





Average Months from The first "Adjudication Disposition Completed" to The First "Permanency Completed"









Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time December 31, 2012 Cibola County N = 15





Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care


Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time December 31, 2012 McKinley County N = 27





Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%

Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012




Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time December 31, 2012 San Juan County N = 41





Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%




Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time December 31, 2012 Sandoval County N = 50










CPS Investigations in Torrance Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 64



Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%






Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012




CPS Investigations in Valencia








Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time December 31, 2012 Valencia County N = 74








Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%




Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




CPS Investigations in Guadalupe Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 2






Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%






Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody Qtr 2 SFY 2013












Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%




Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody Qtr 2 SFY 2013










Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%

Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012












Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody Qtr 2 SFY 2013










Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%






Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%

Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%



Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%










Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%



Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%






Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care






PS Investigations in Dona Ana


Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%


Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012




Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%


Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care

PS Investigations in Hidalgo Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 4








Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%








Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012







CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Otero Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 241










Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care


Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012







CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Sierra Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 88










Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%


Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012

PS Investigations in Socorro Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 58




Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time December 31, 2012 Soccore County N = 3





Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%




Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%
