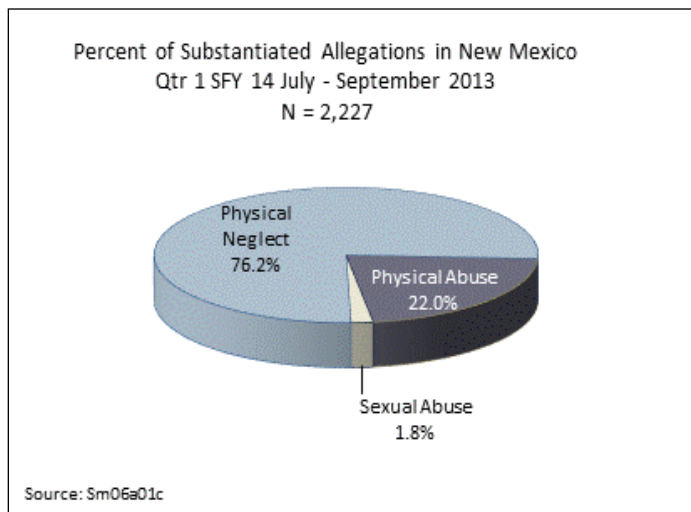

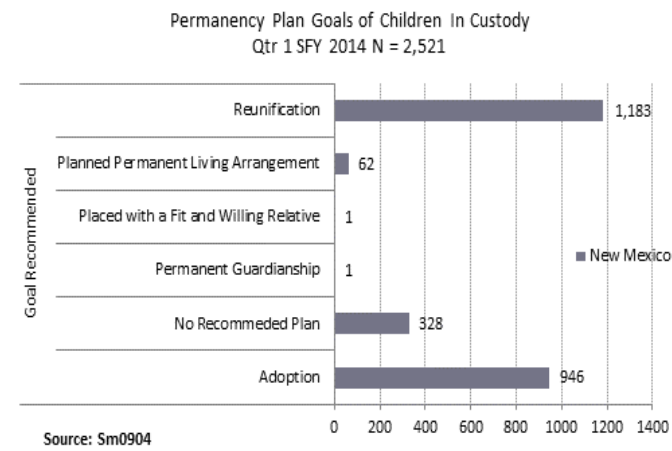
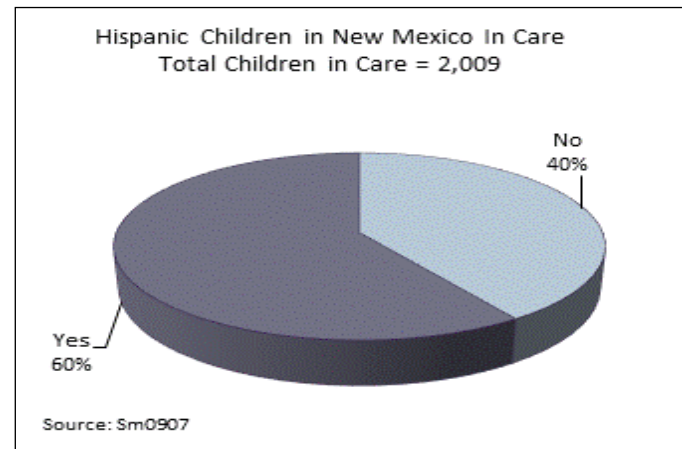
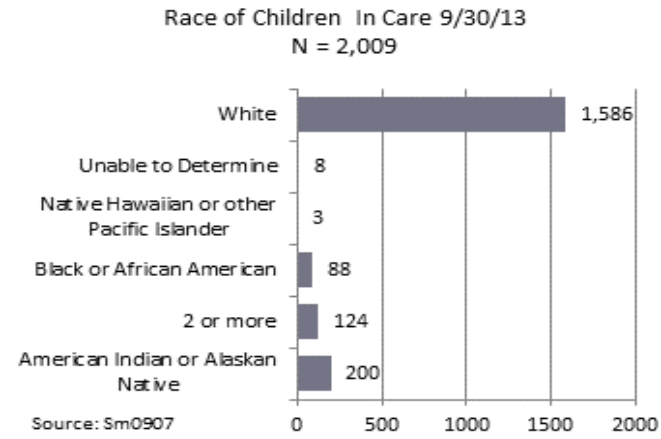

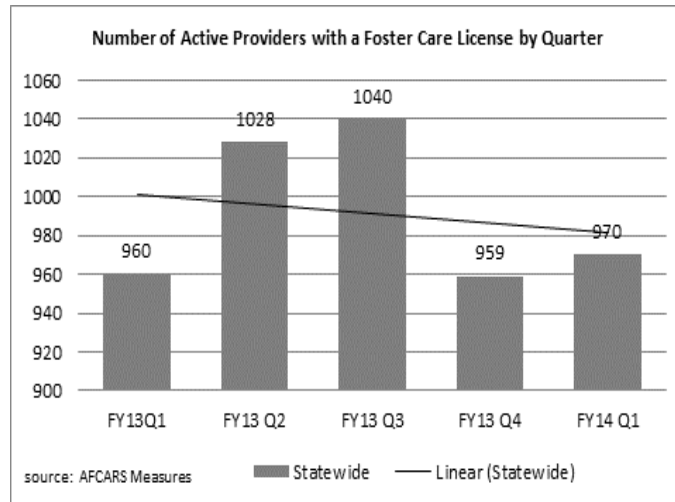

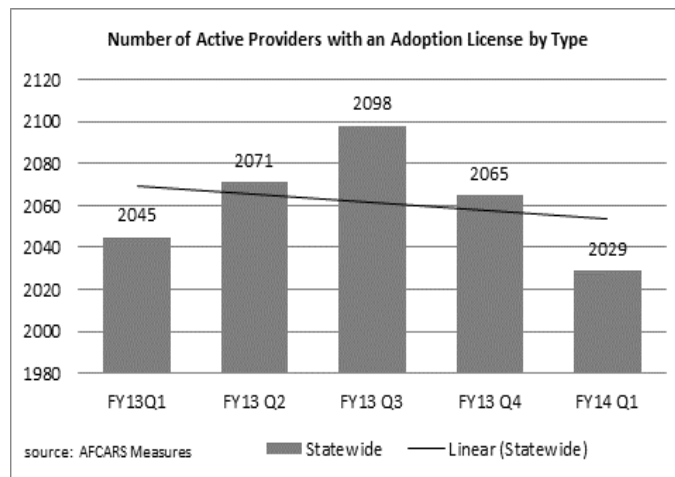

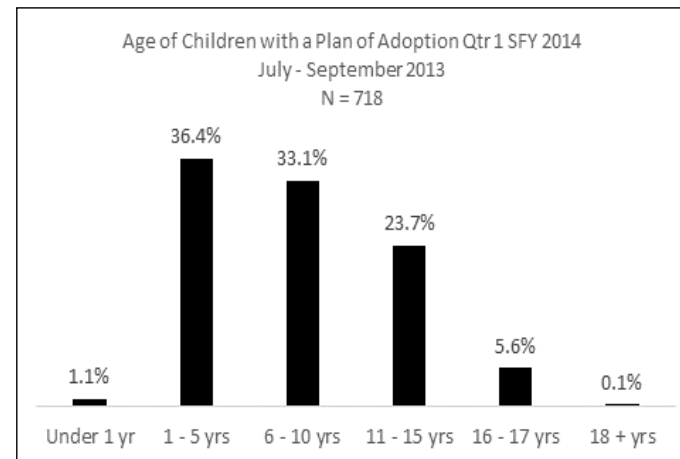

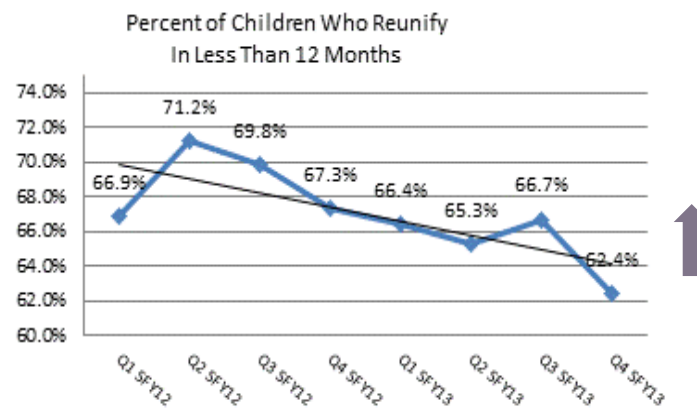

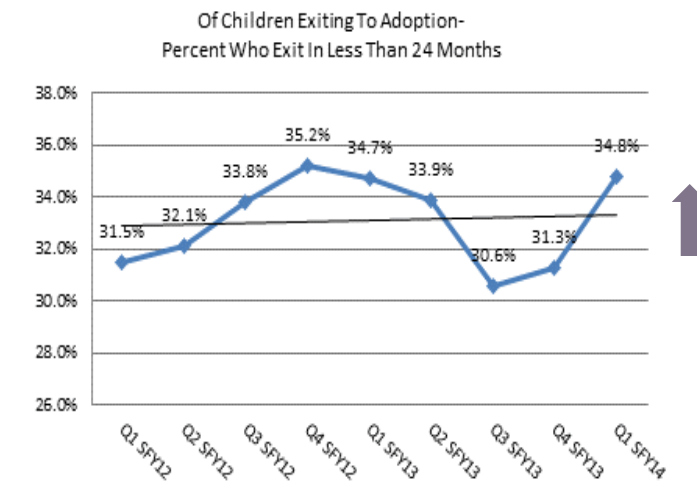

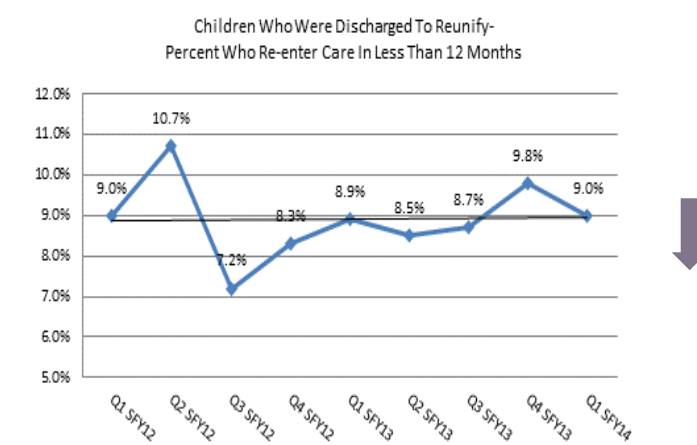

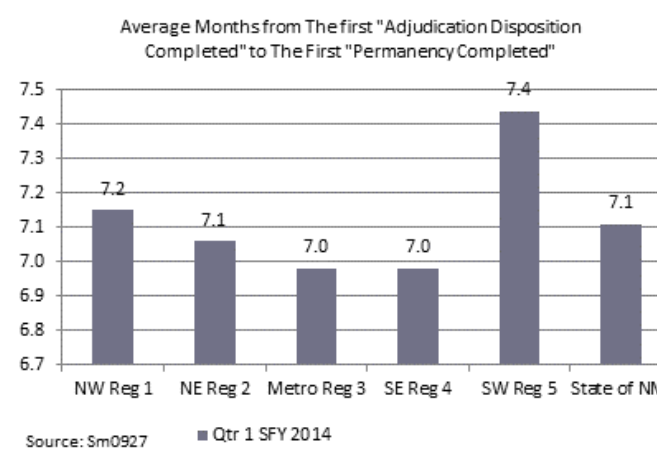
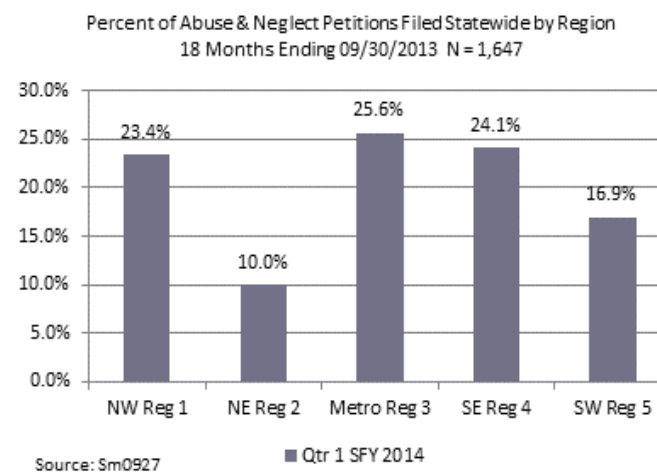
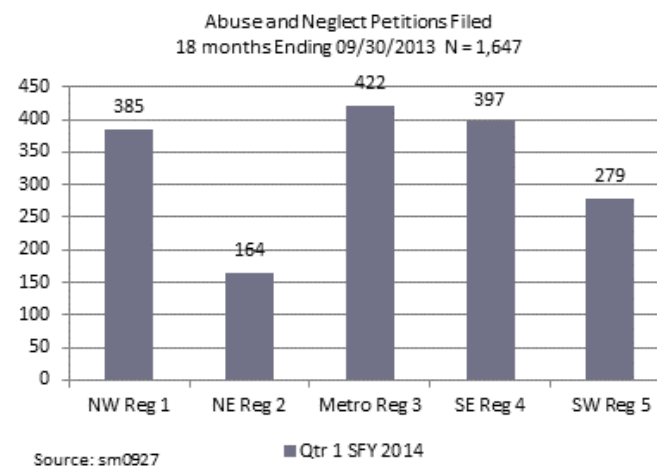

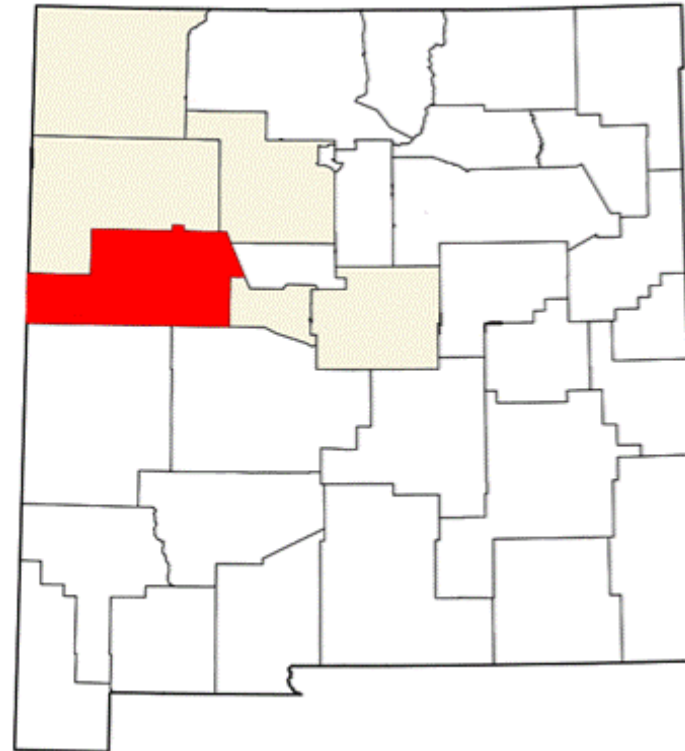

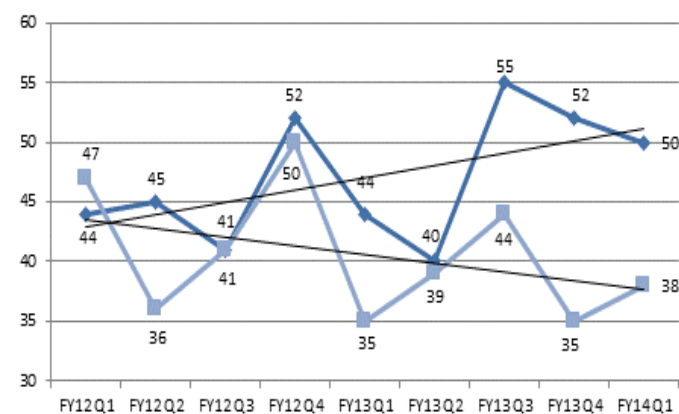

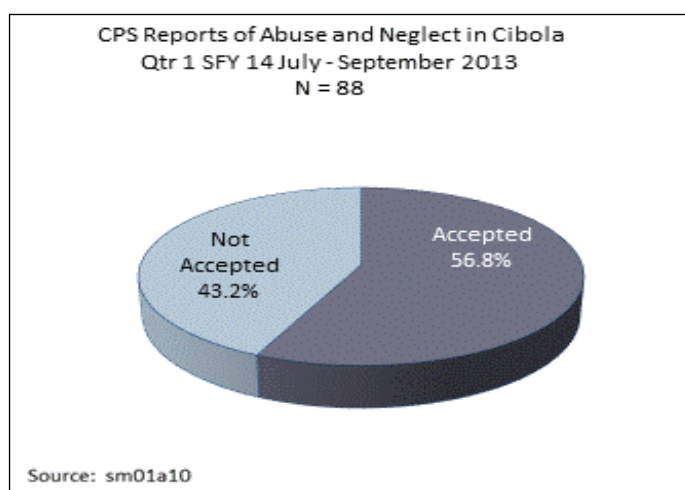

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Cibola County

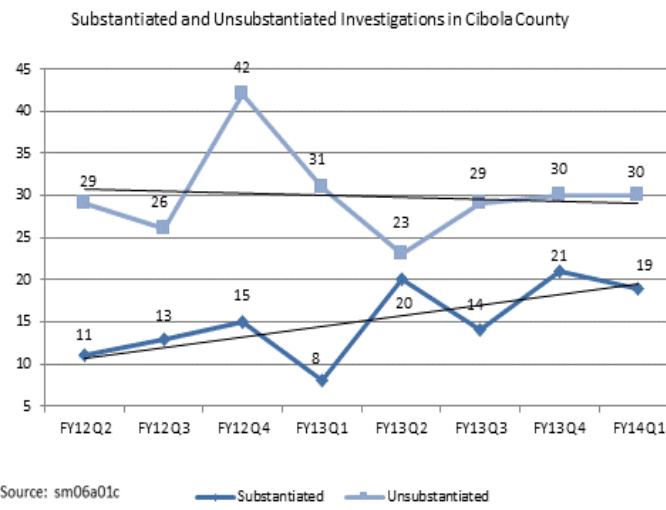

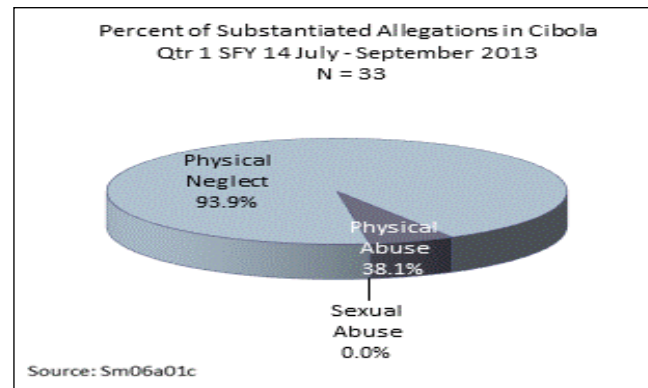

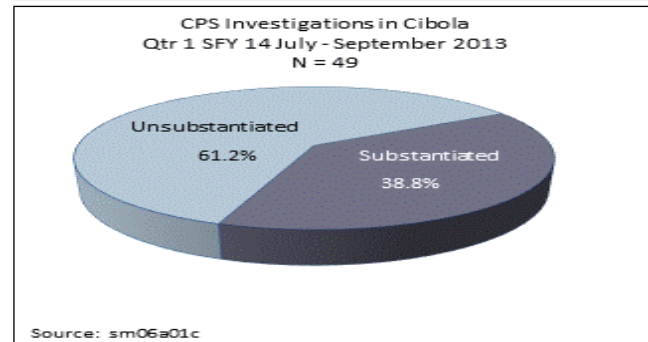

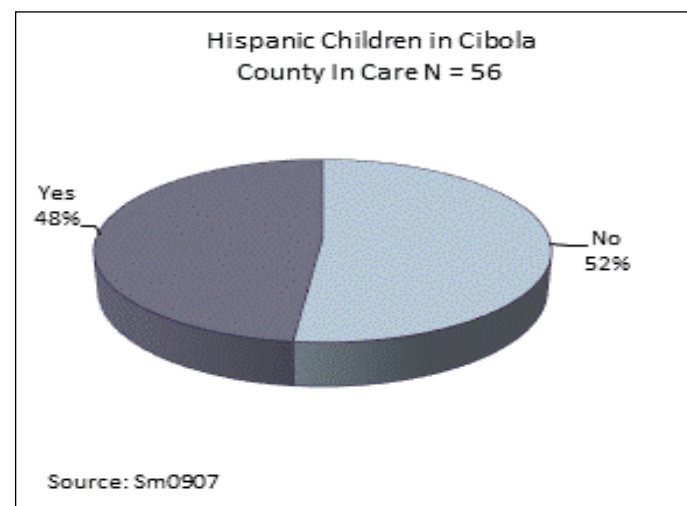

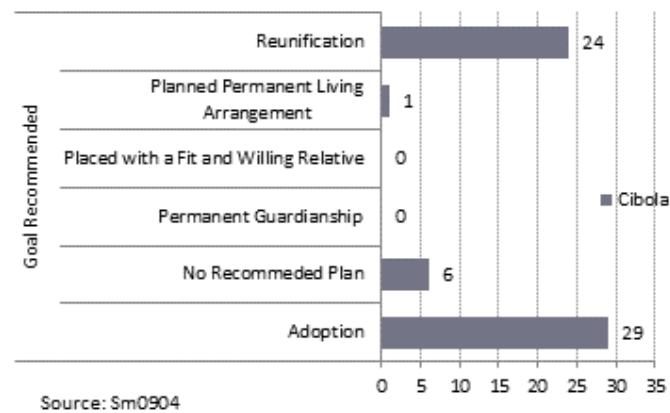

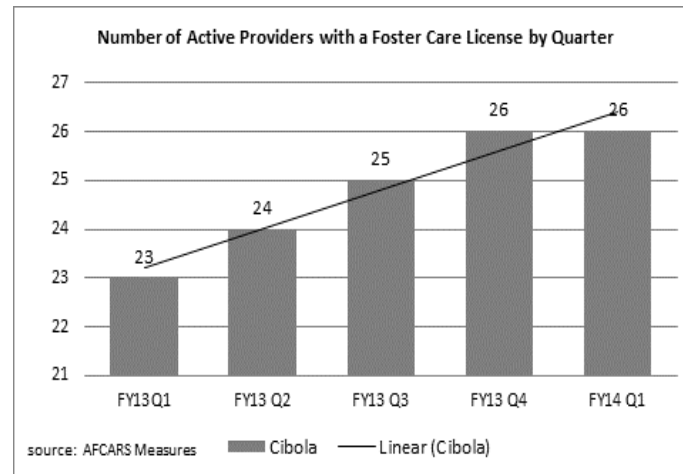
Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody
Qtr 1 SFY 2014



