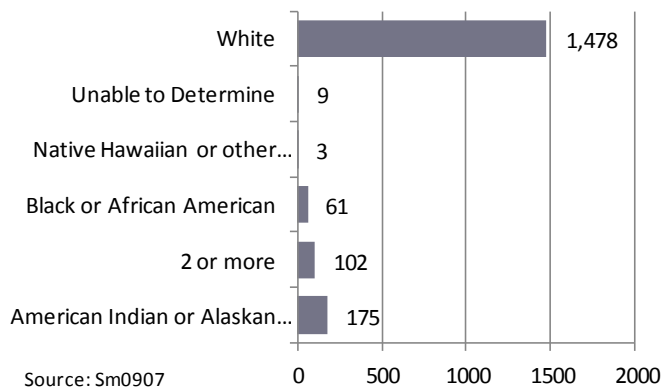

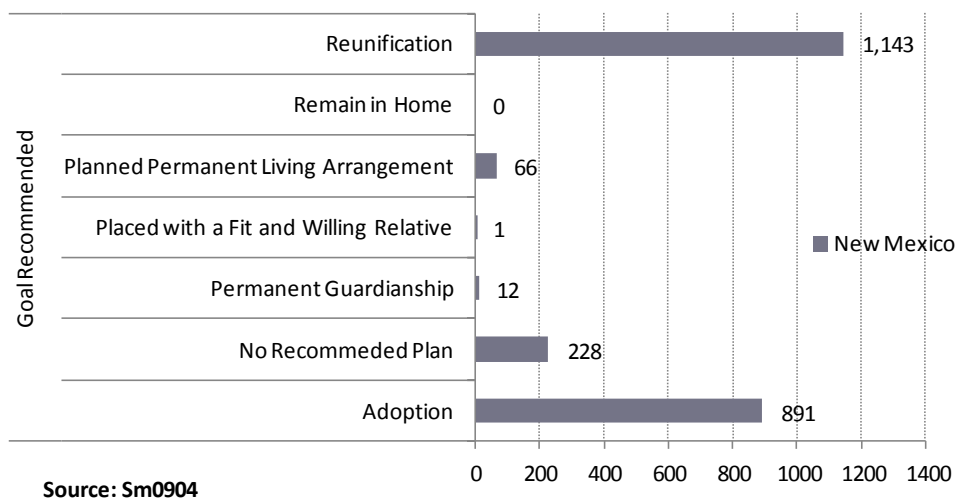

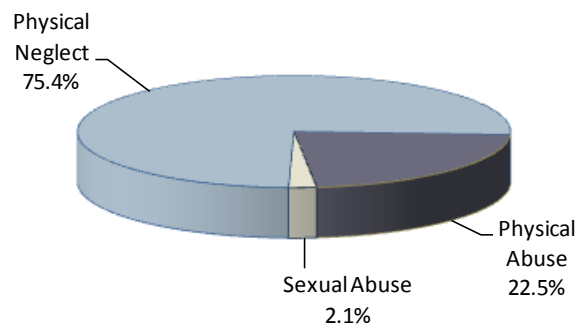

Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012

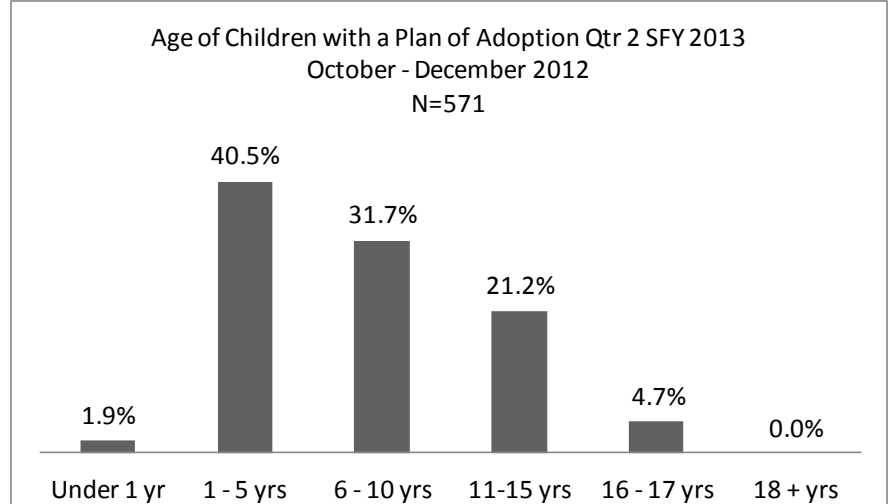

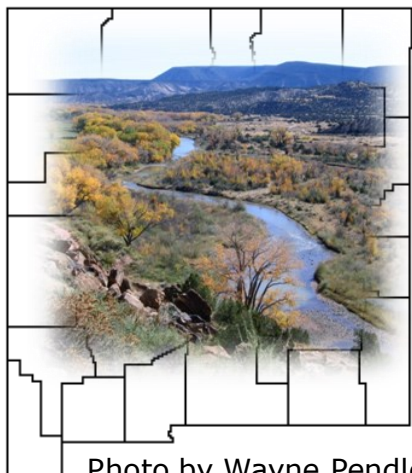


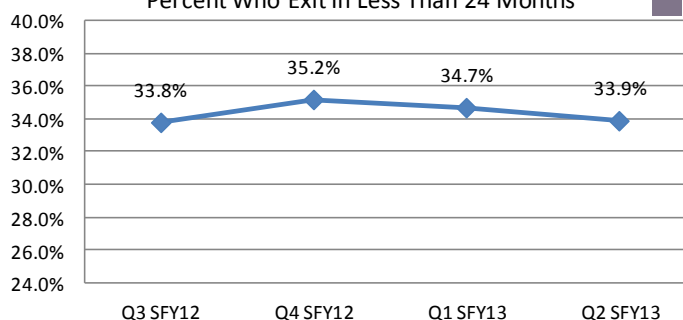

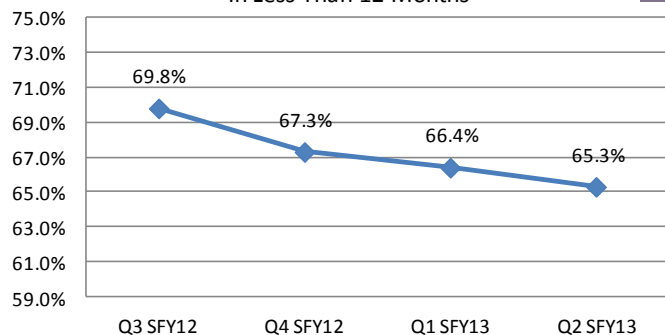
### Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System (AFCARS) Permanency Measures