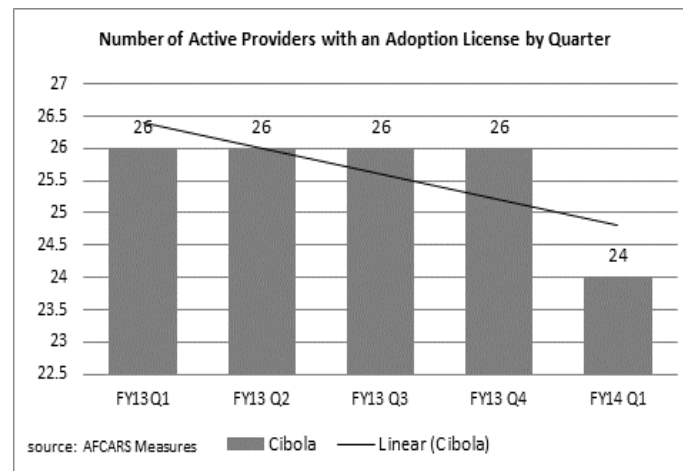

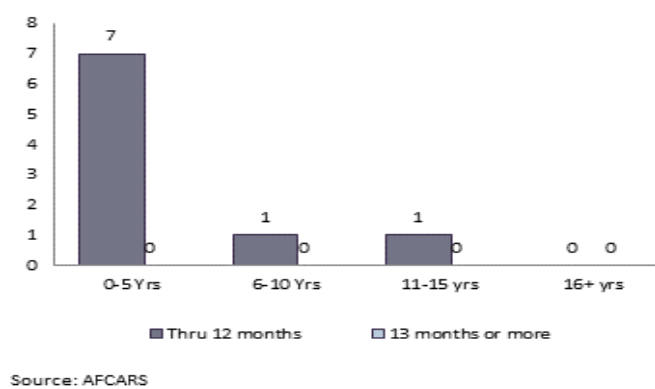

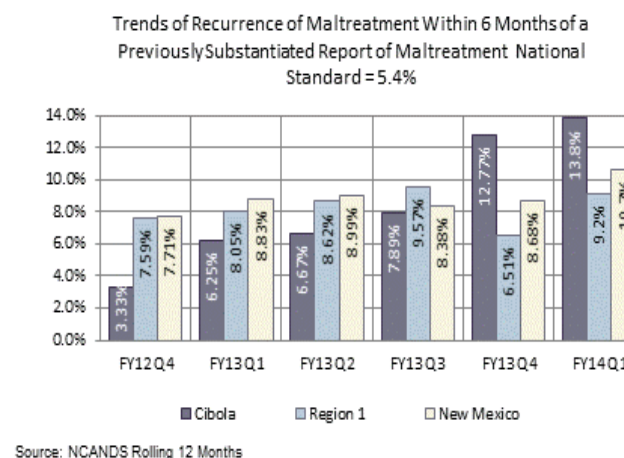

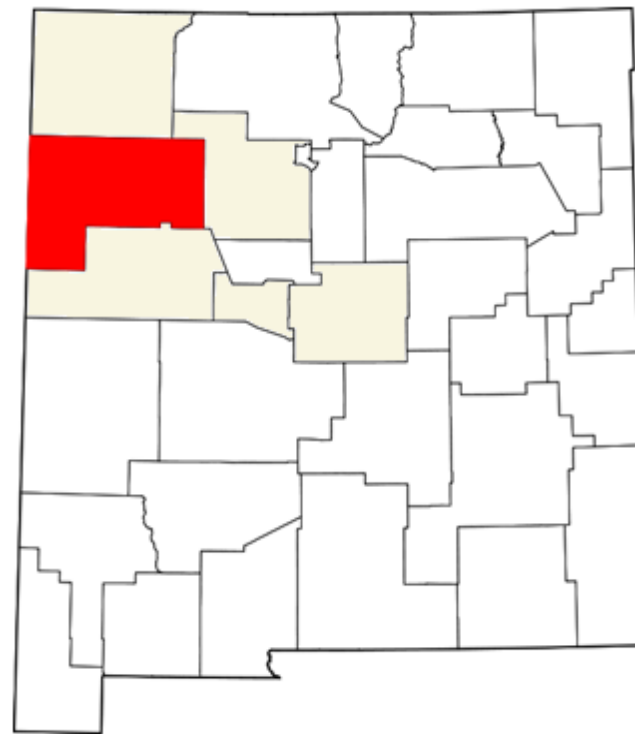

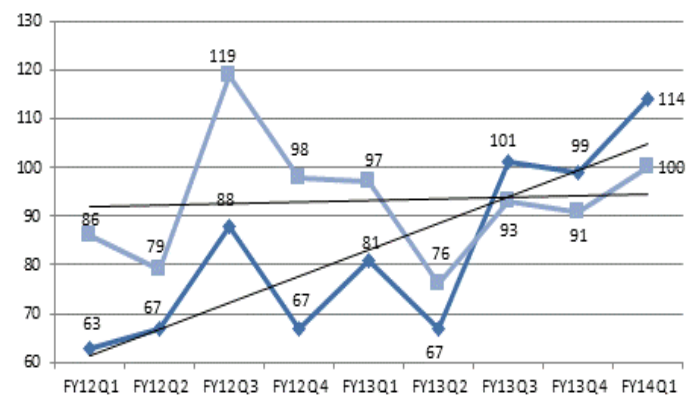

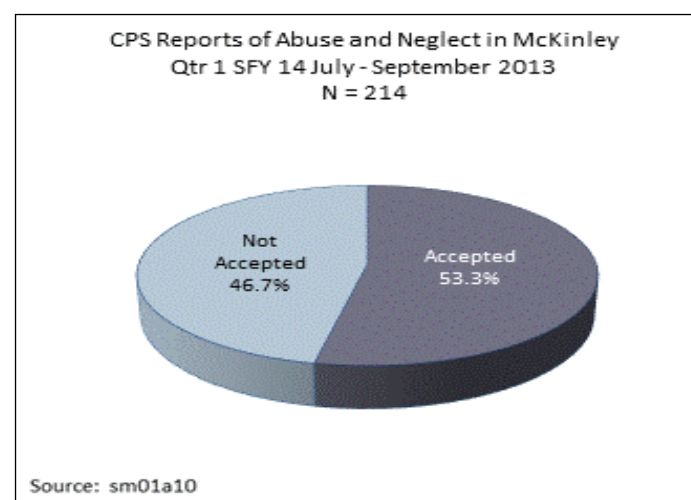

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Mckinley County

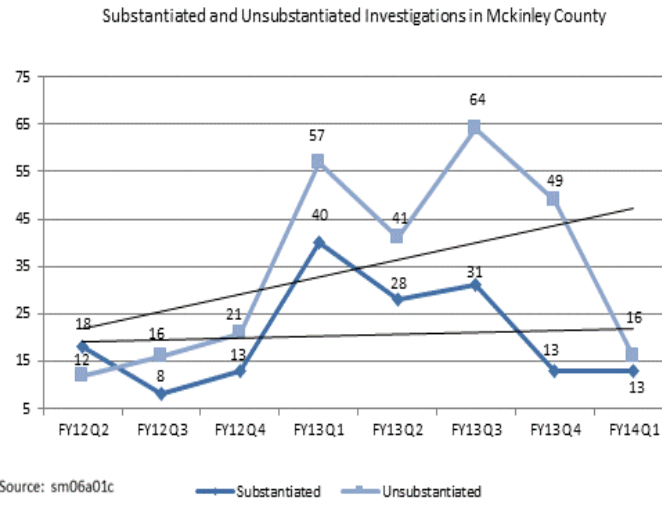

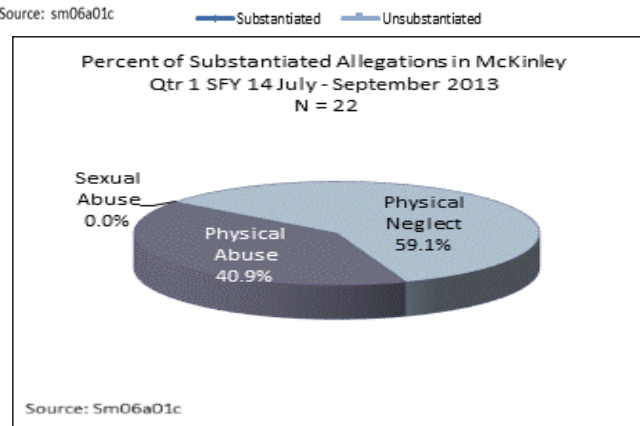

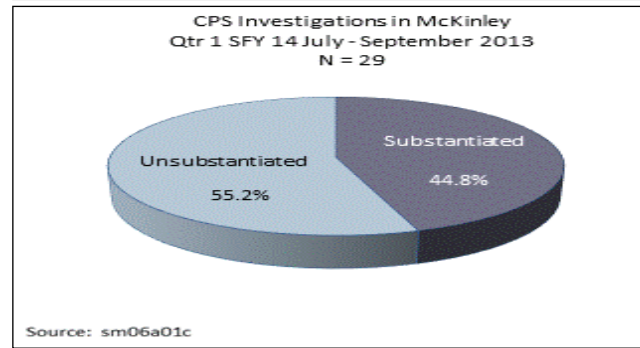

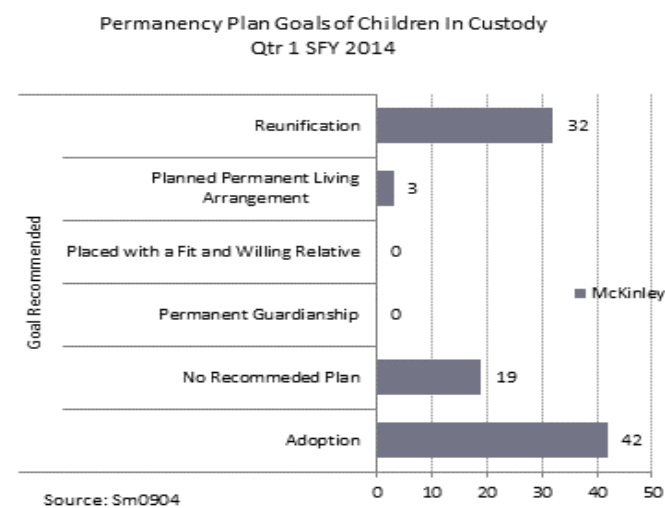

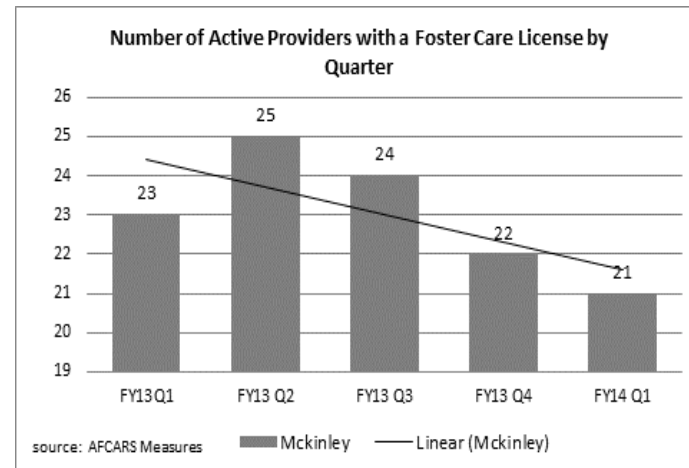

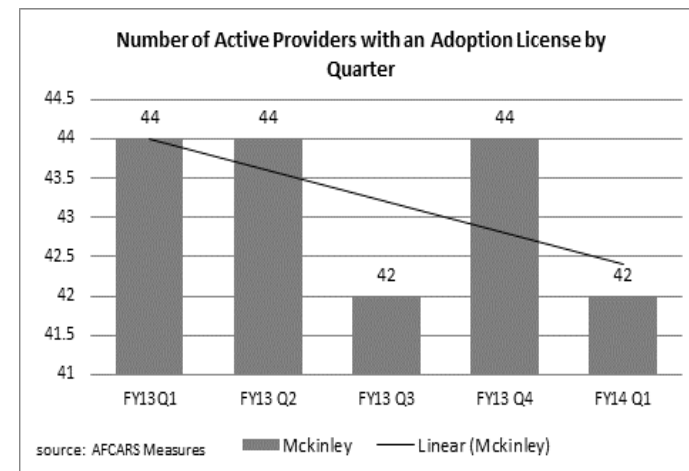

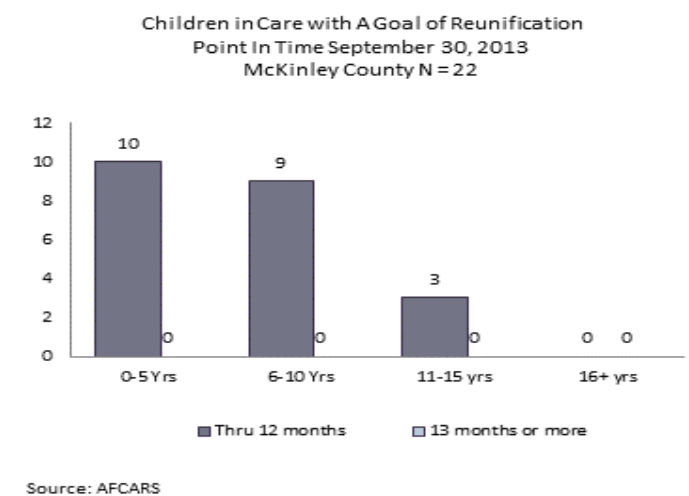

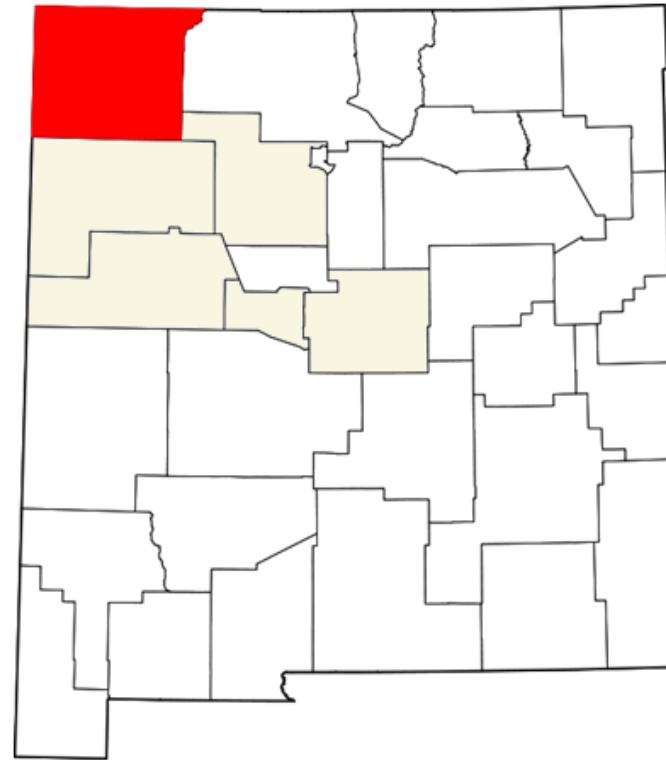

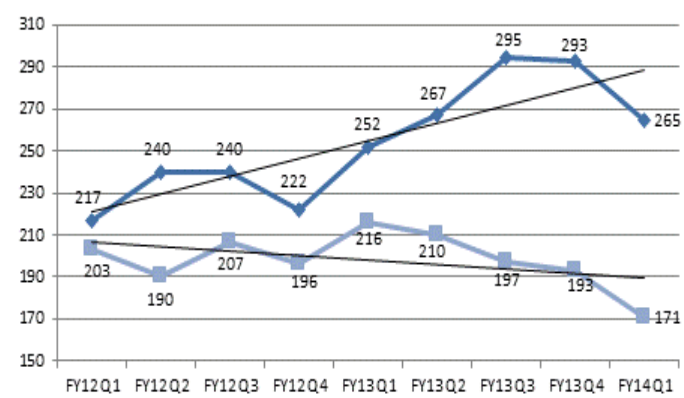

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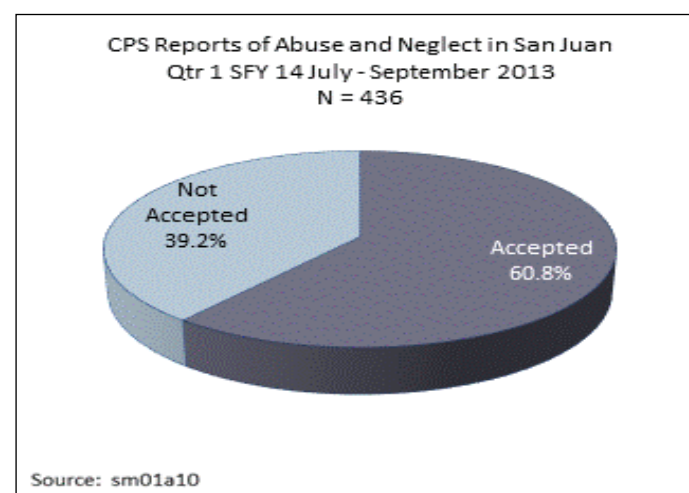