Percent Who Exit In Less Than 24 Months



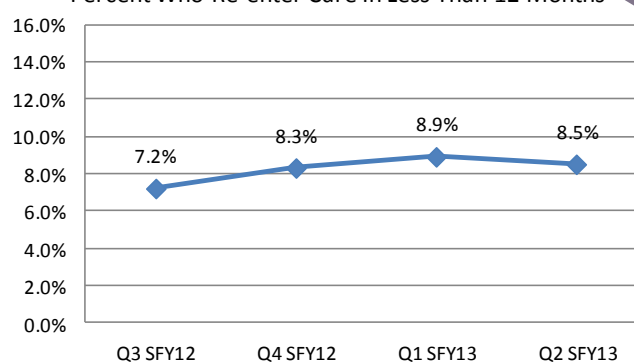

Percent Who Re-enter Care In Less Than 12 Months



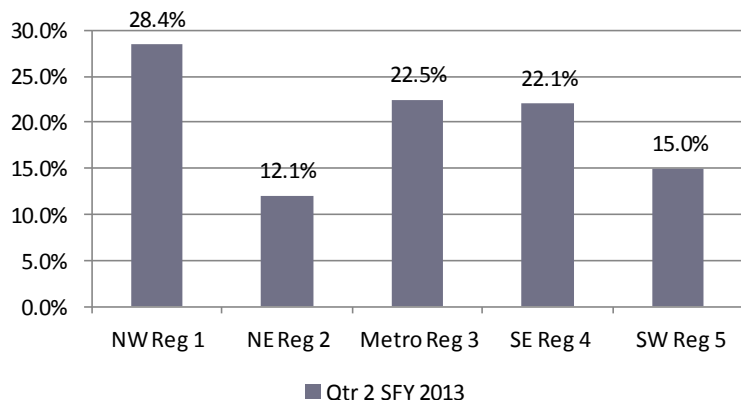

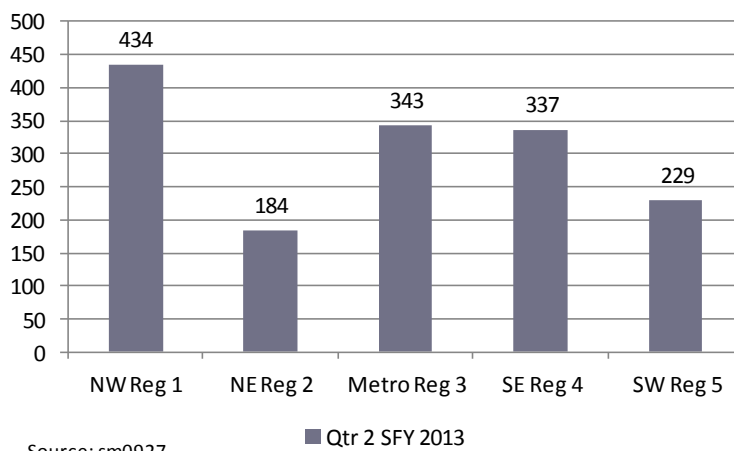

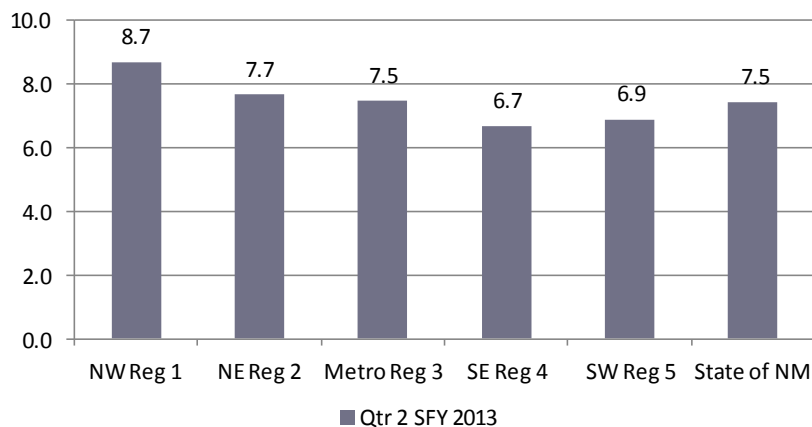

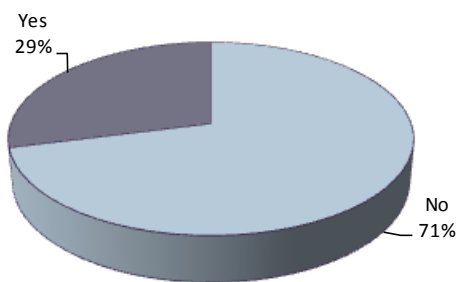