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in San Juan County

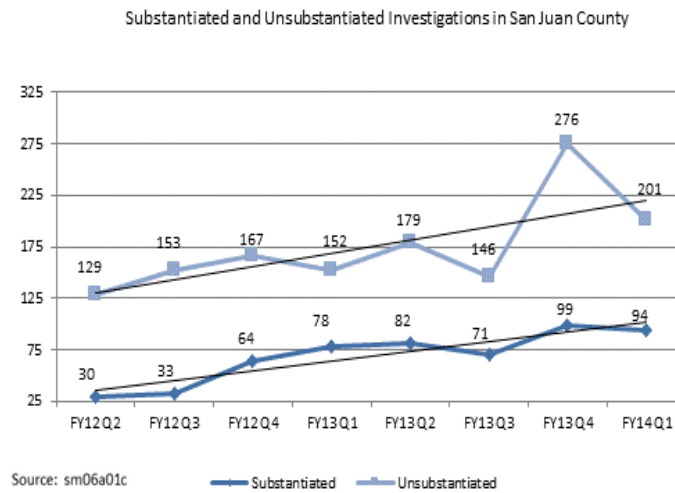

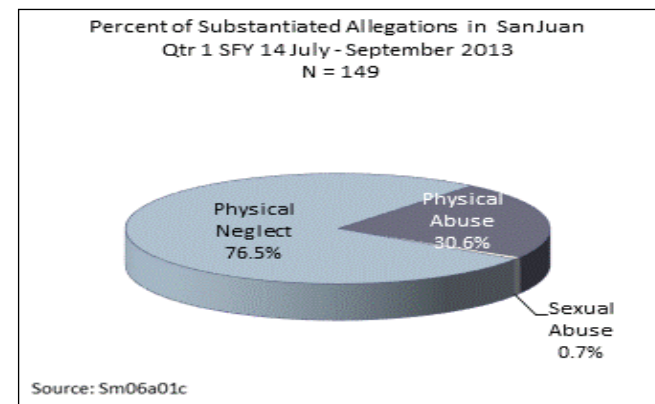

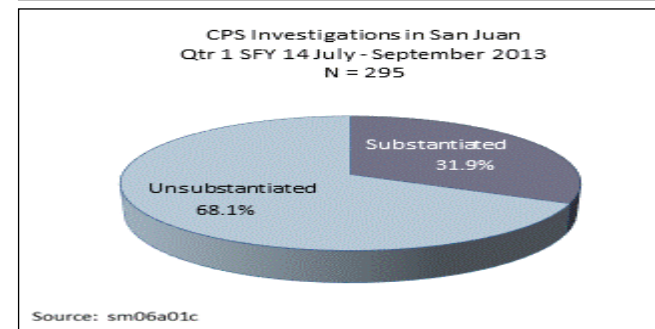

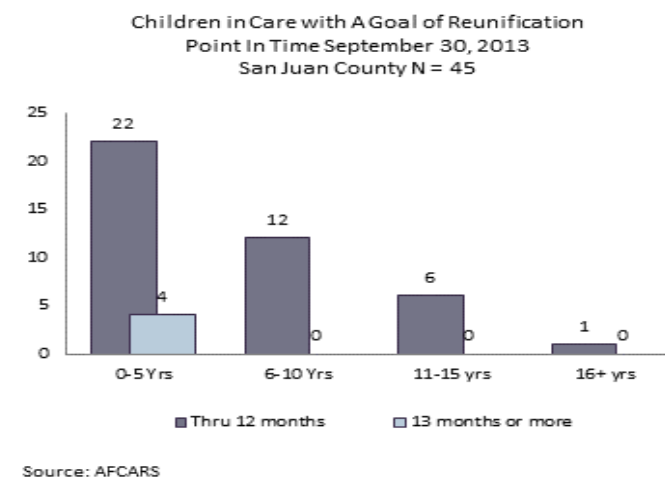

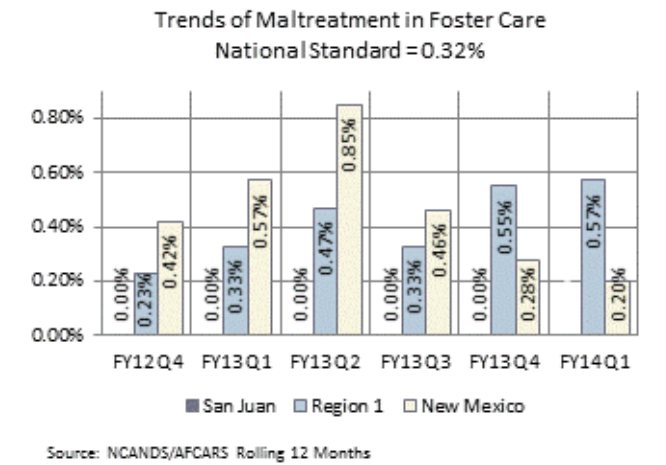

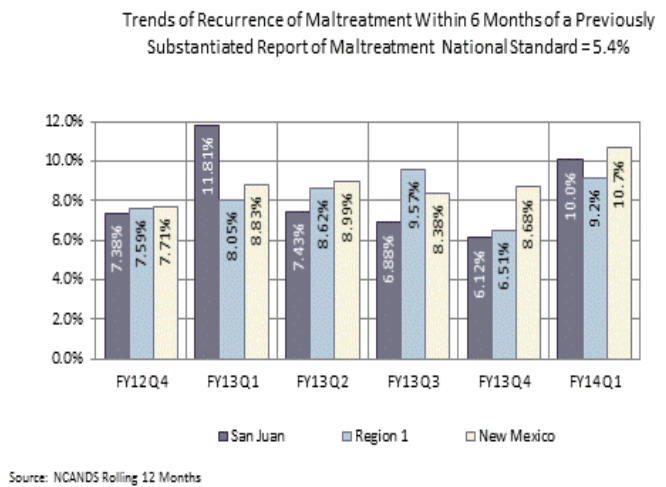

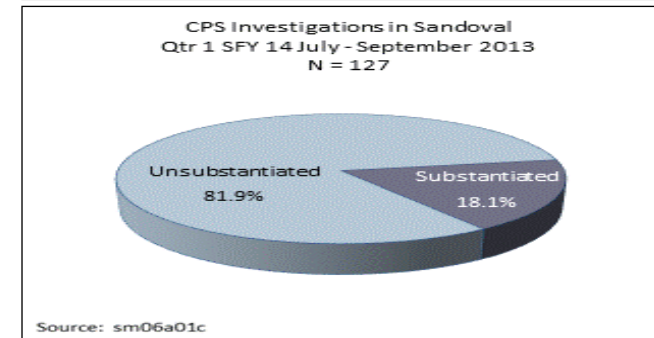

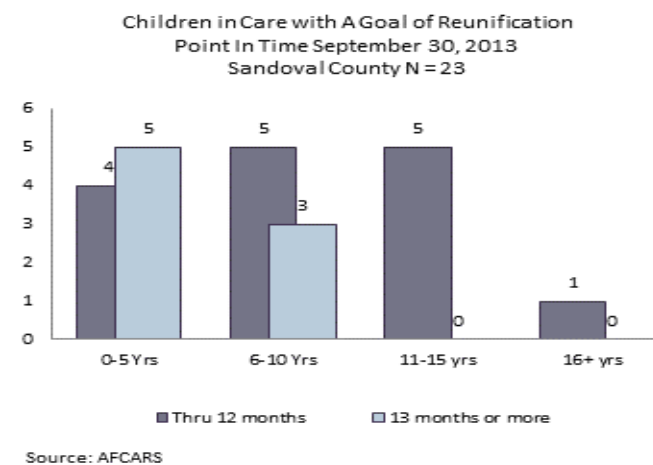

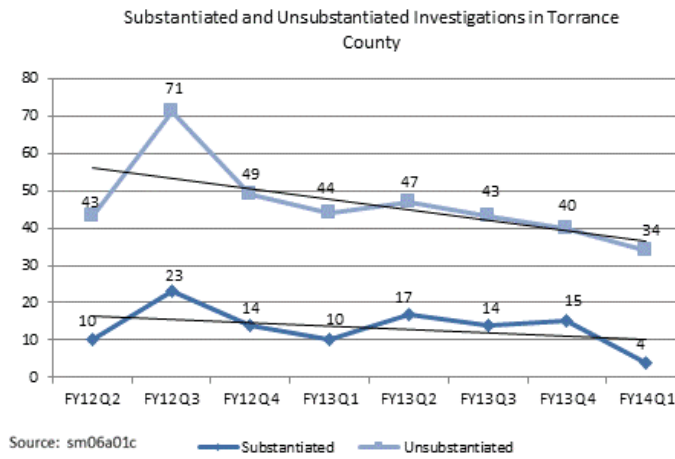

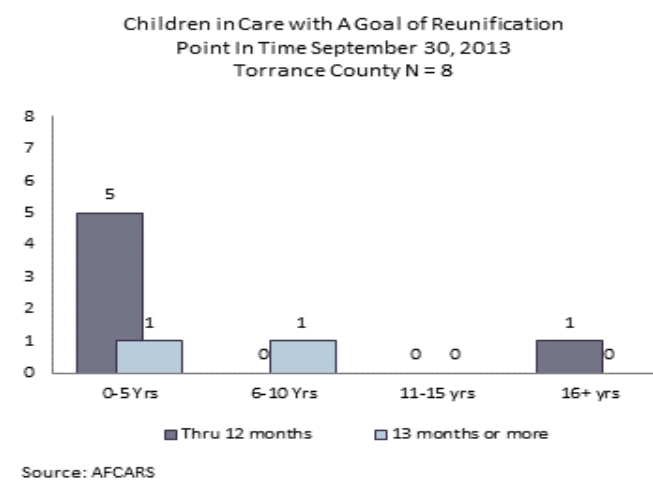

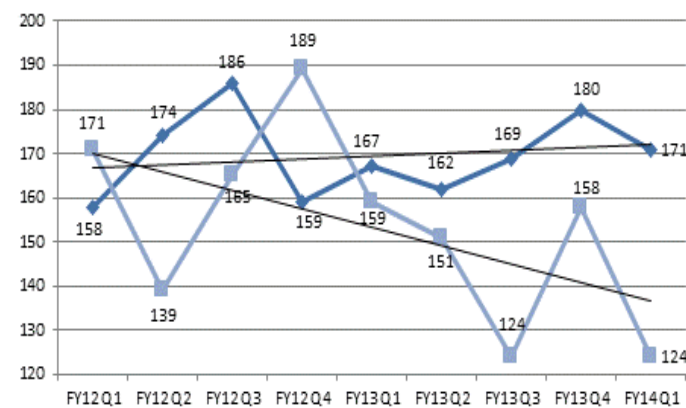

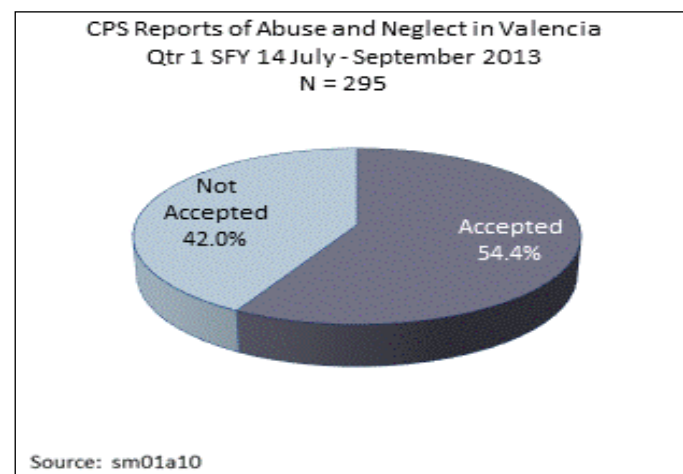


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Valencia County

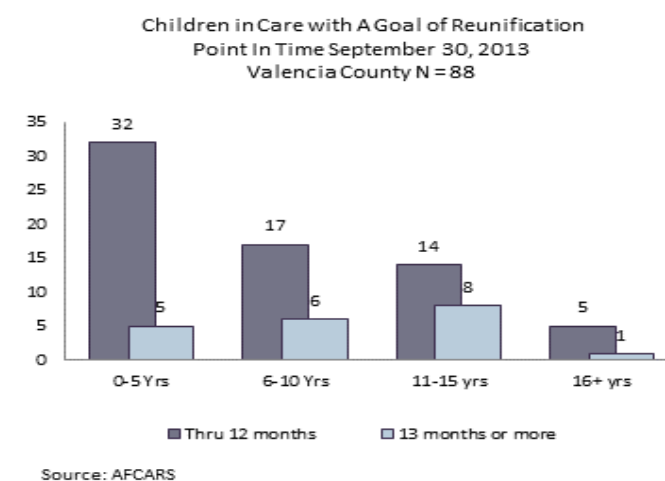

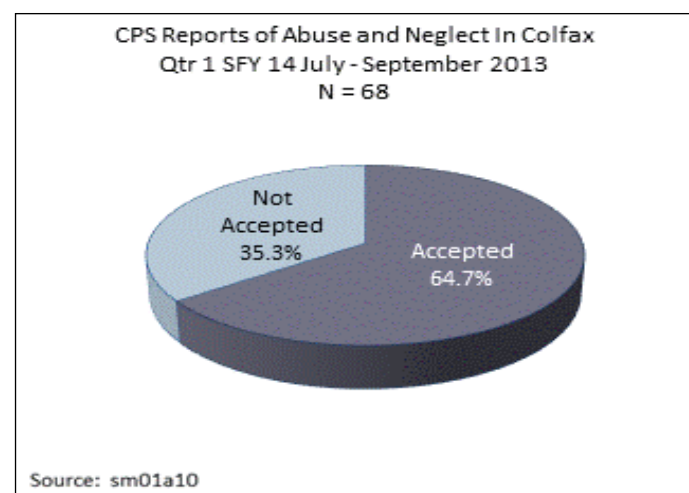

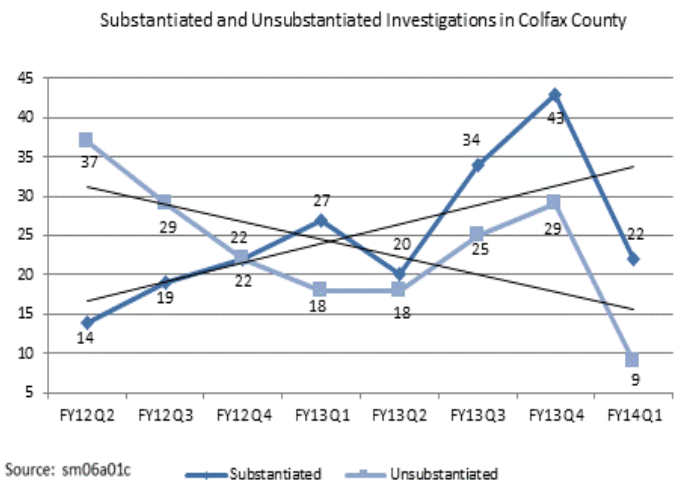

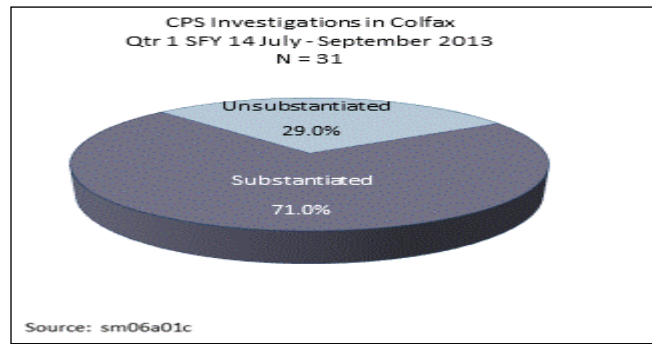

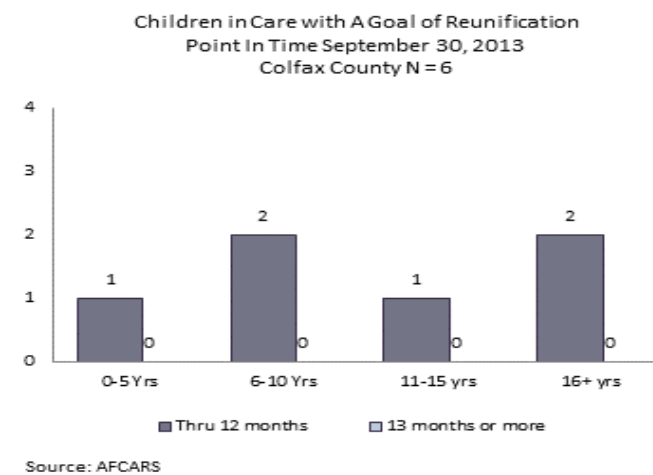

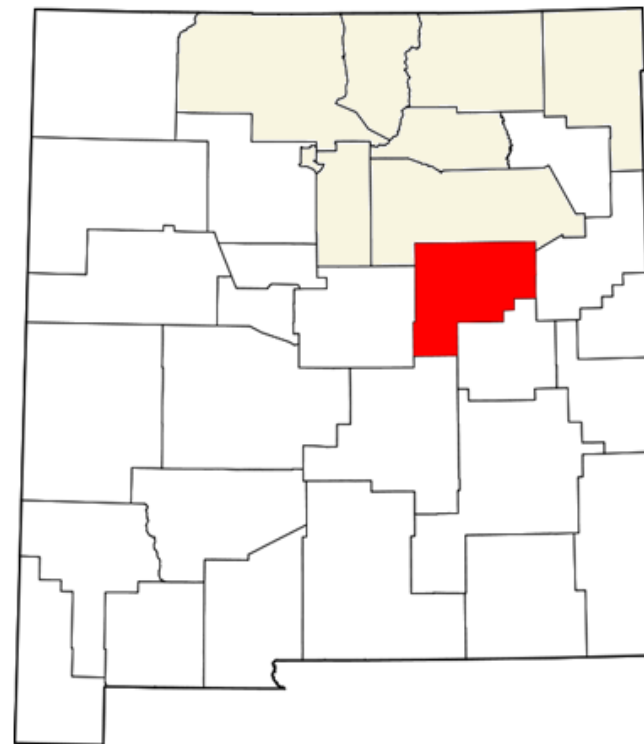

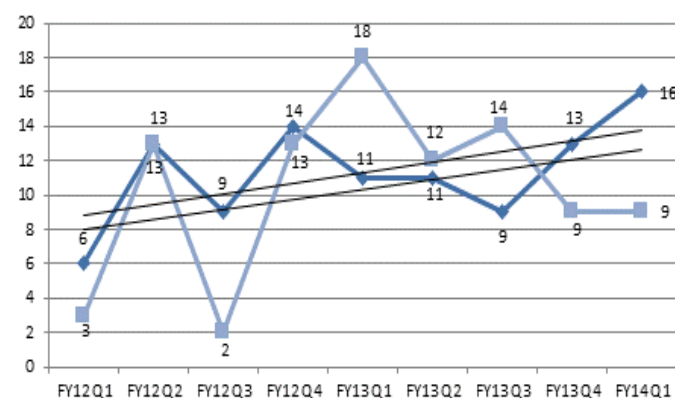

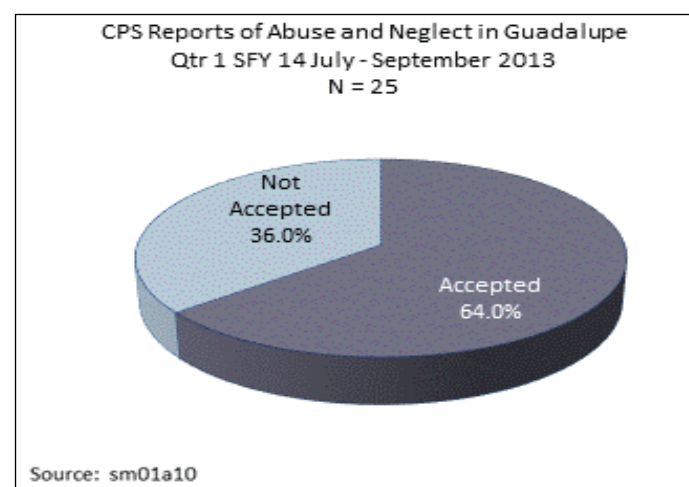

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Guadalupe County

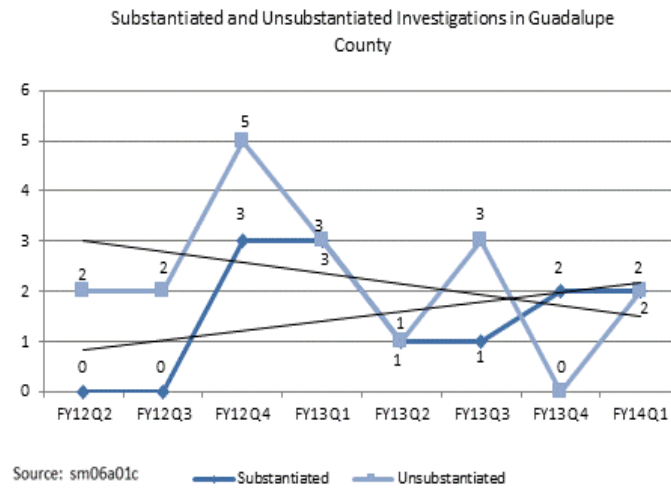

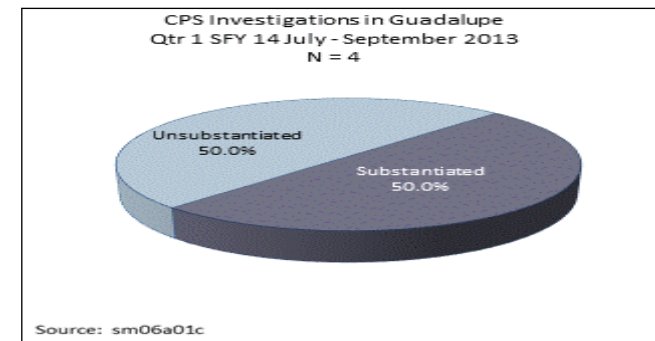

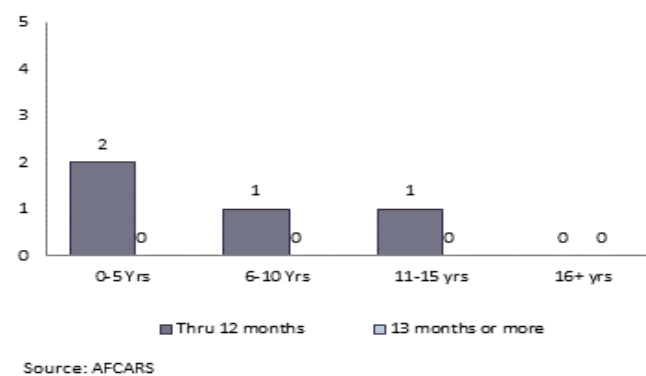

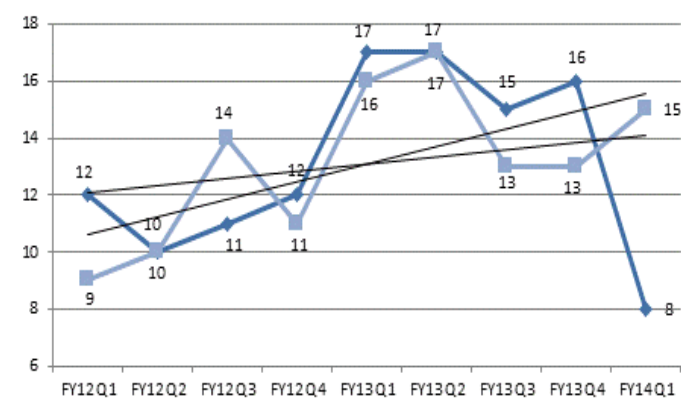

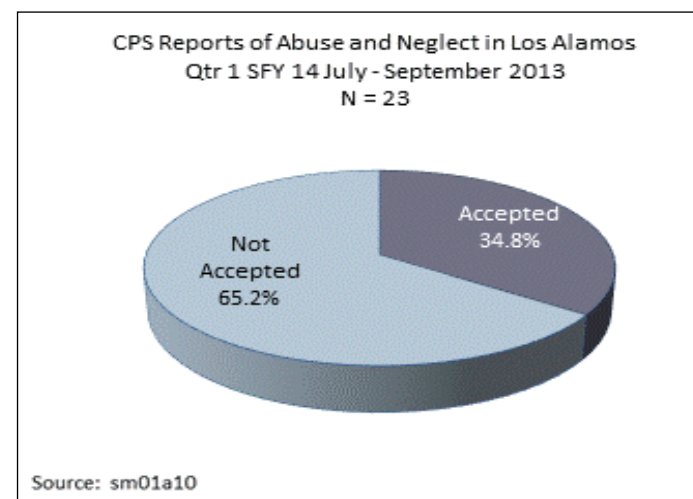


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Los Alamos County



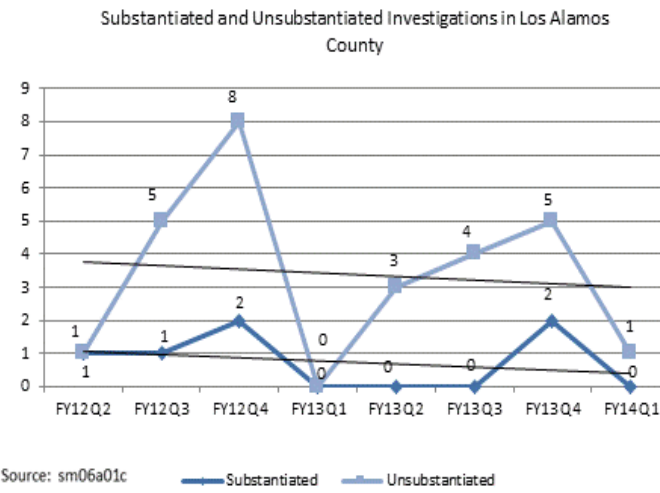

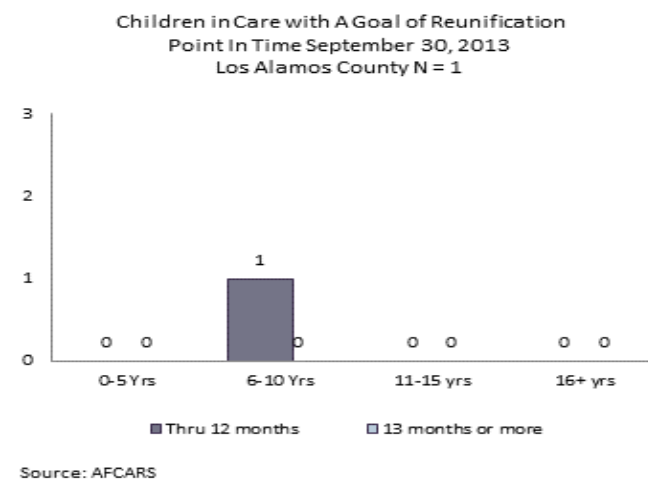

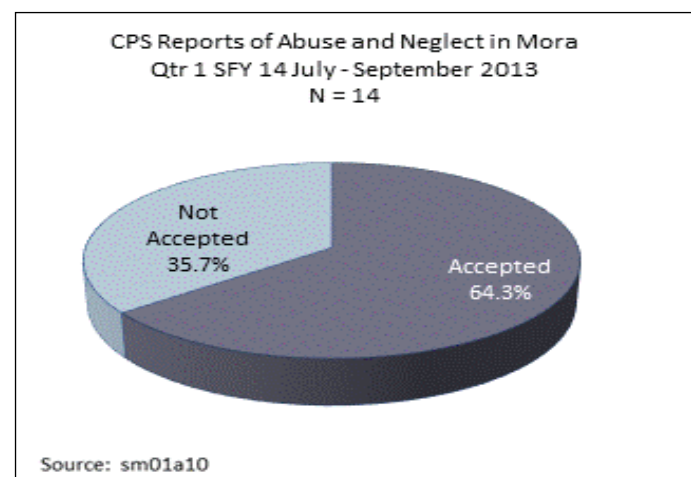

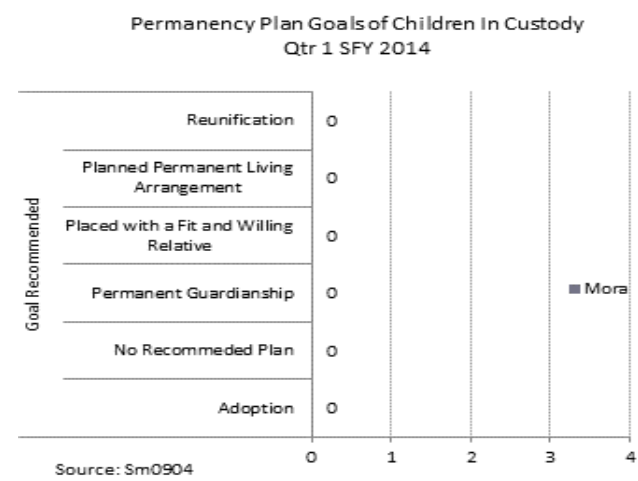

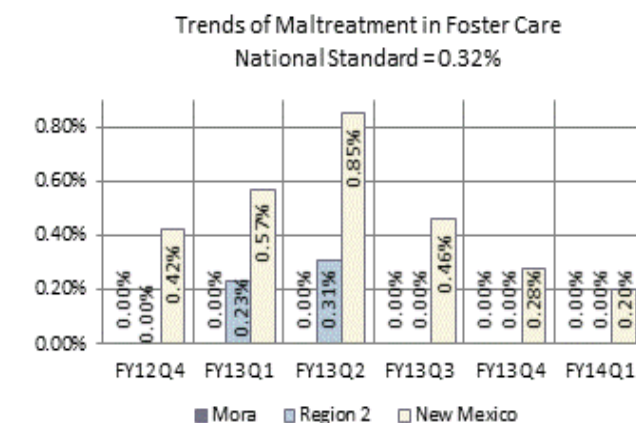

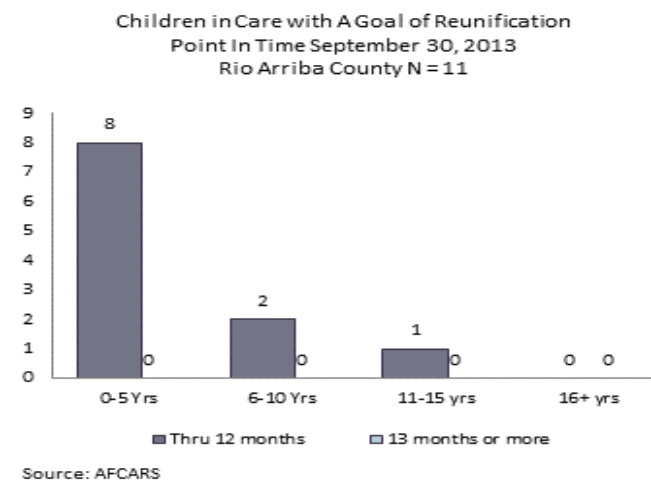

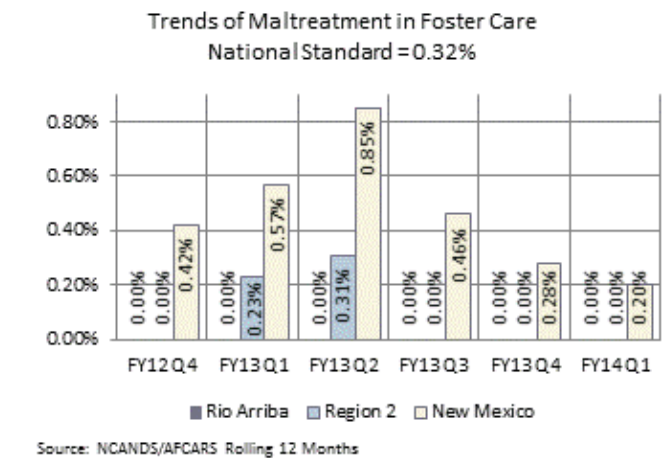

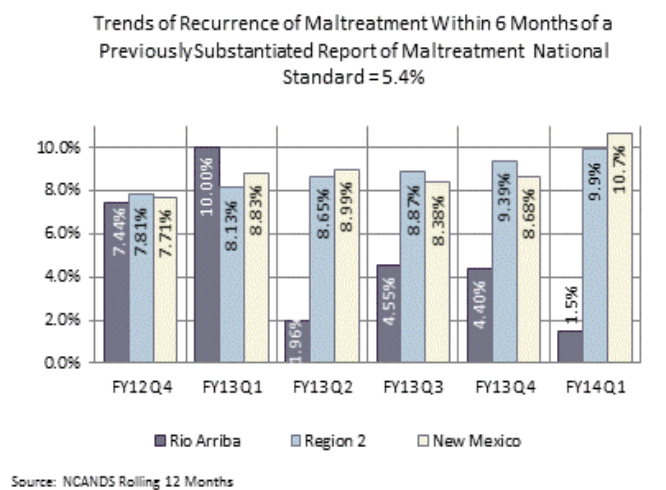

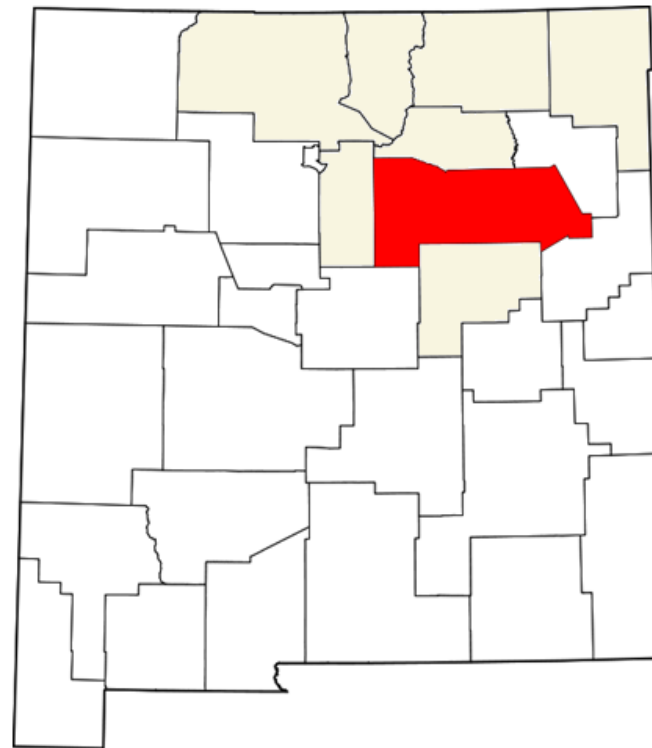

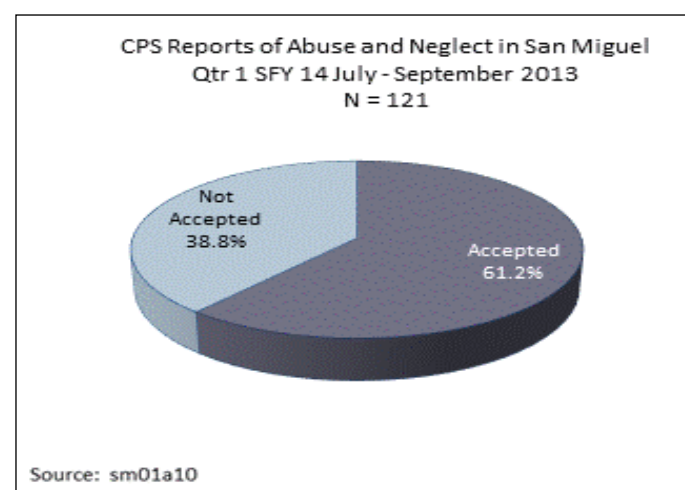

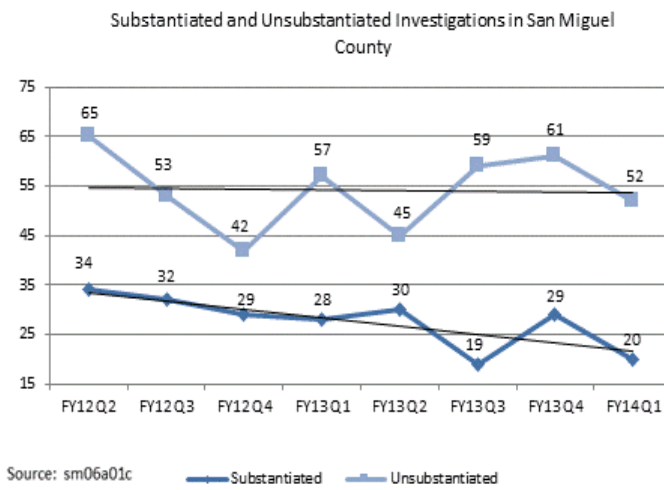

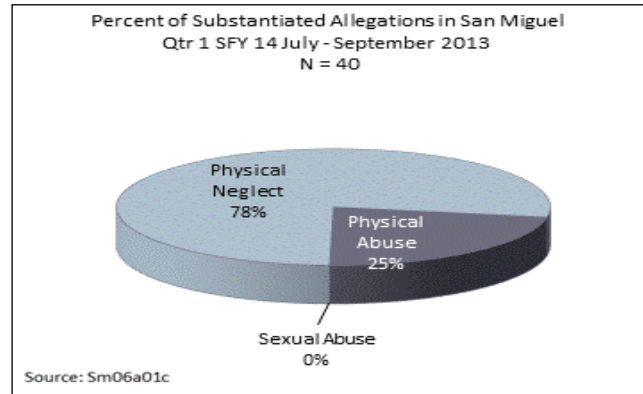

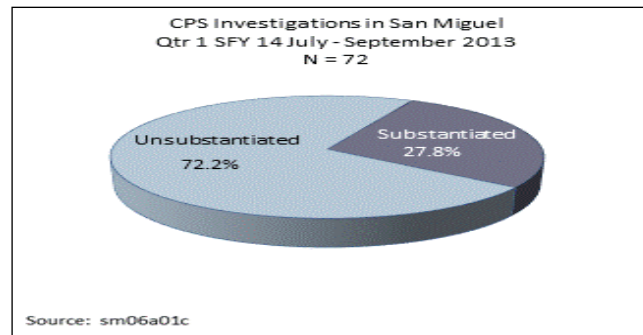

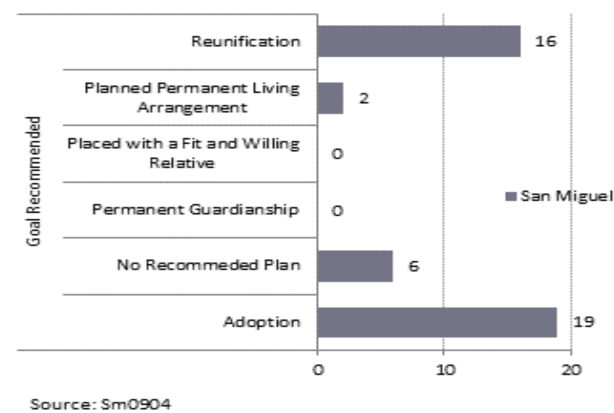

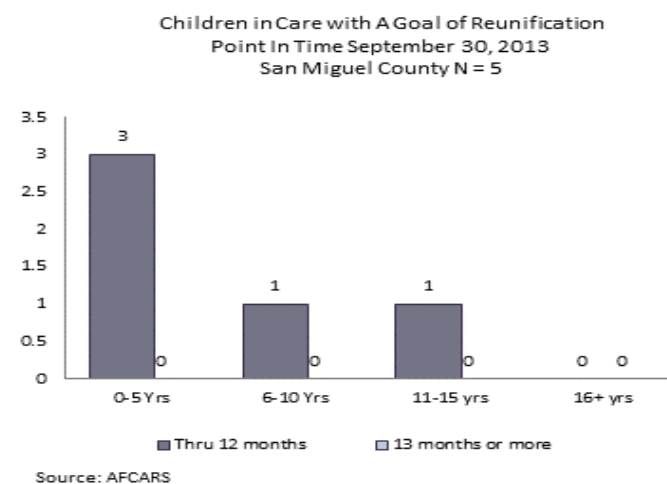

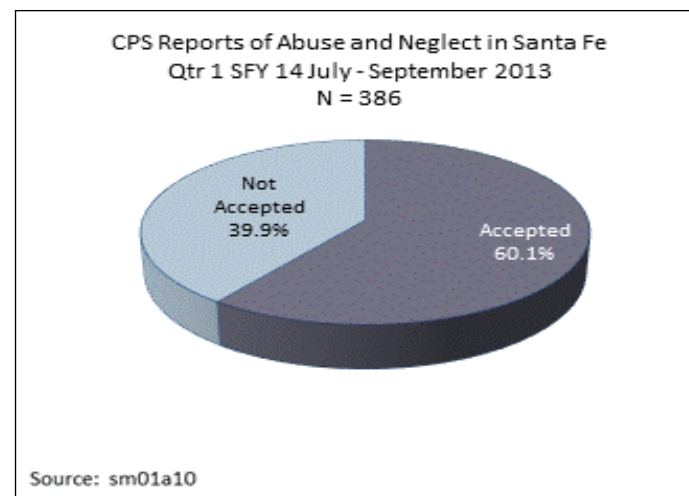
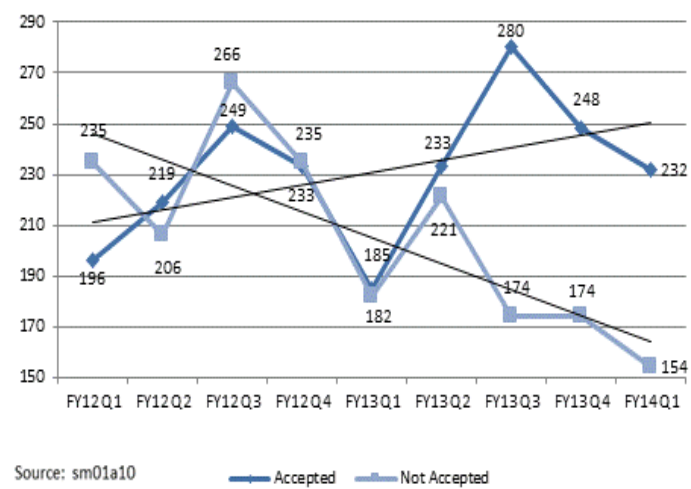

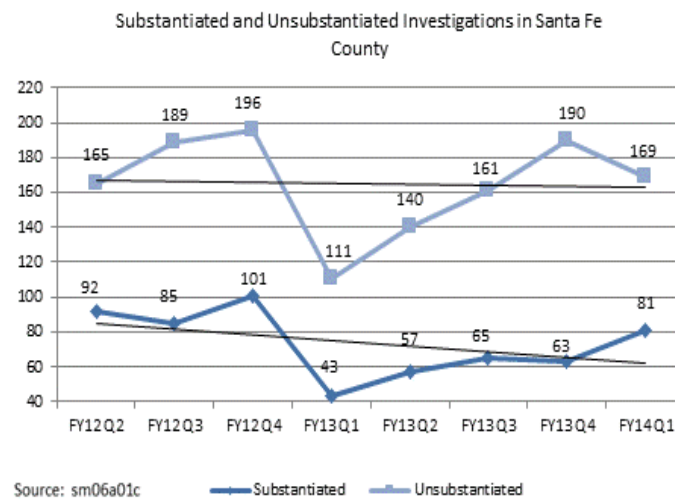


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Santa Fe County

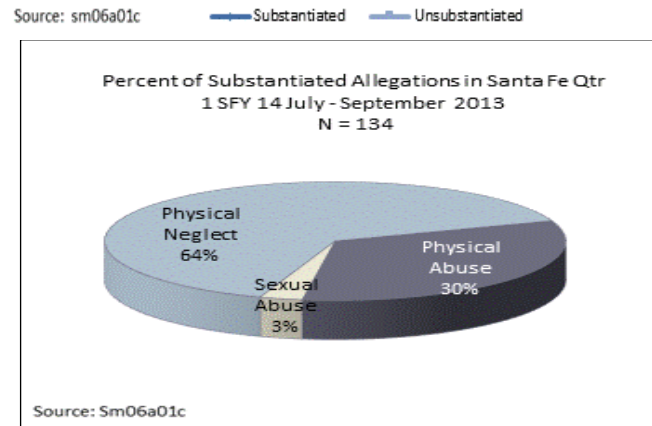

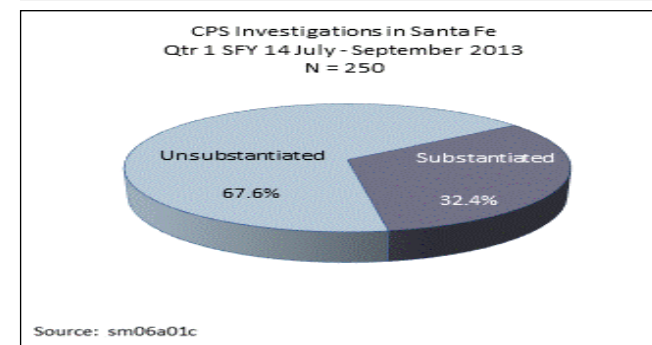

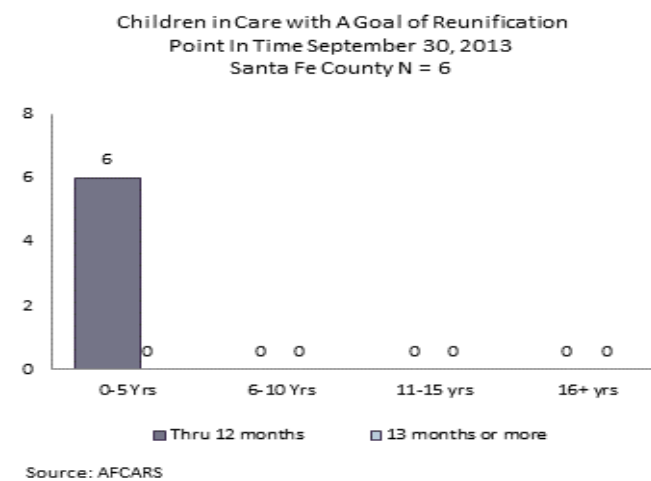

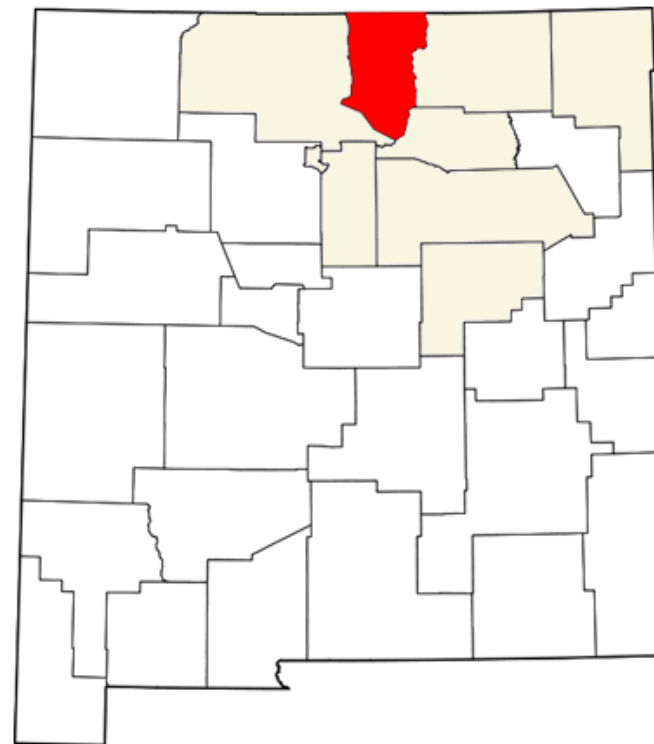

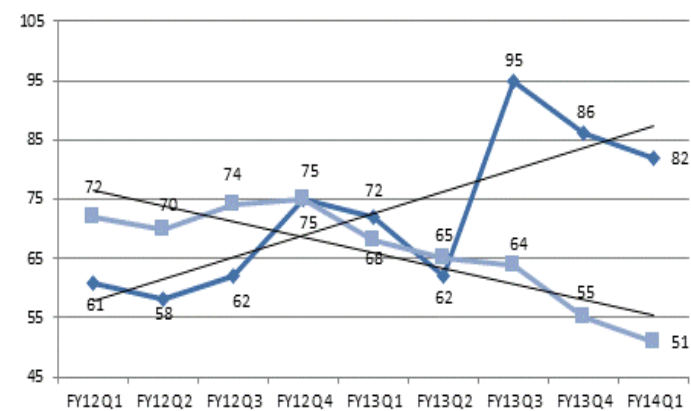

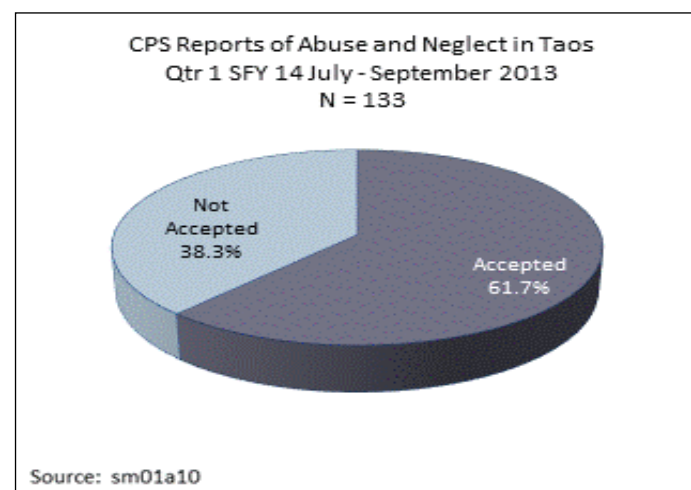

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Taos County

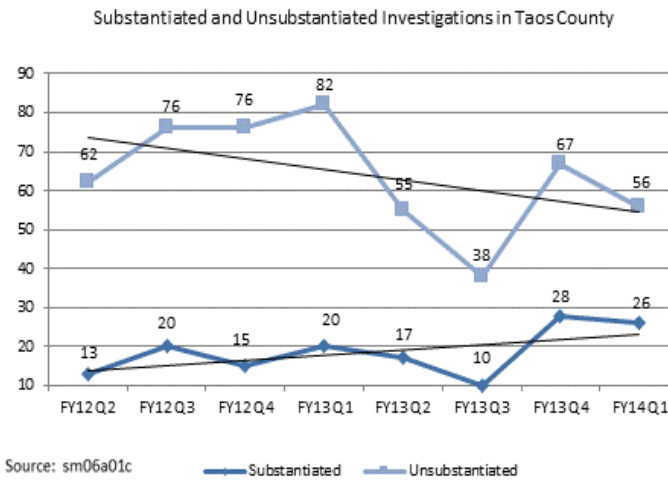

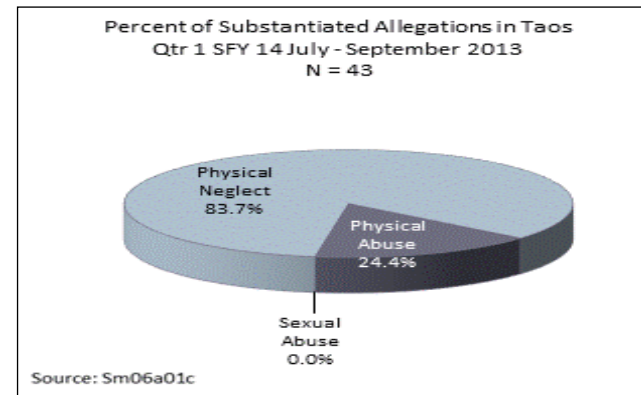

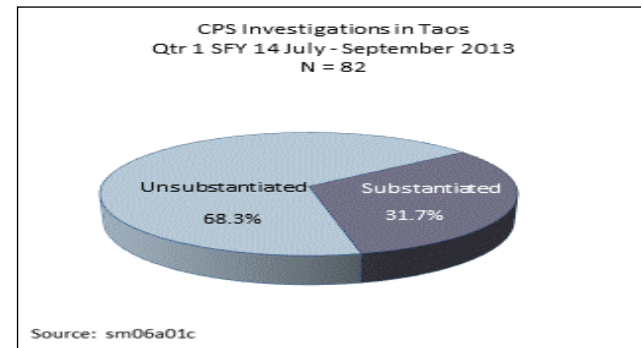

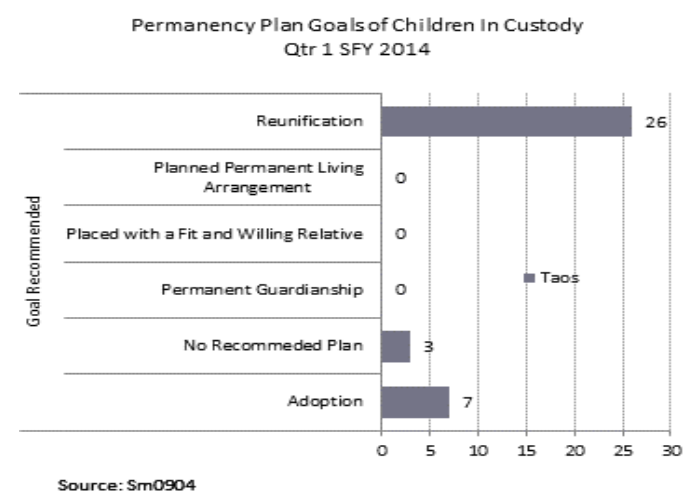

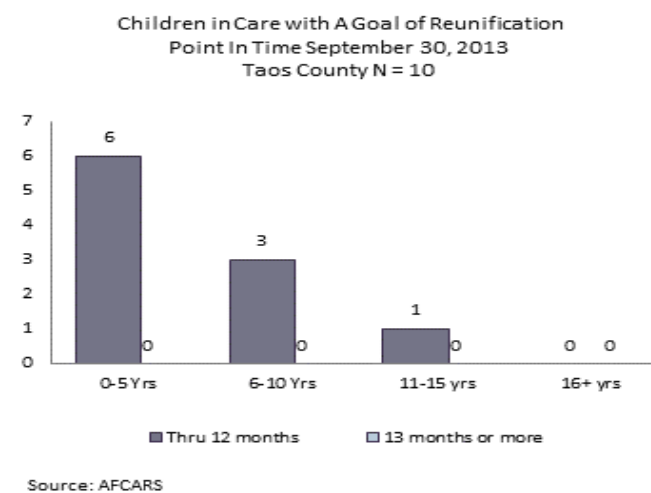

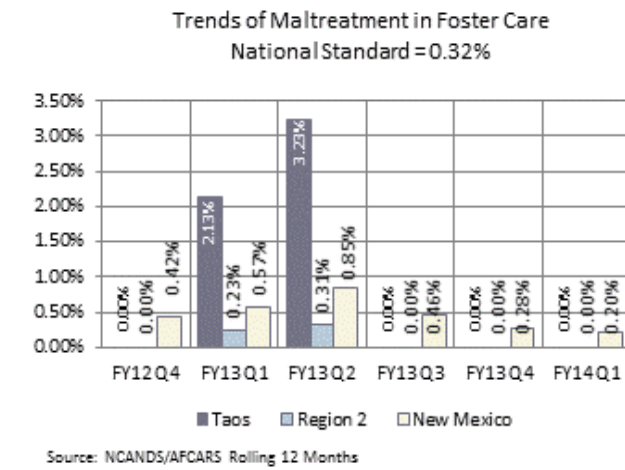

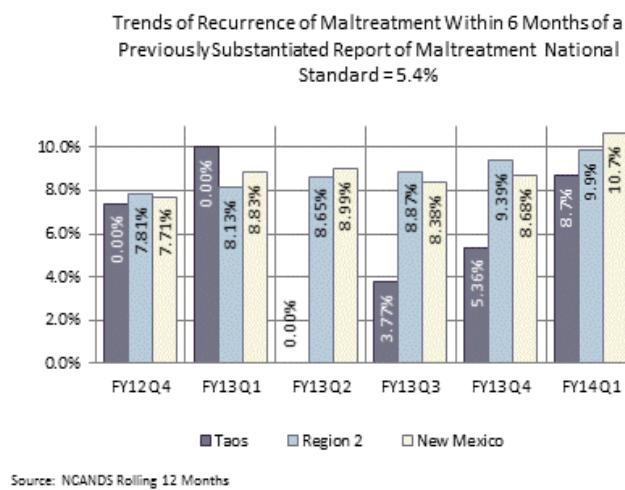

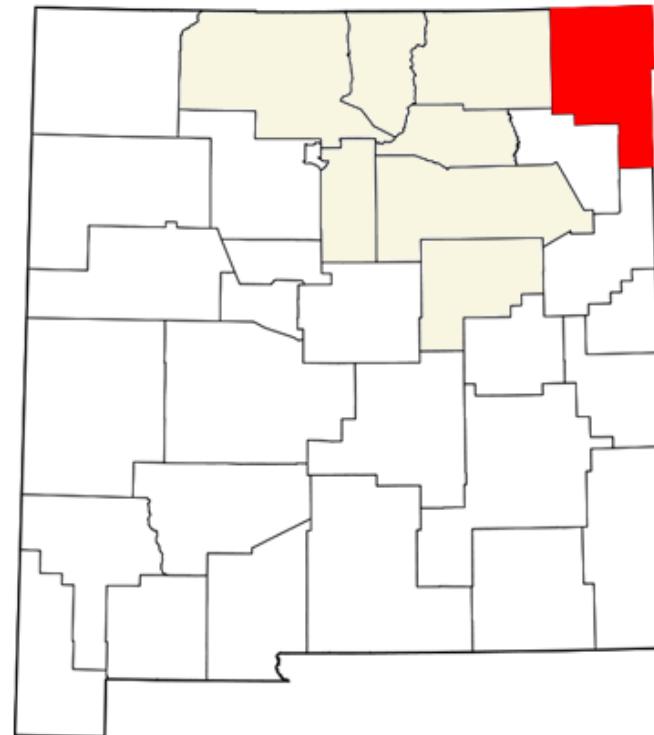

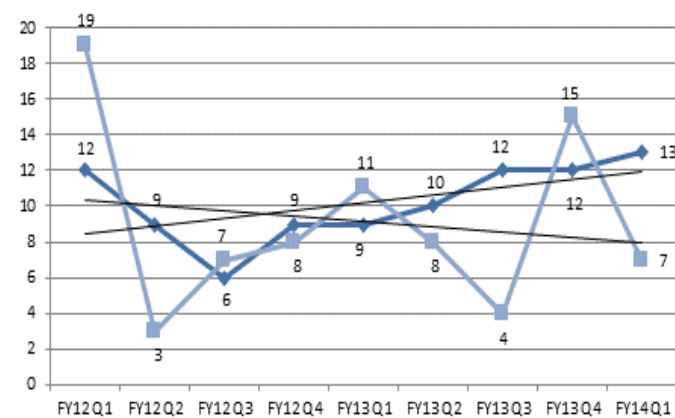

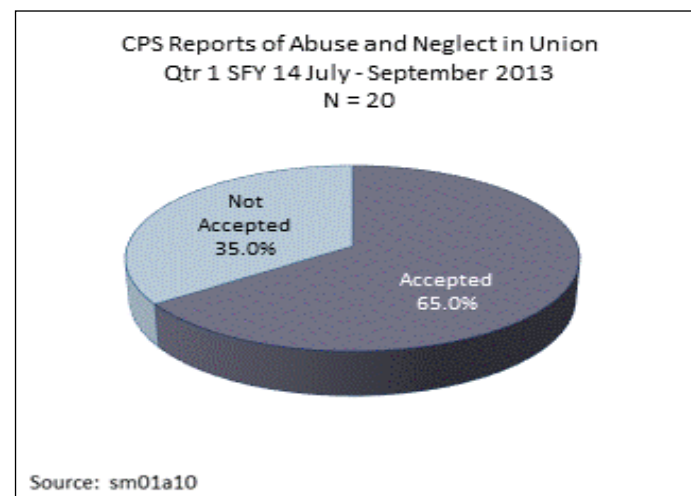


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Union County

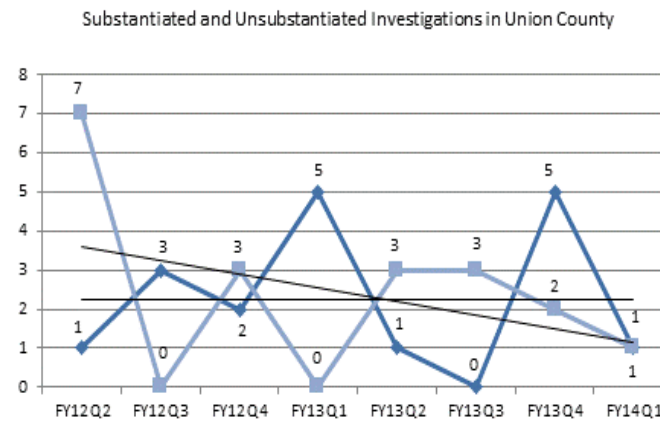

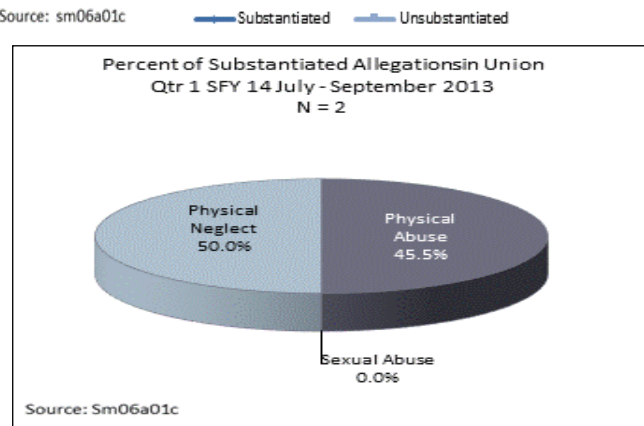

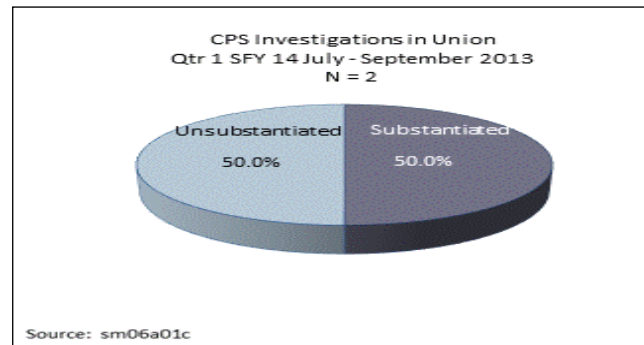

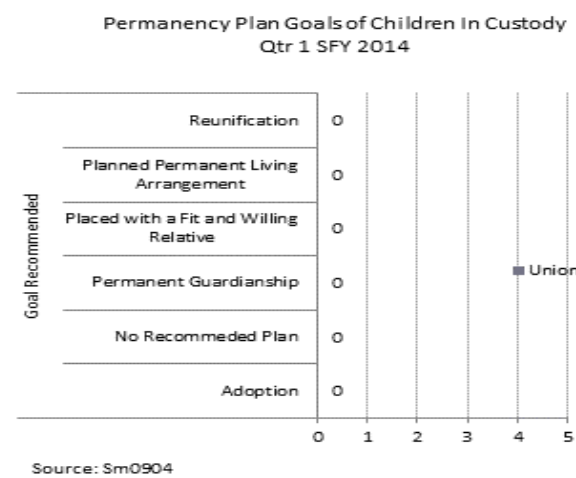

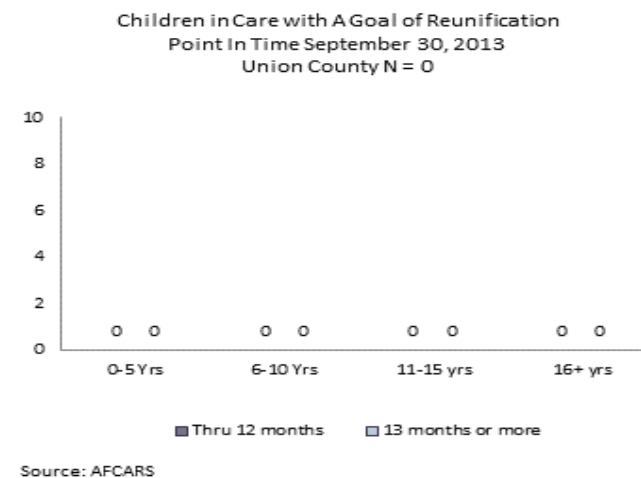

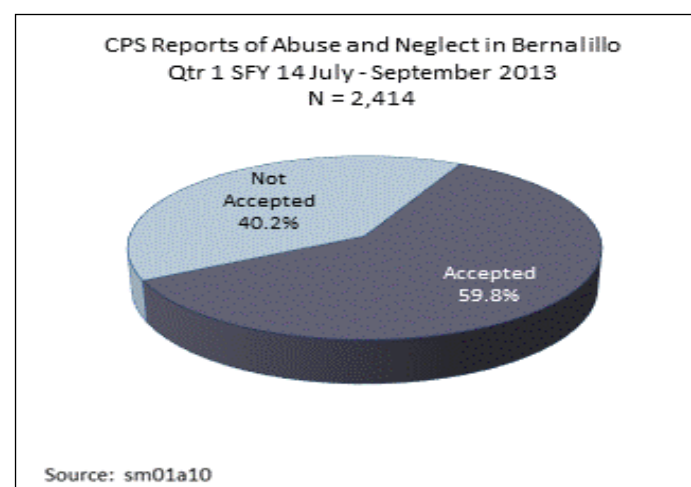

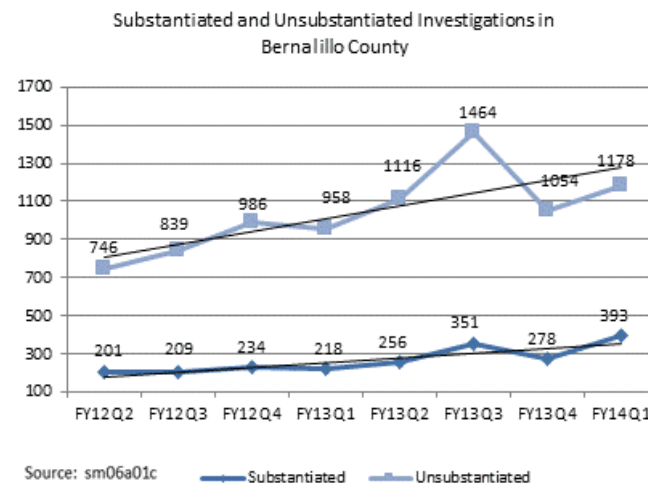

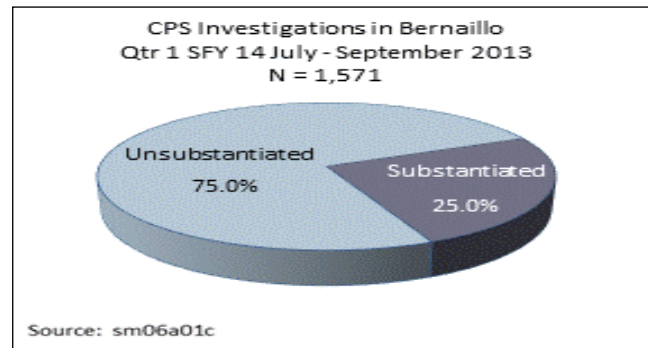

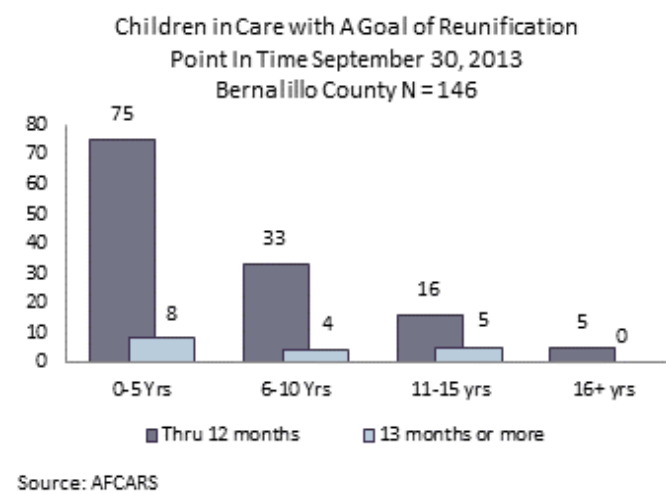

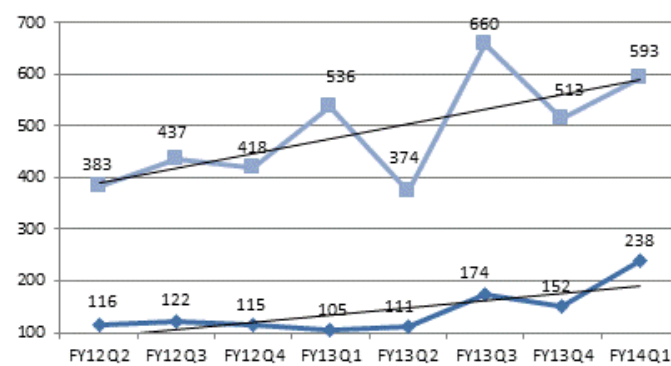

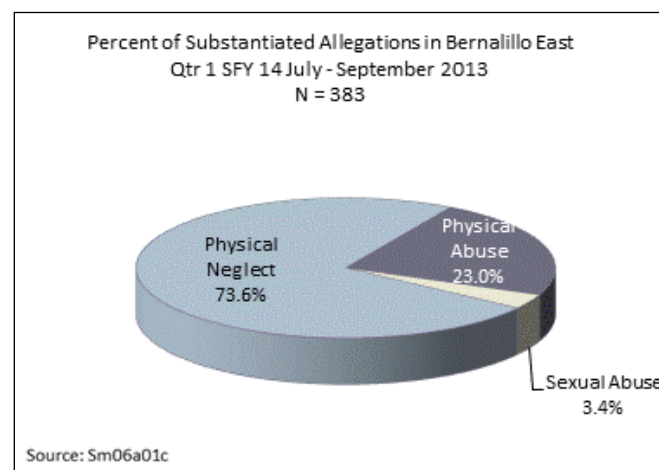

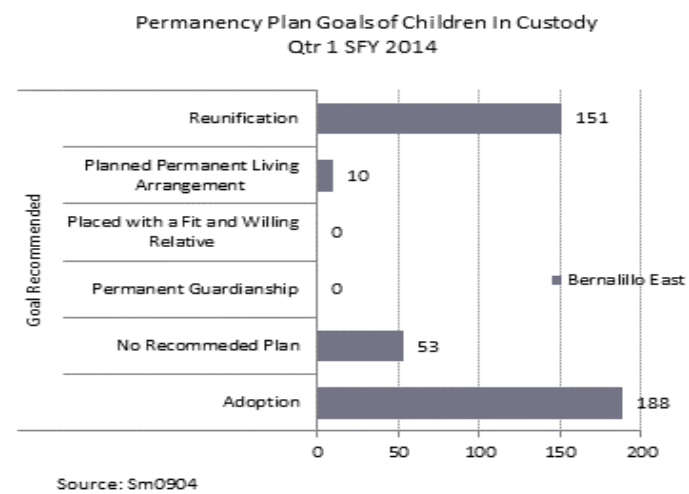

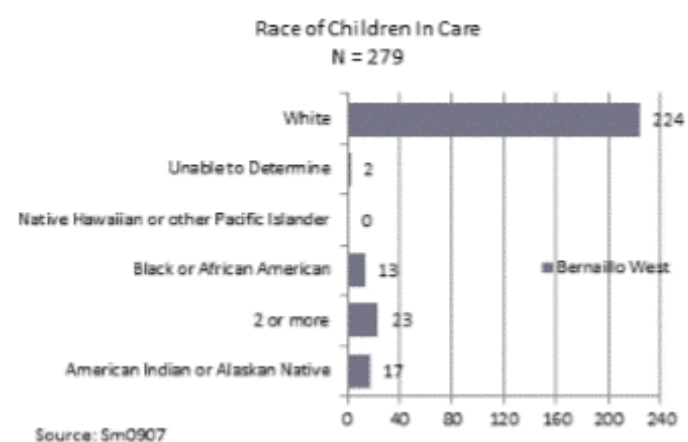

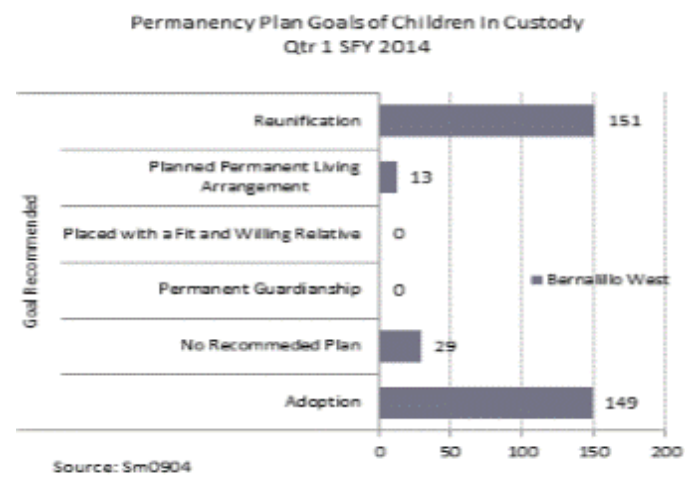

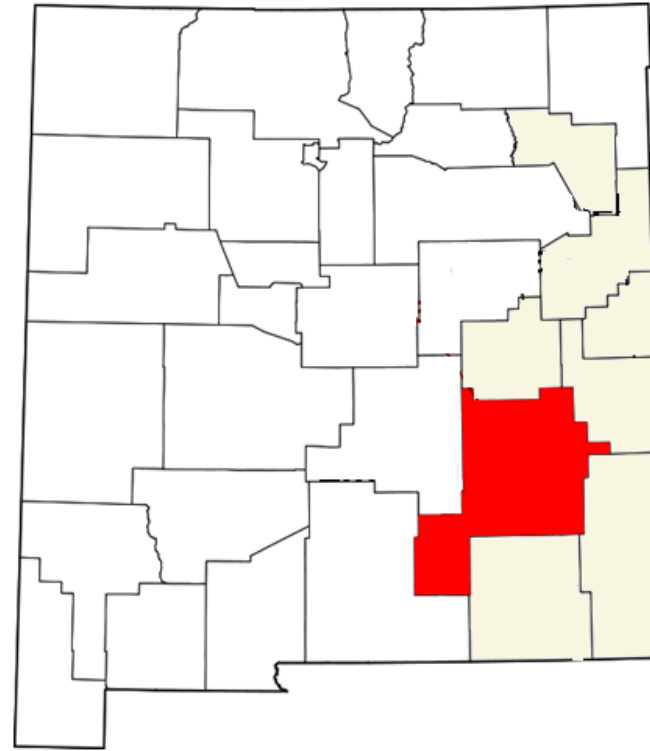

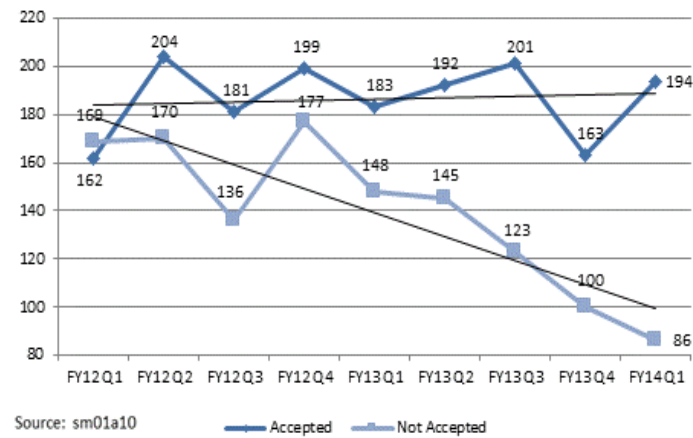

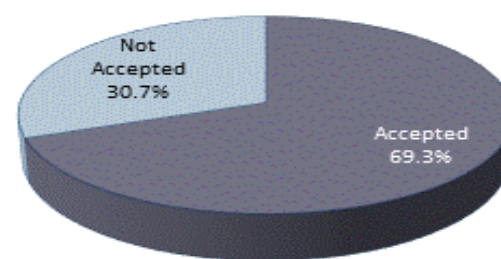

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Chaves County

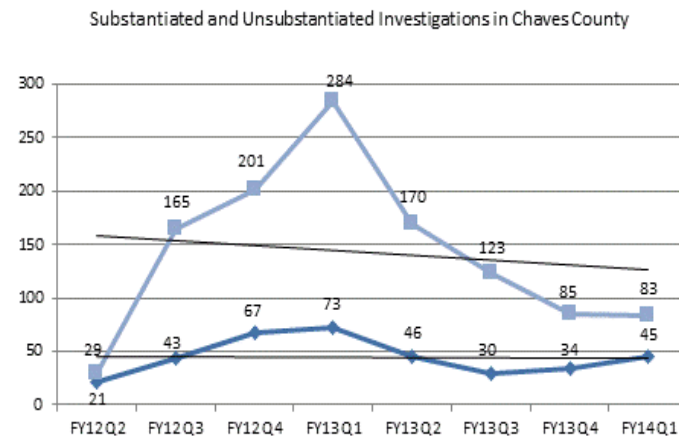

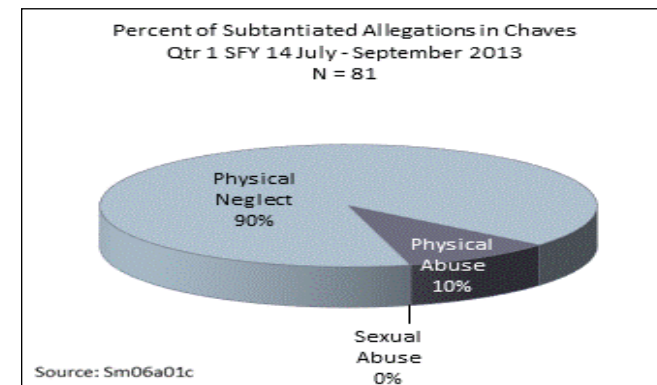

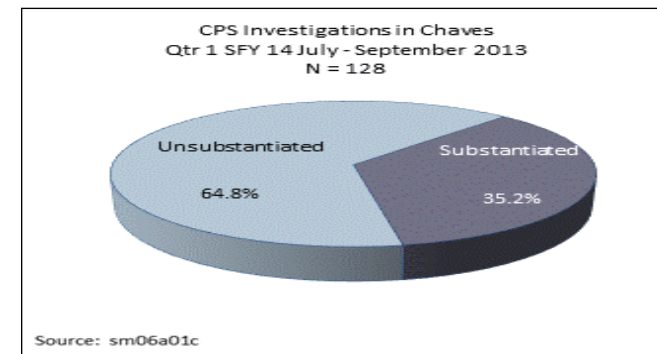

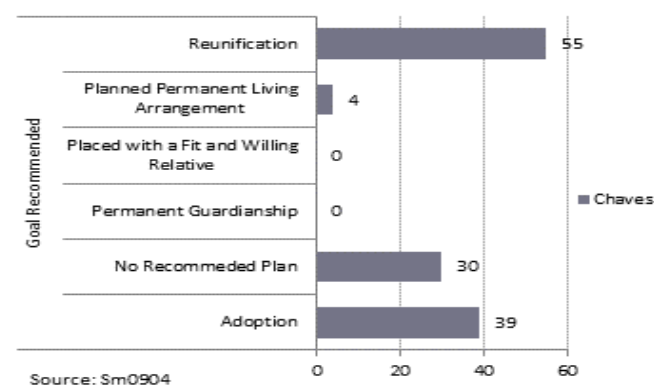

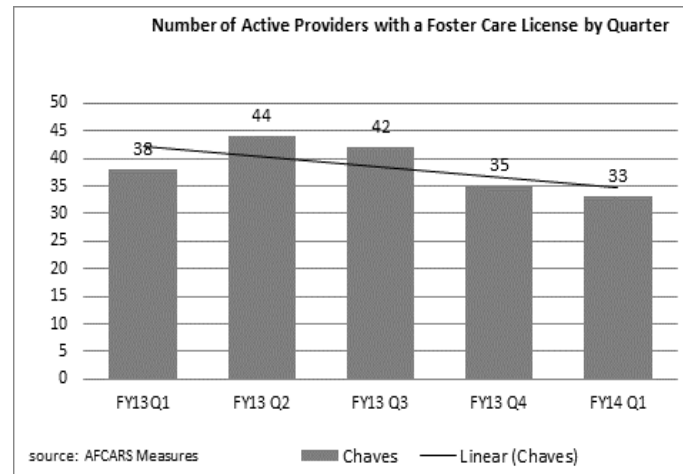
Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

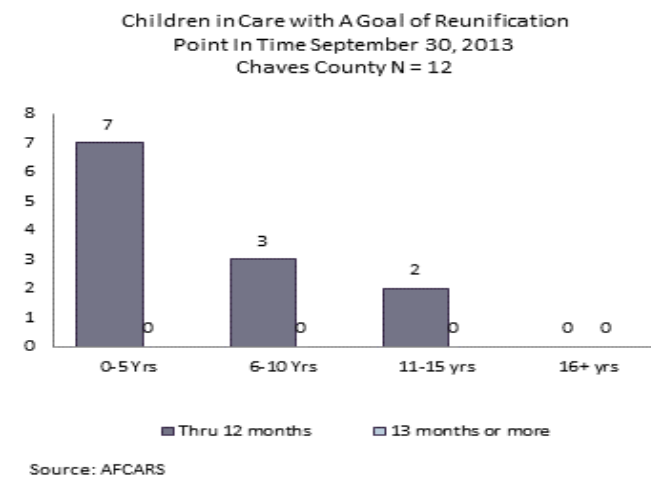

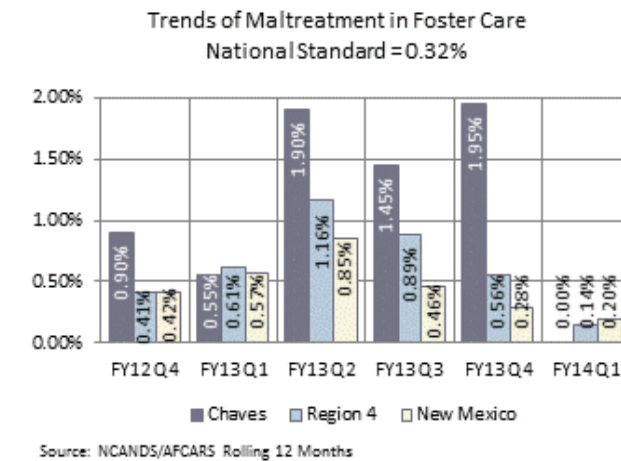

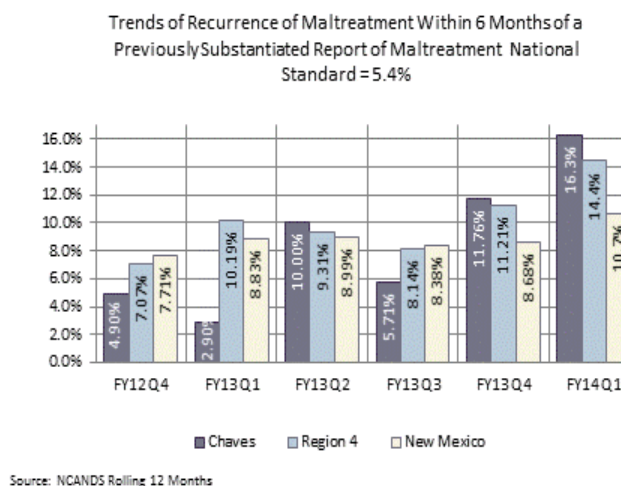

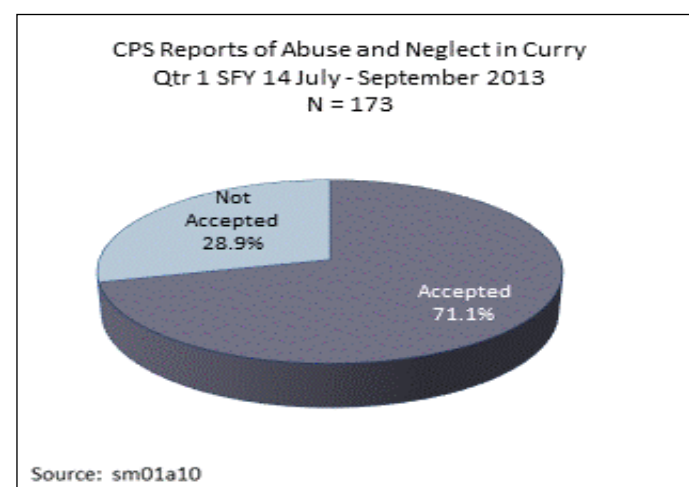

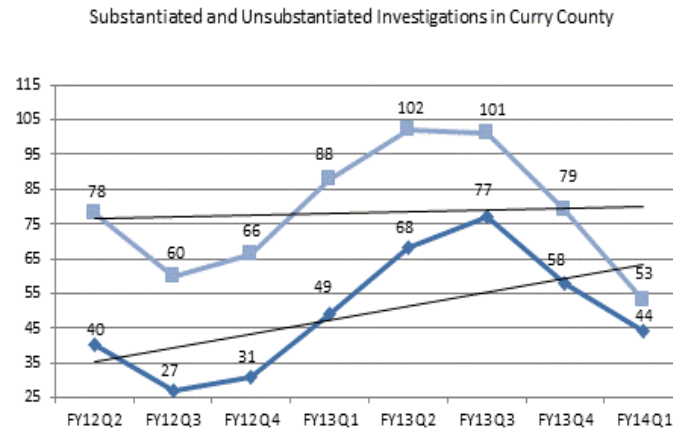

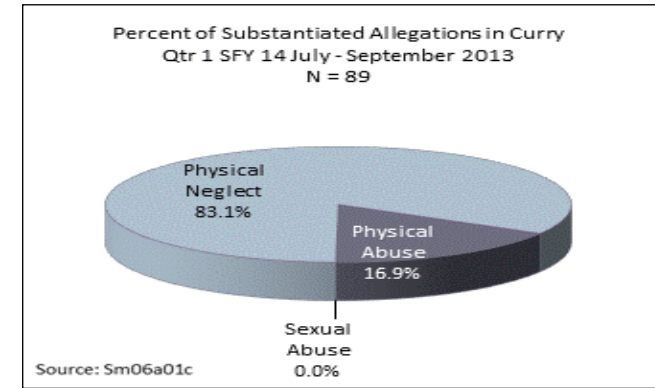

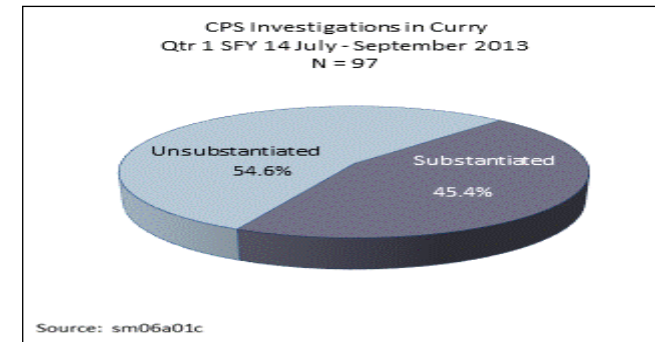

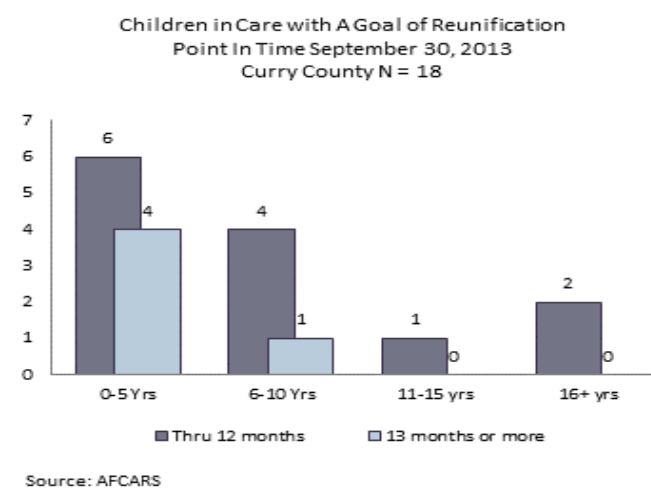

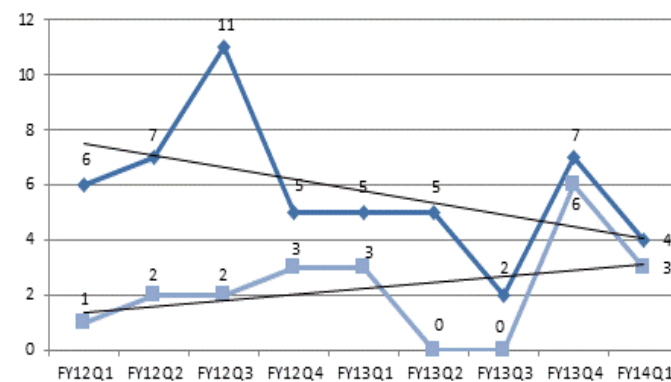

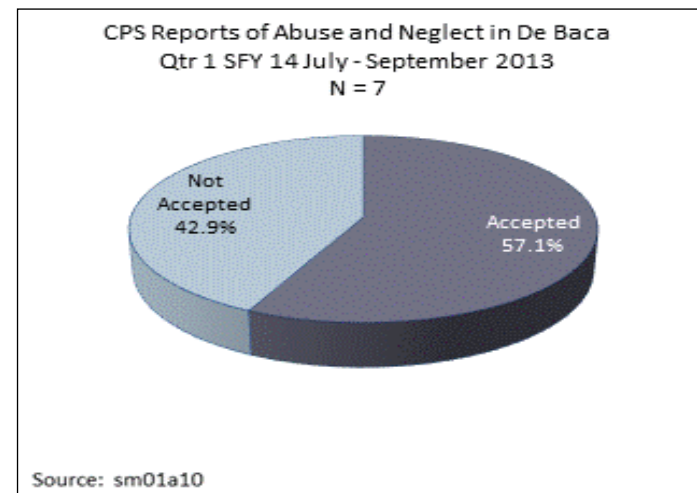

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in De Baca County



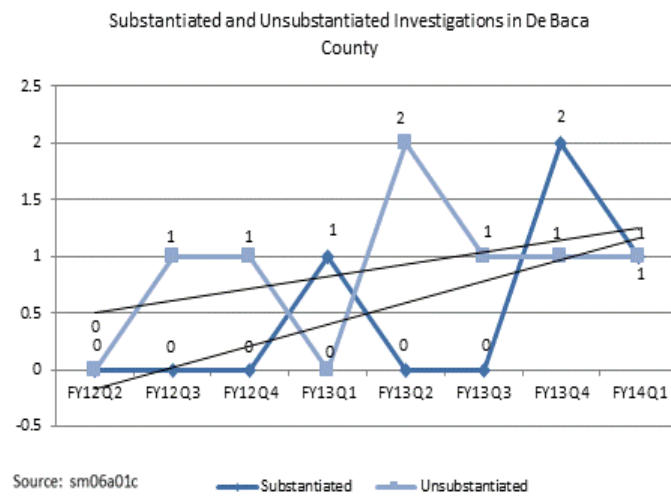

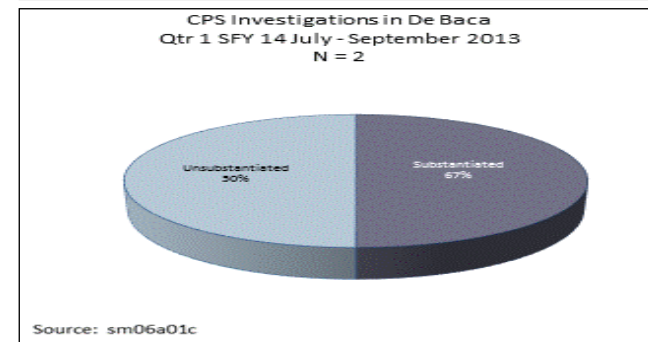

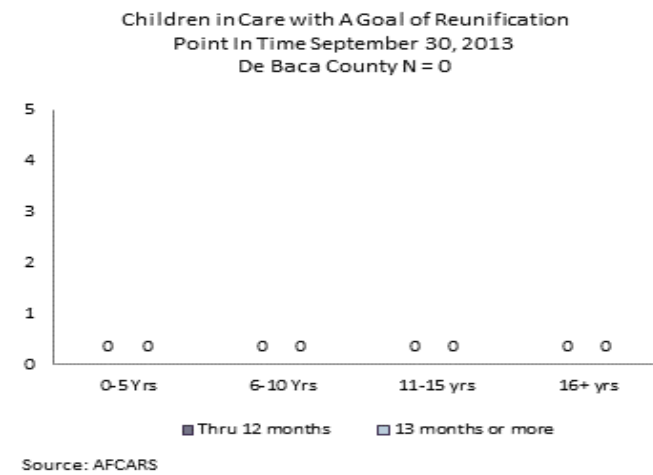

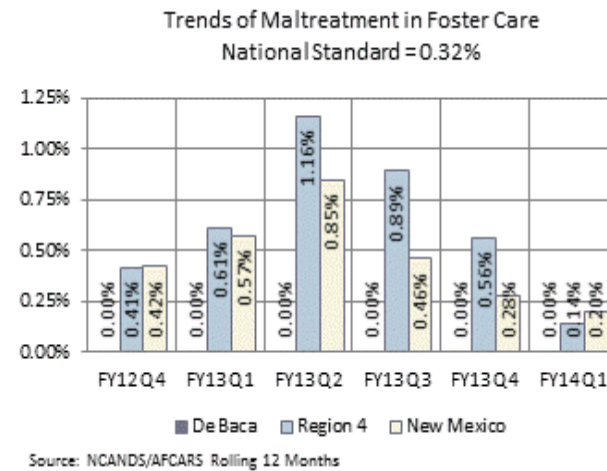

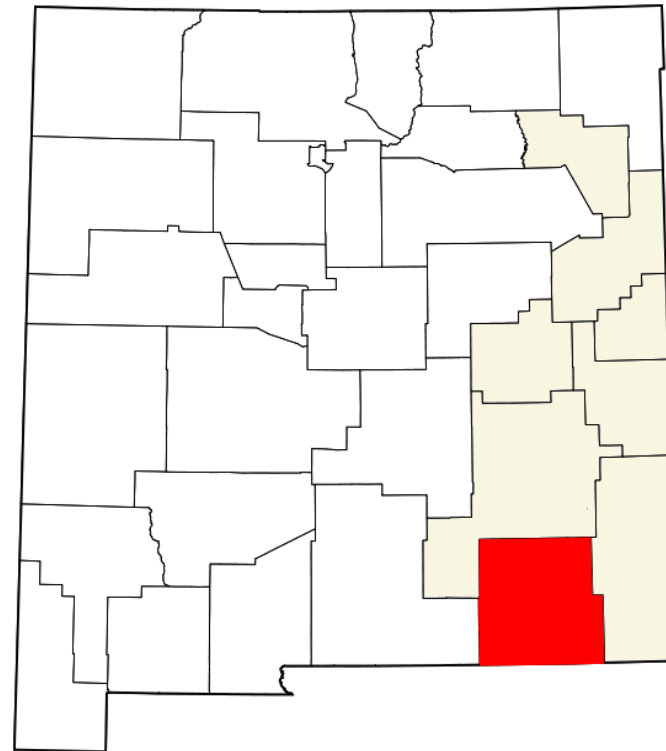

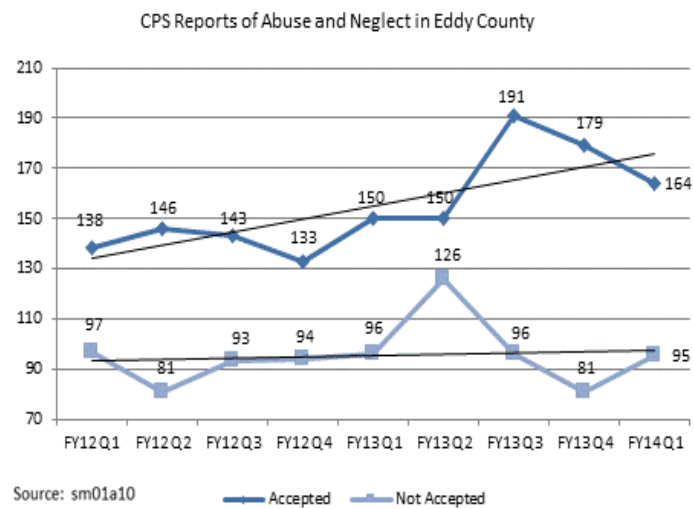

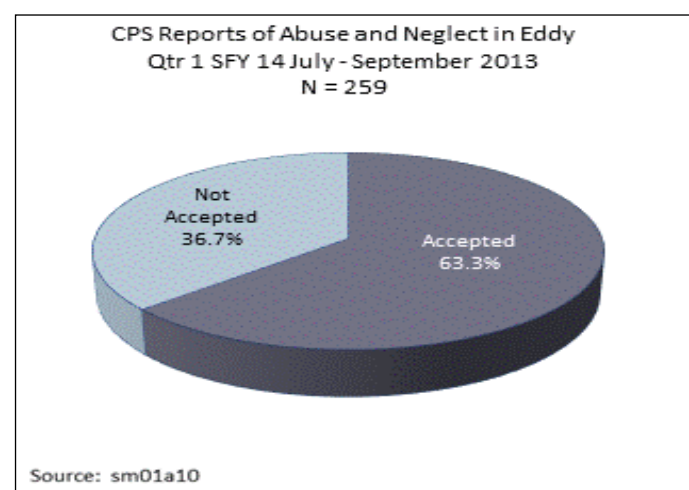

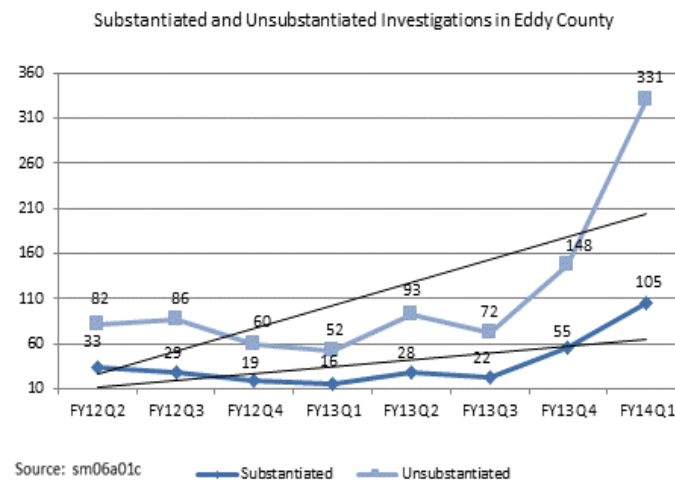

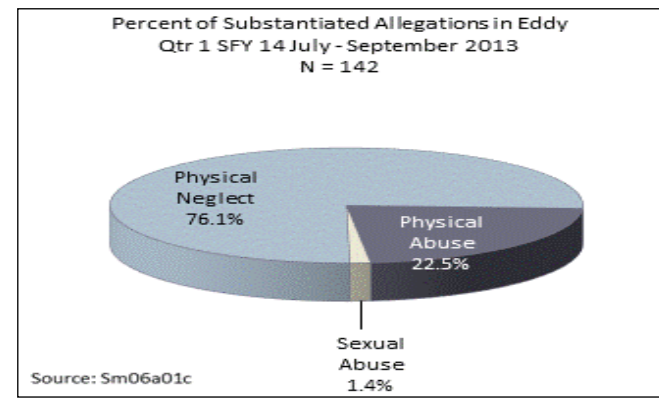

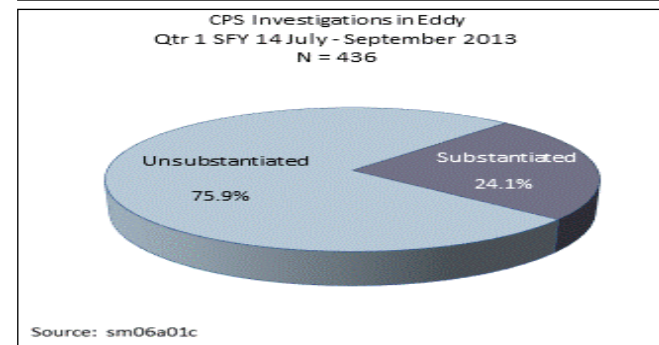

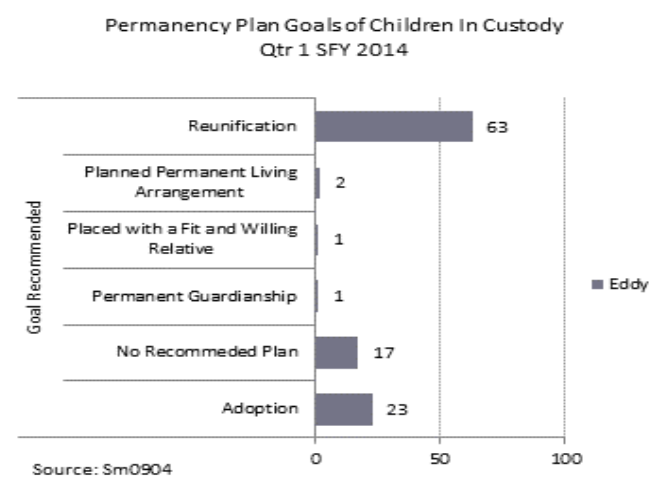

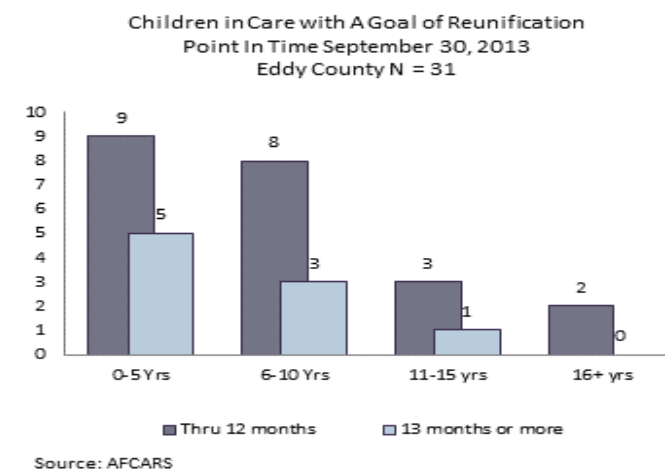

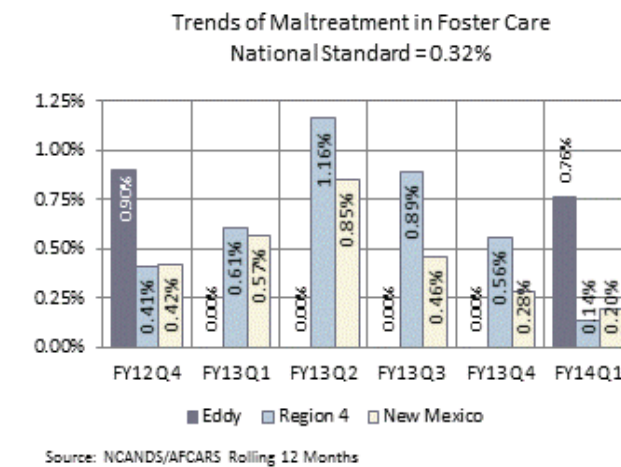

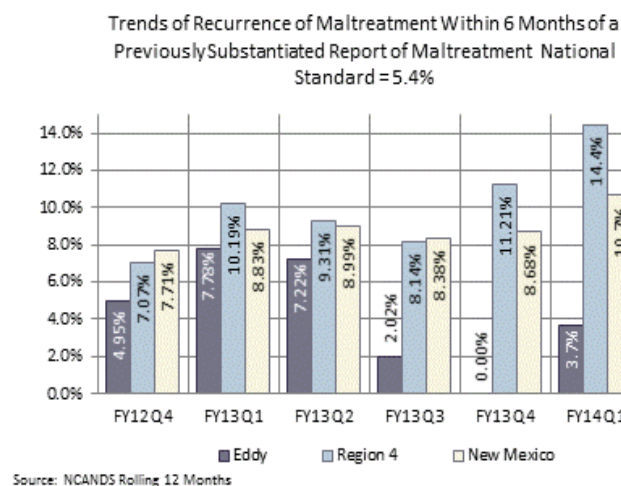

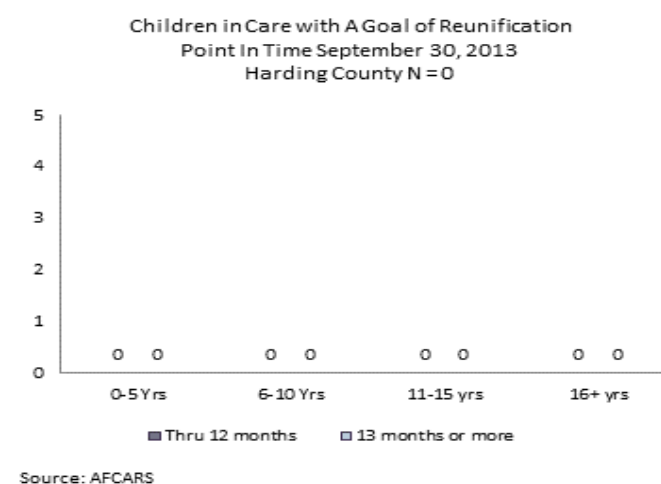

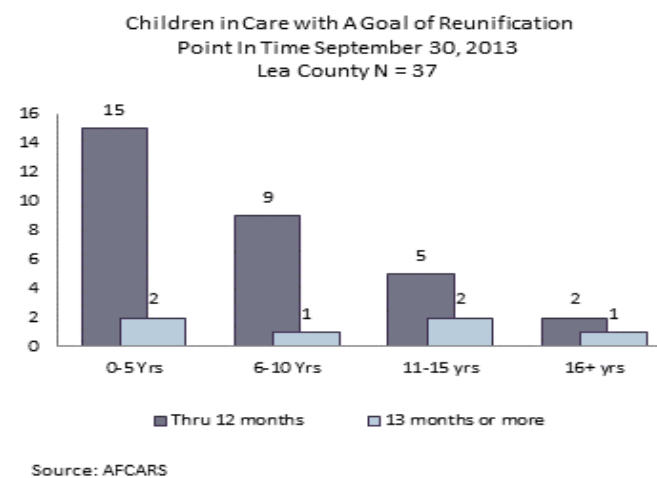

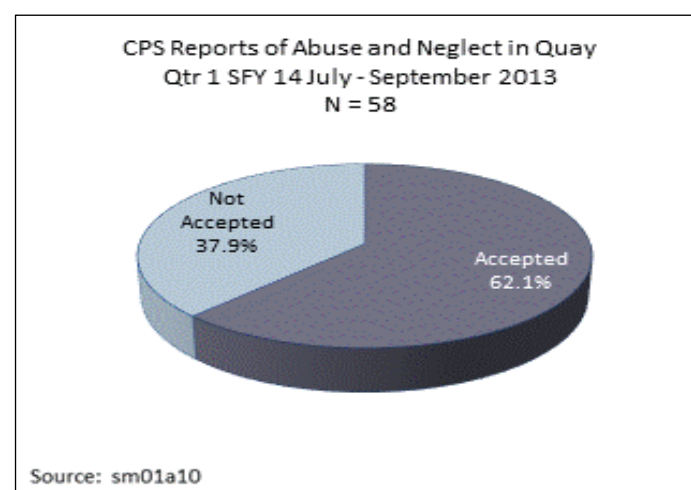

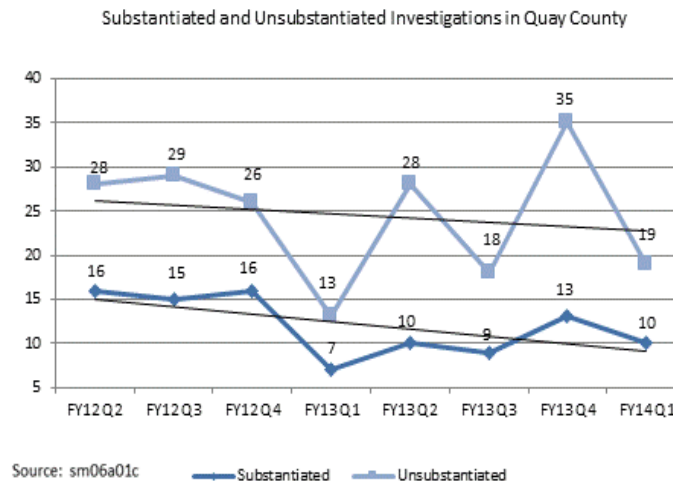

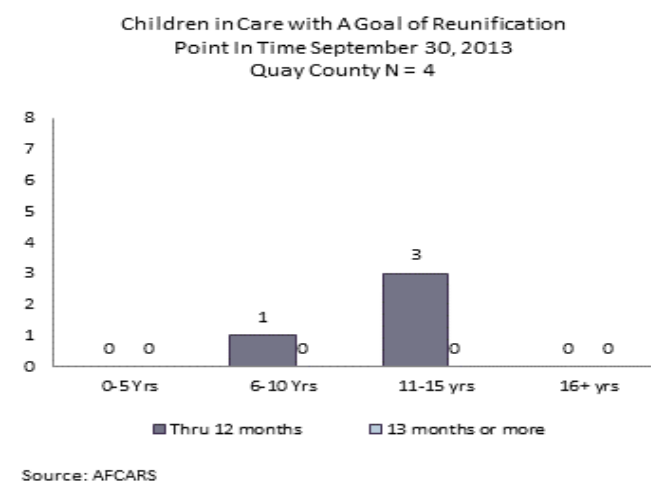

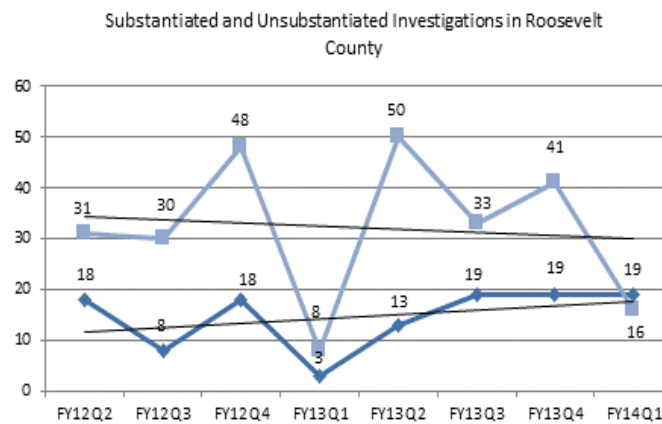


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Roosevelt County



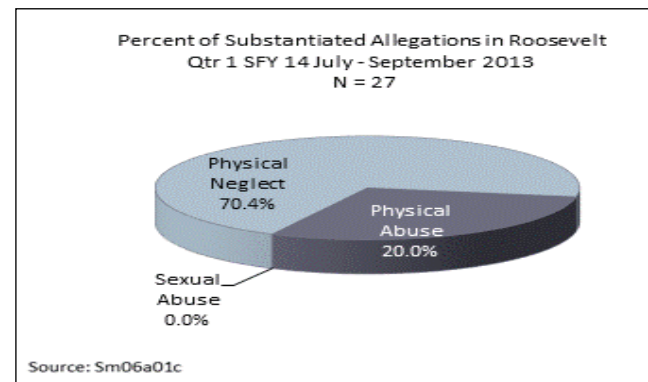

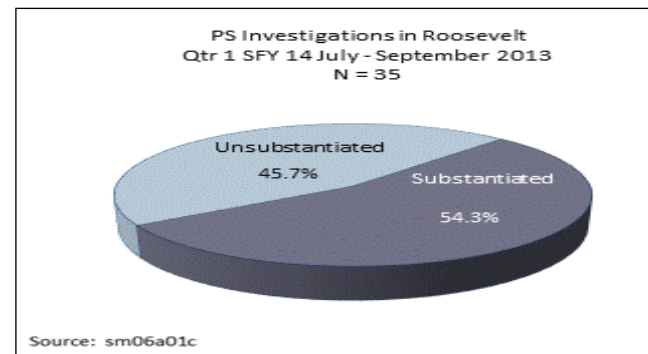

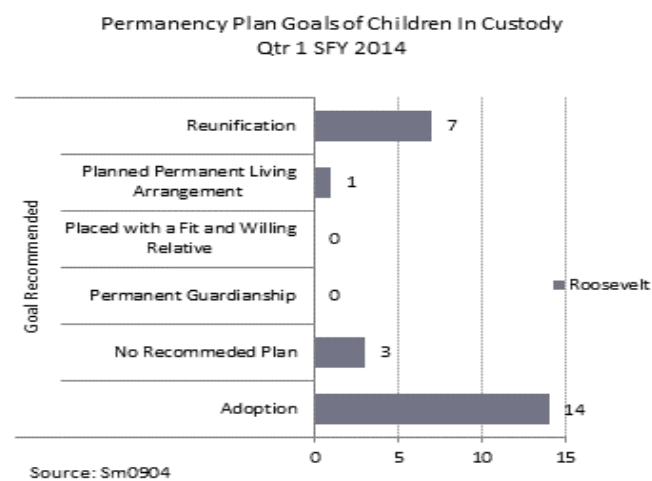

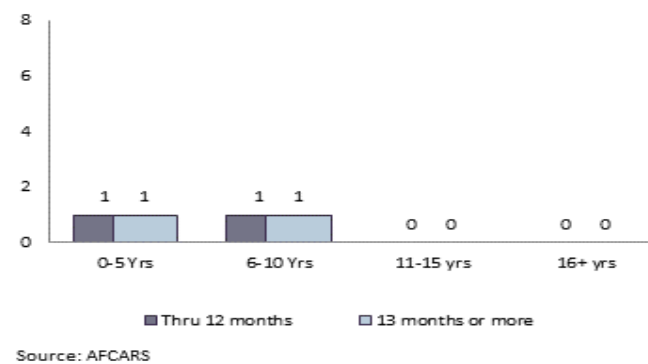

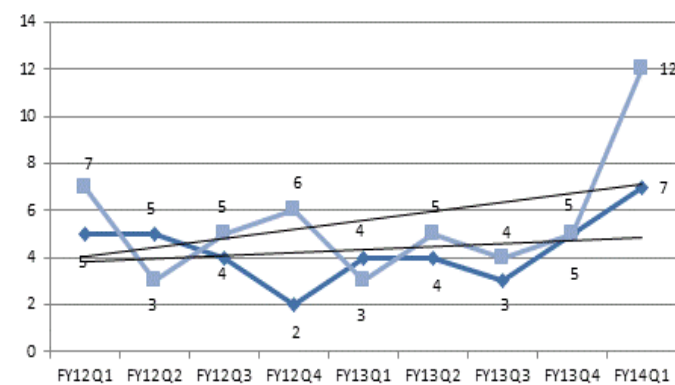

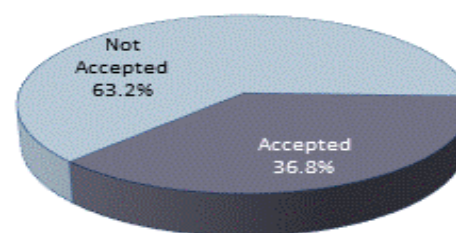
CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Catron County

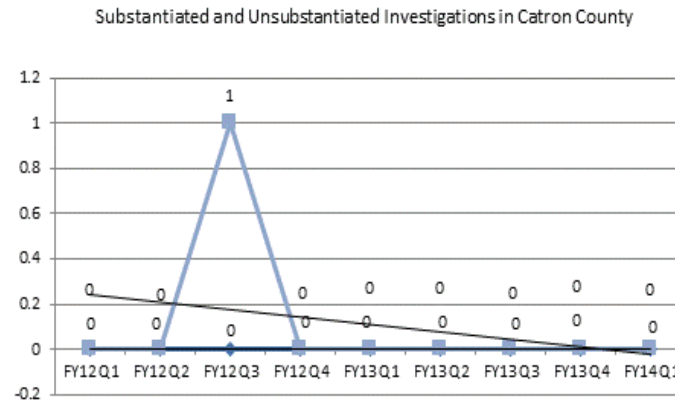

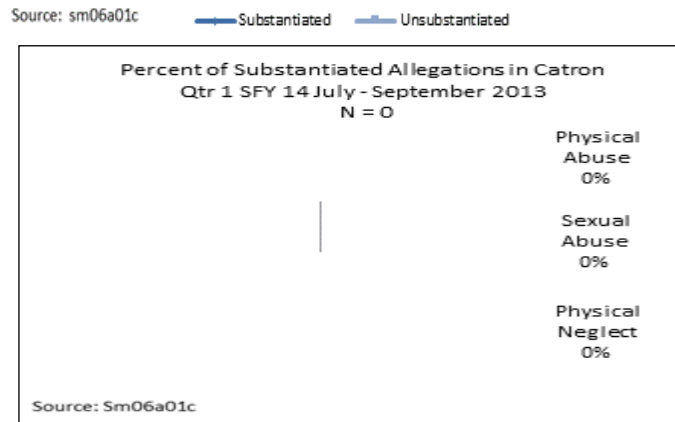

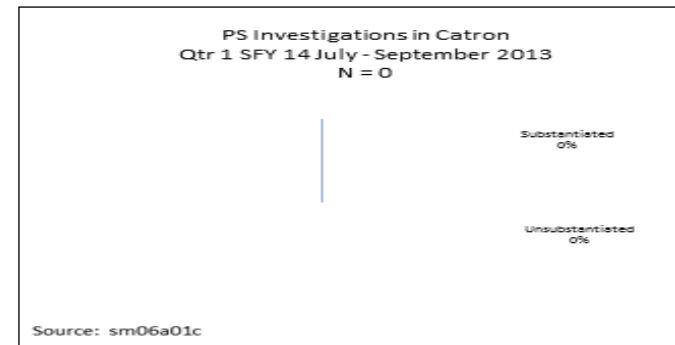

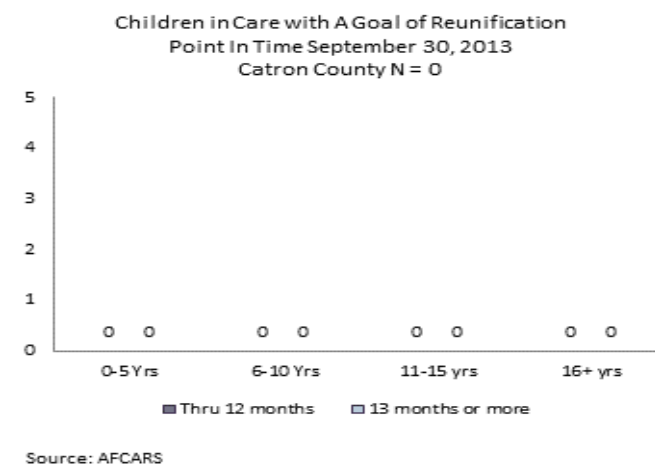

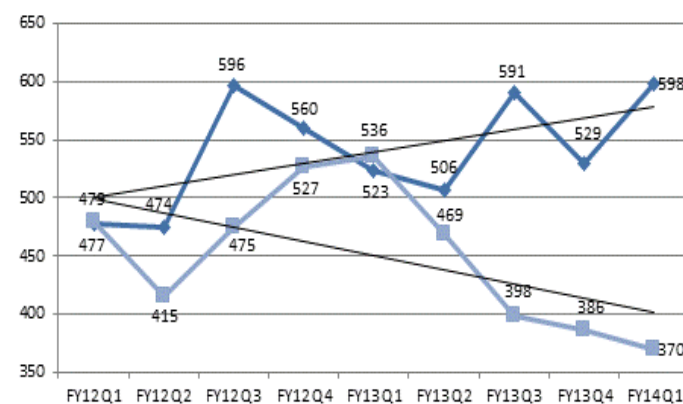

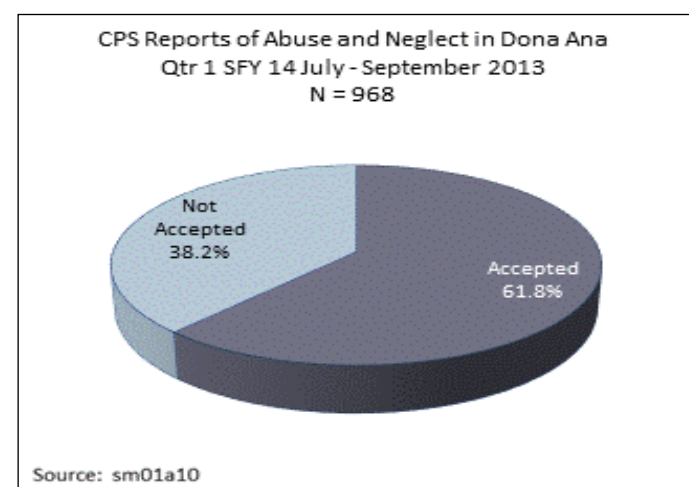


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Dona Ana County

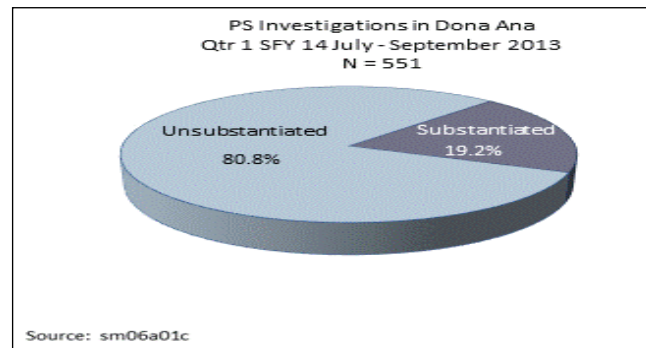

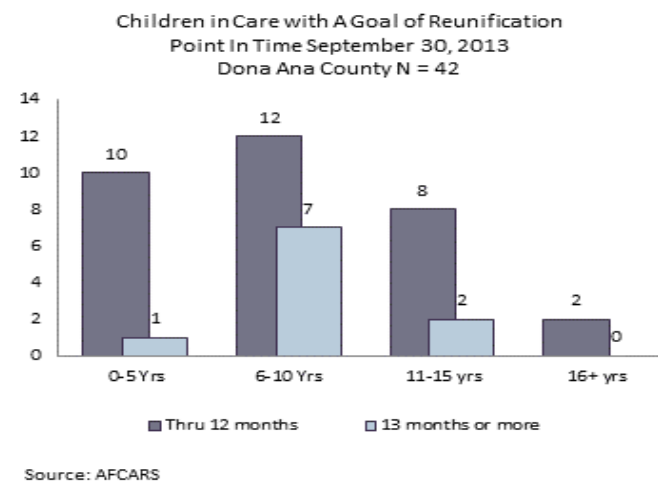

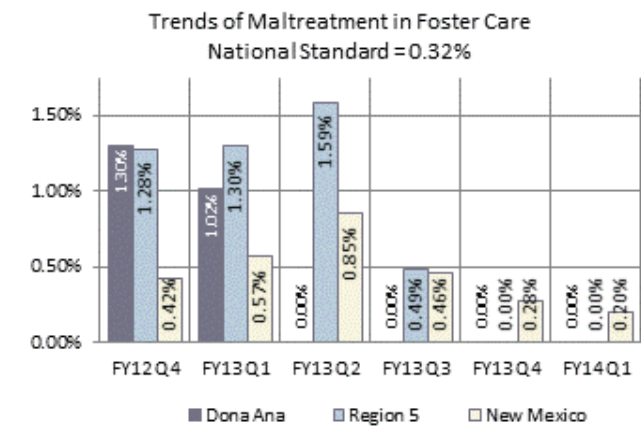

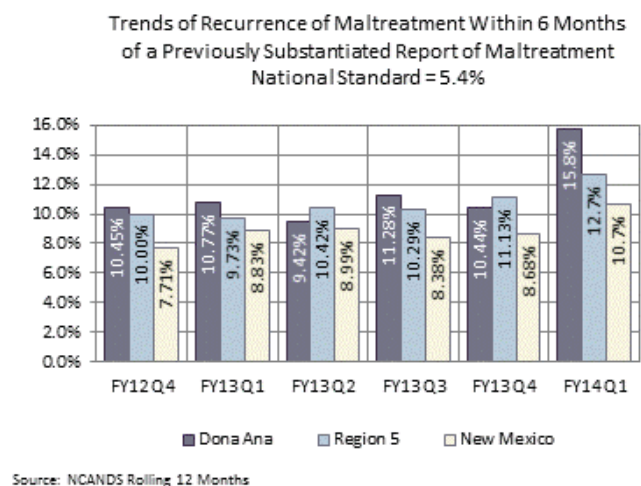

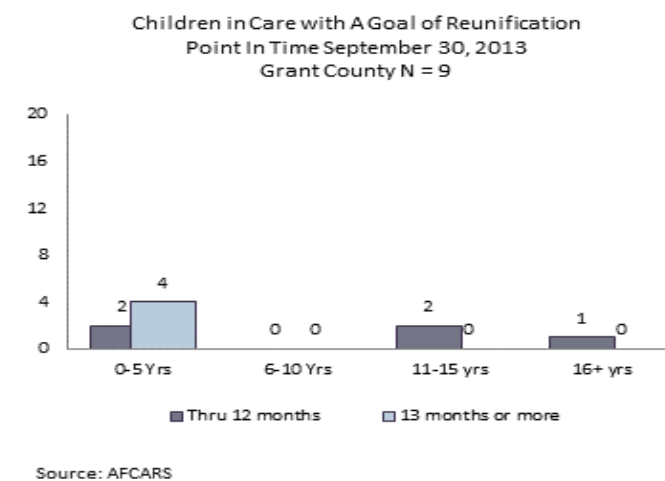

Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 09/30/2013



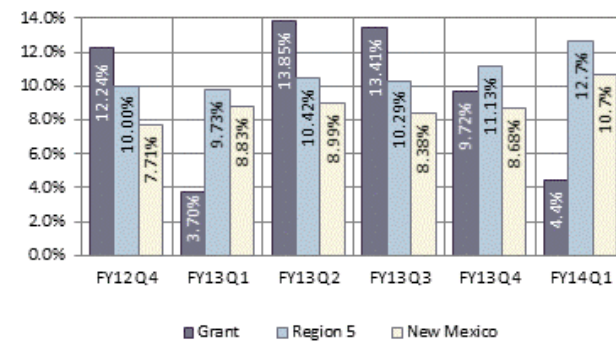

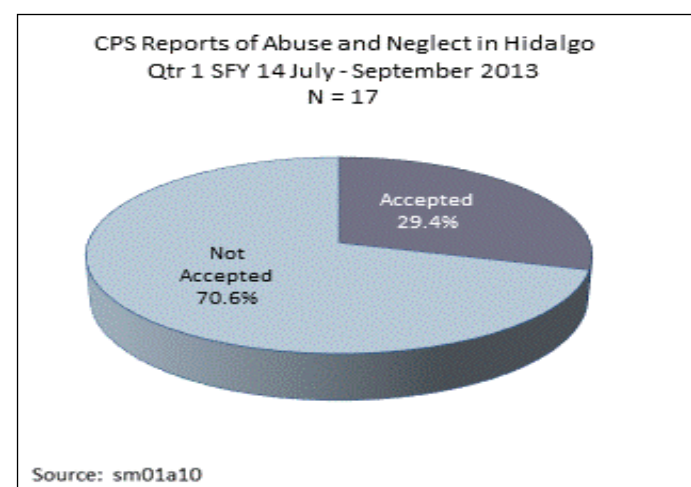

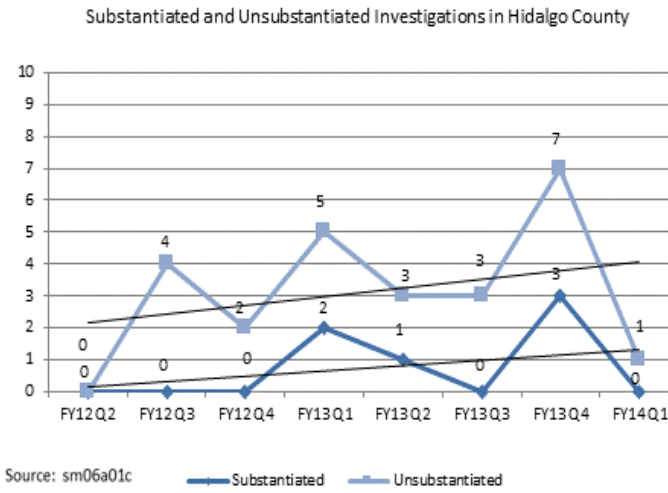

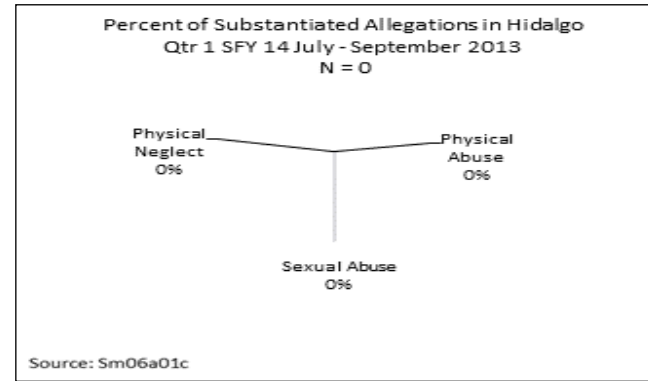

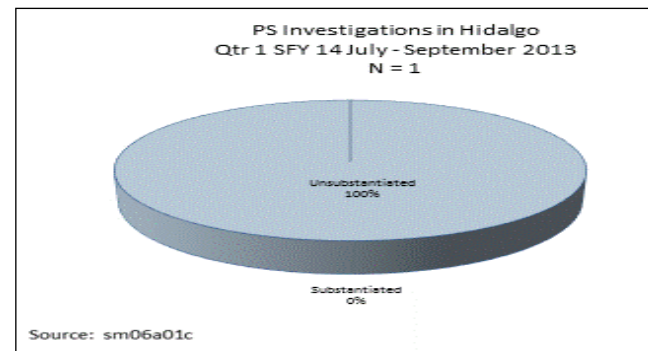

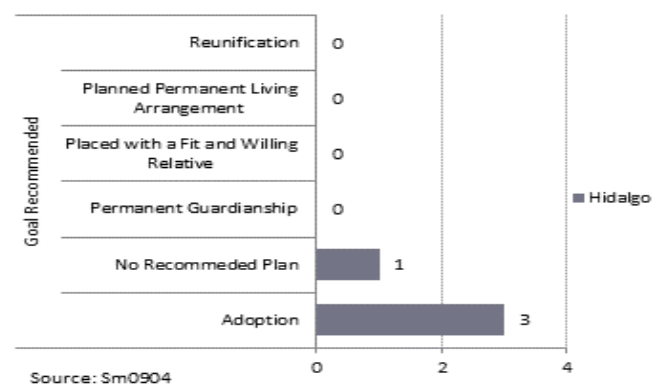

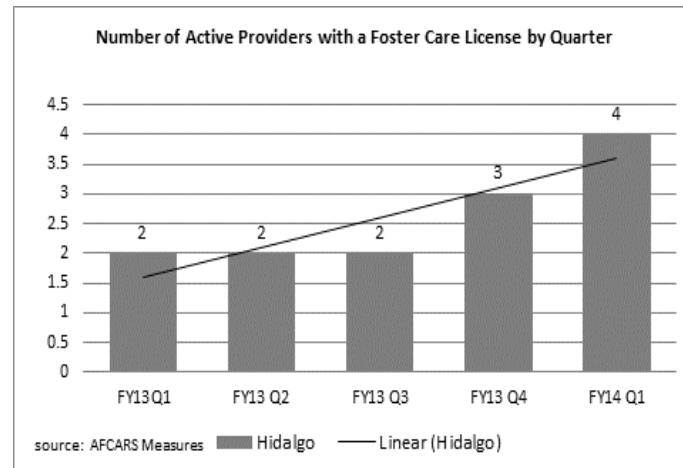
Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

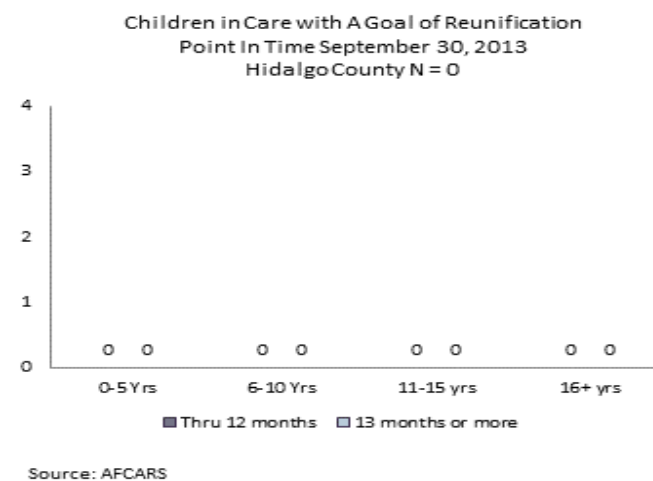

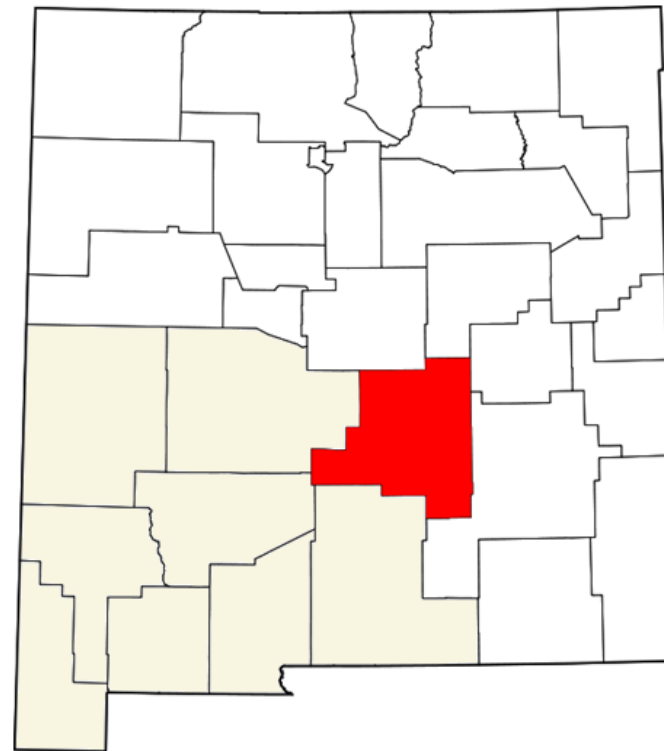

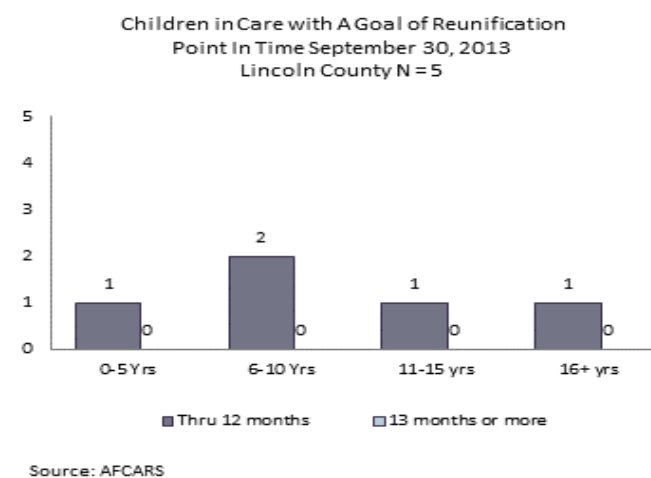

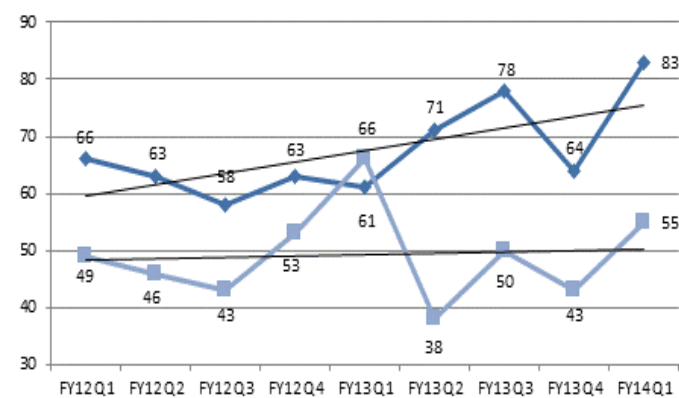

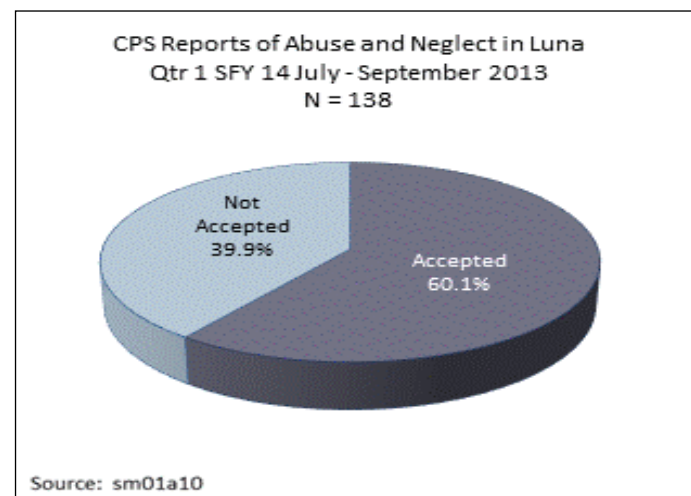

CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Luna County

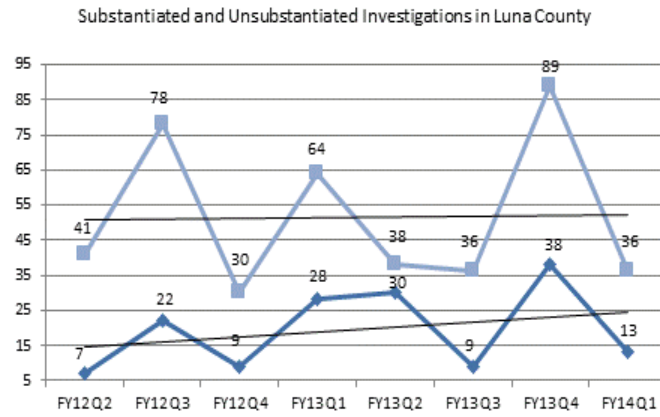

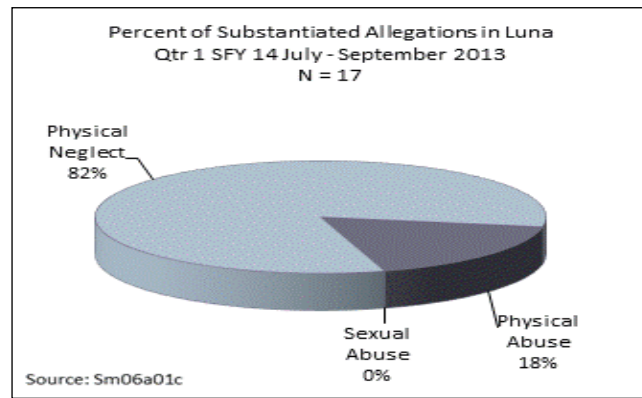

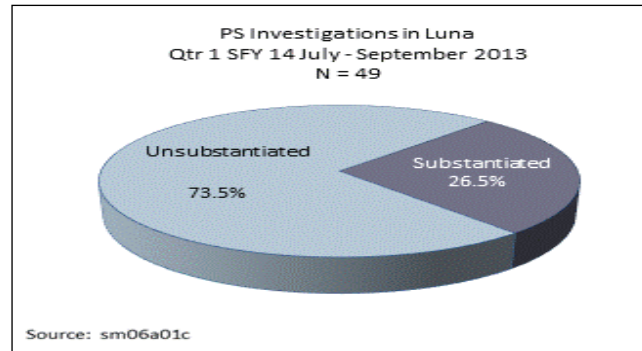

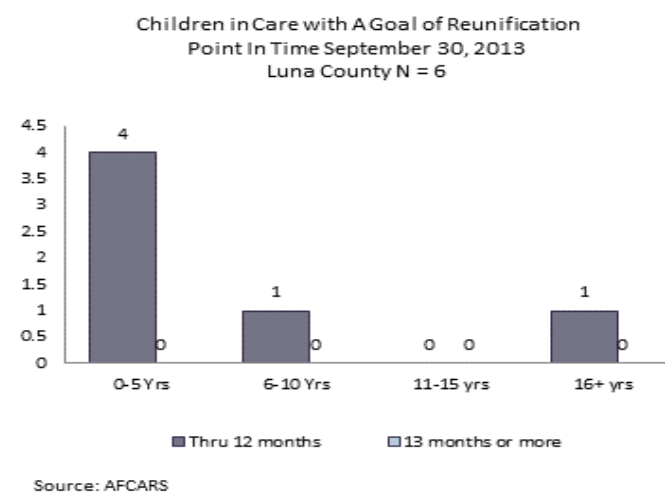

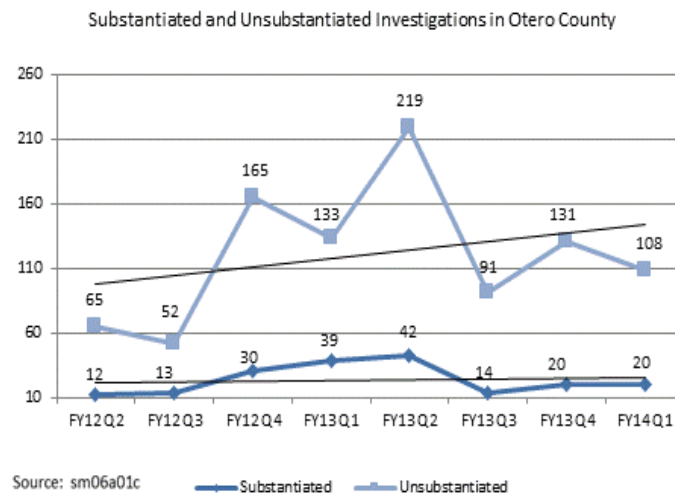

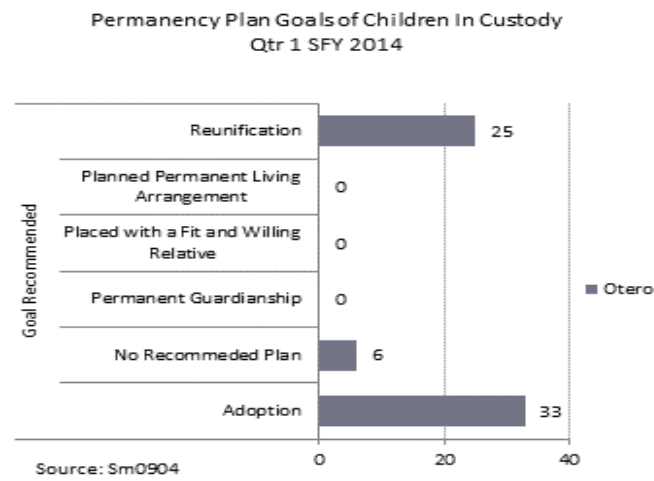

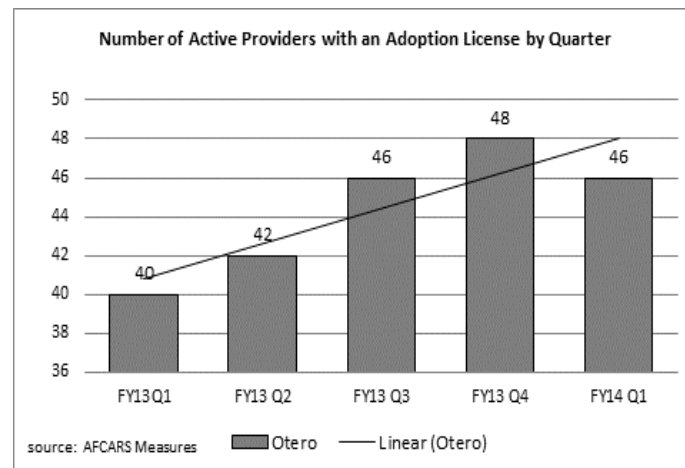

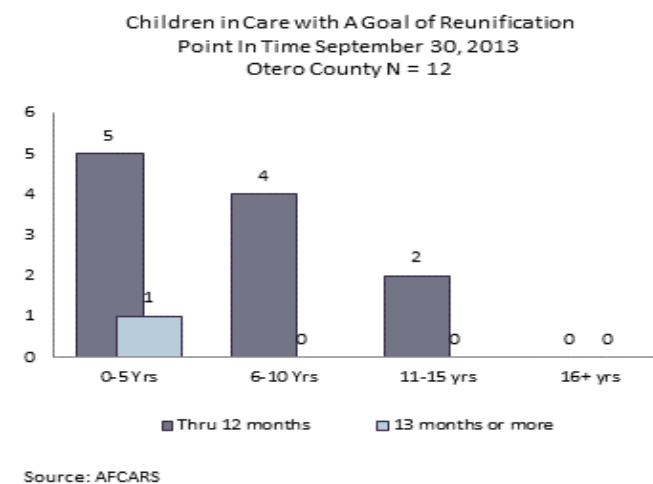

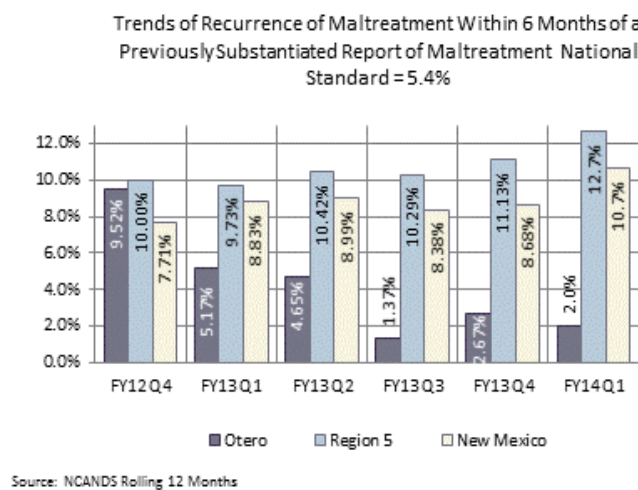

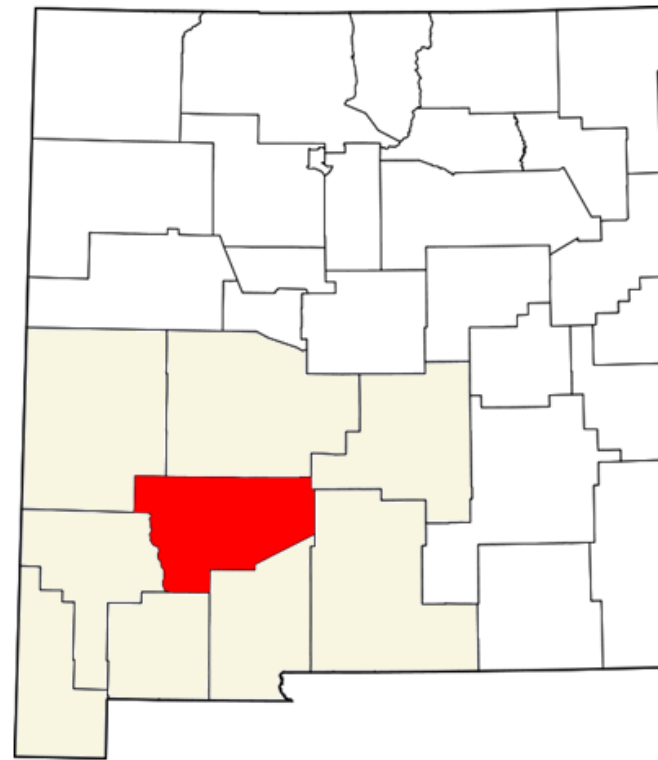

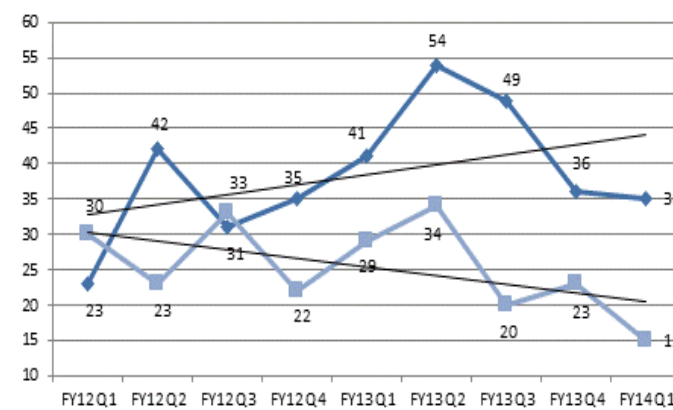

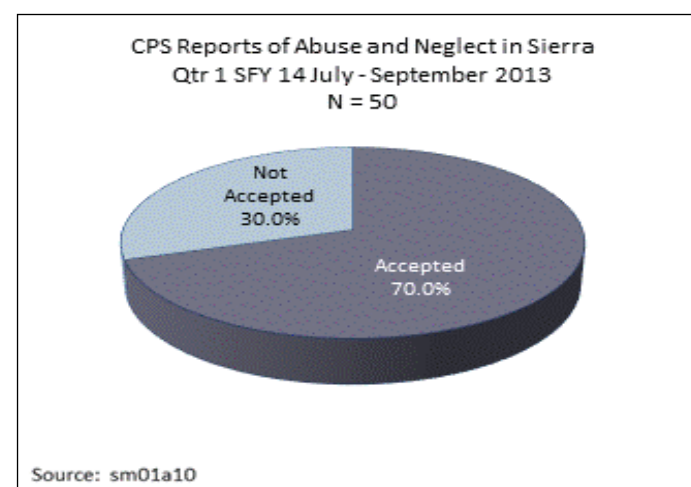


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Sierra County



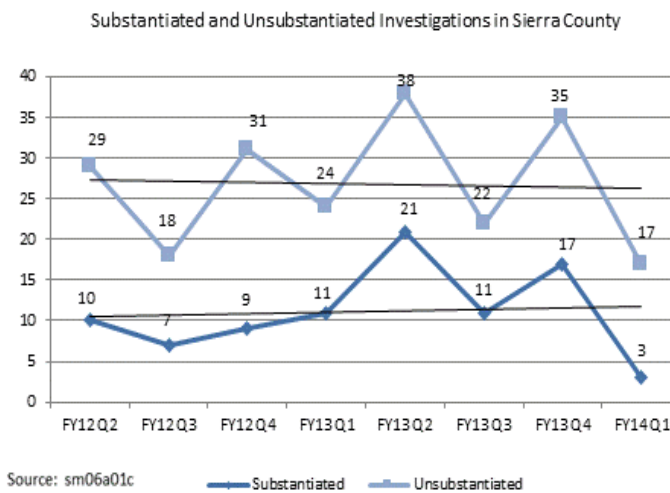

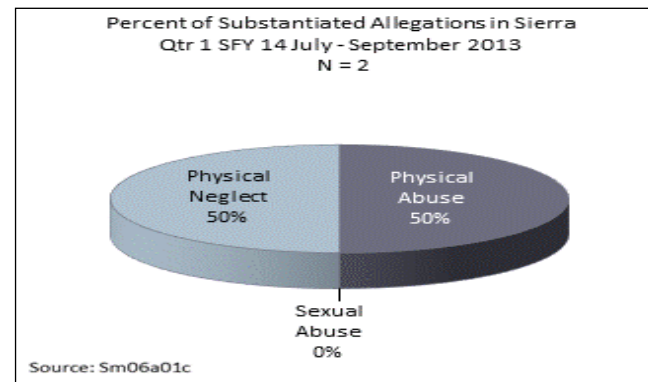

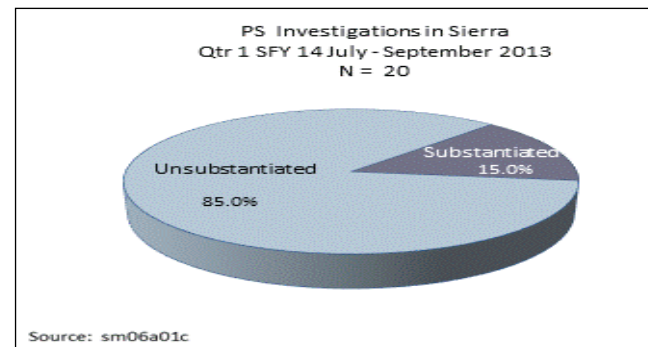

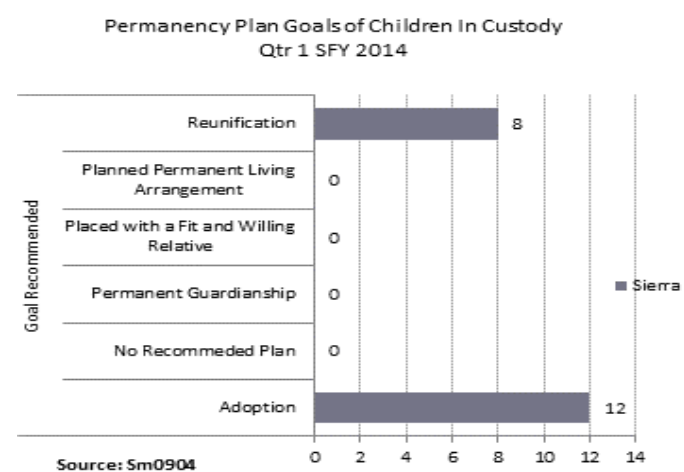
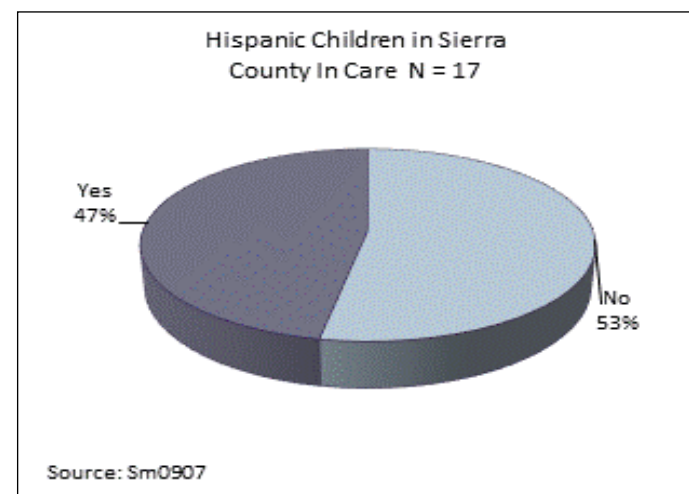
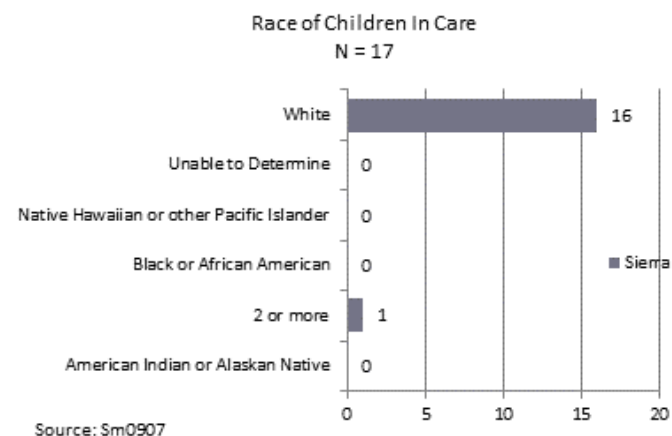

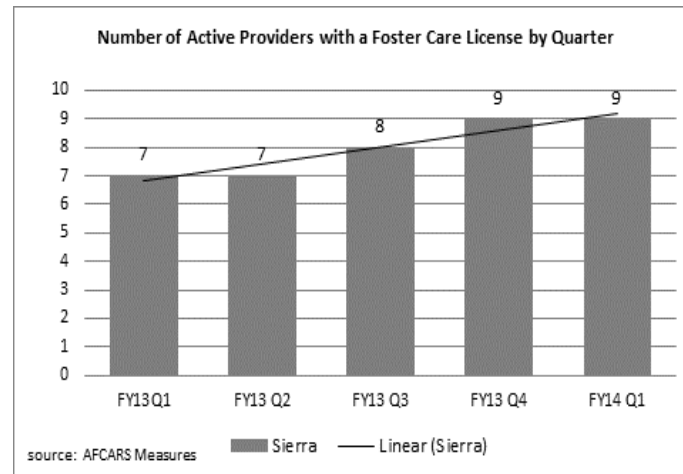

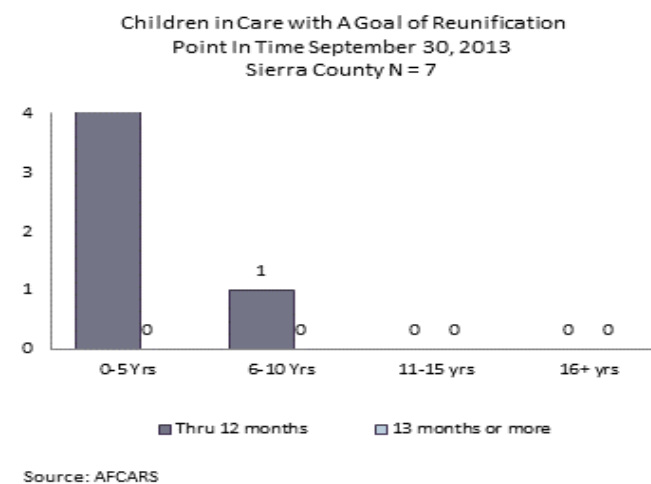

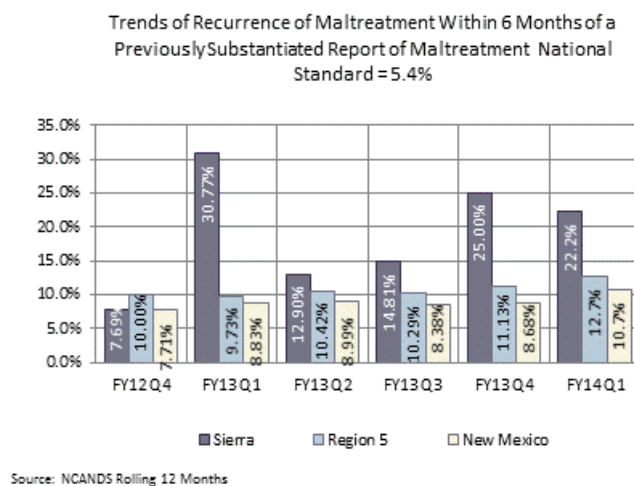

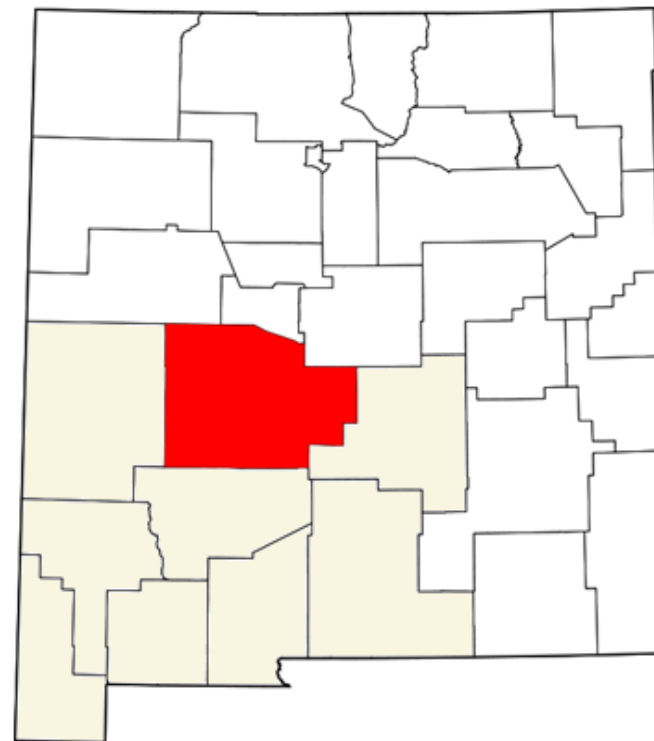

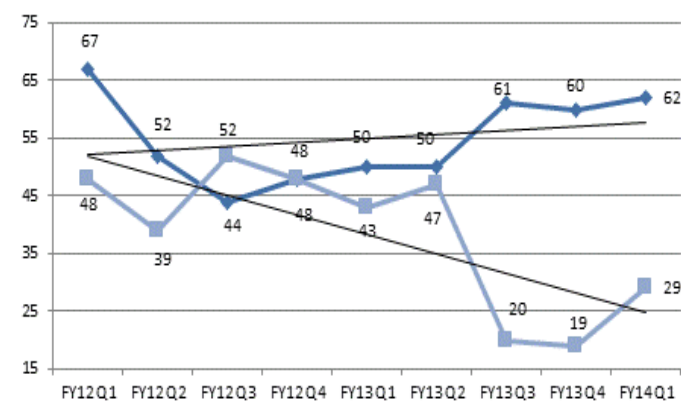

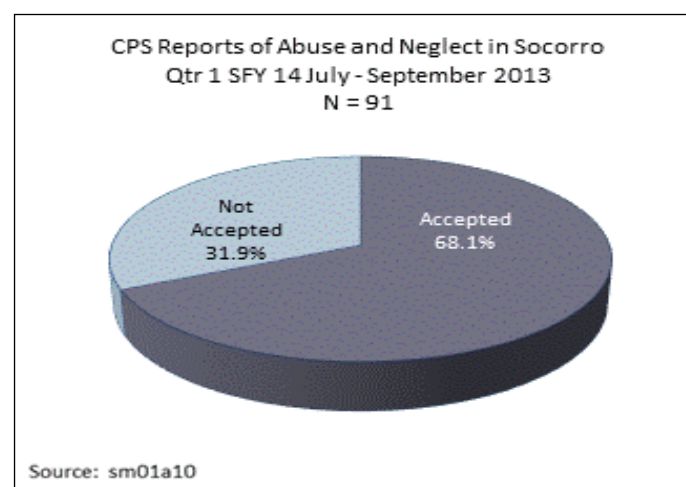


CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Socorro County



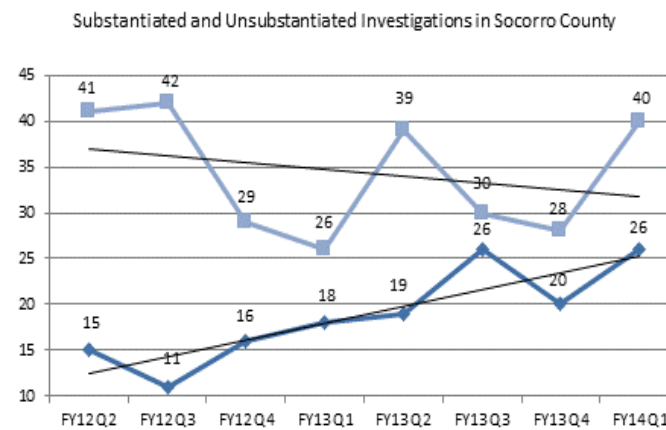

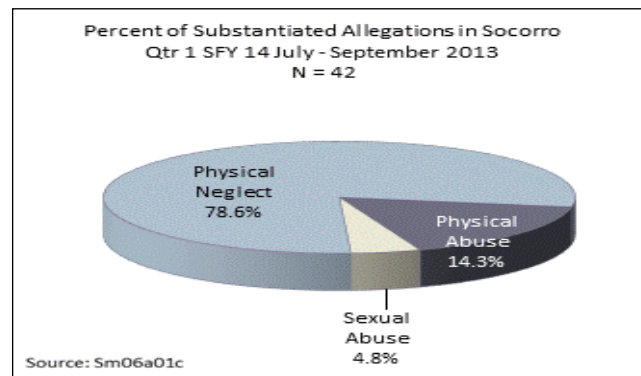

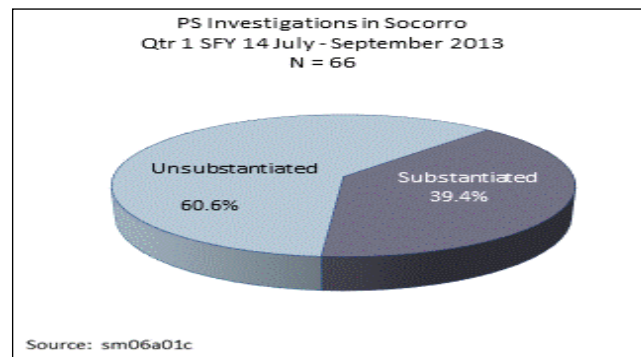