Cibola County had 2.1% of NM Protective Service's total children "in care" as of December 31, 2012, which is more than expected, based on population alone.

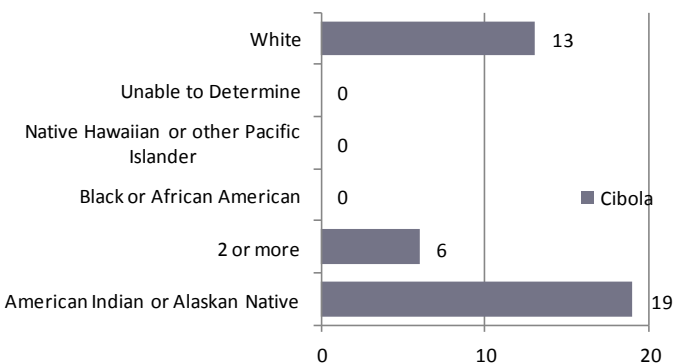

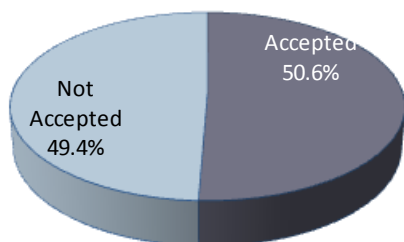

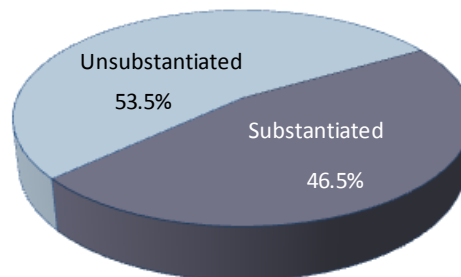

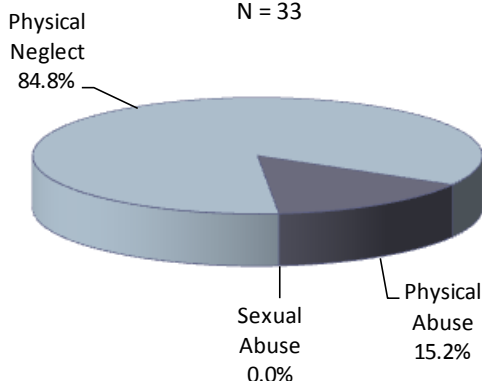

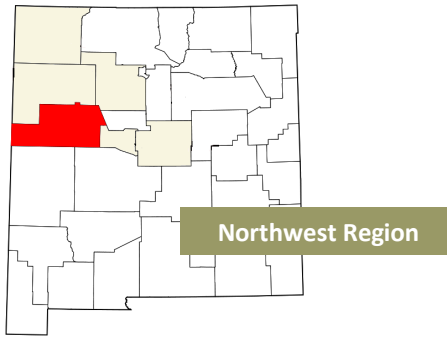

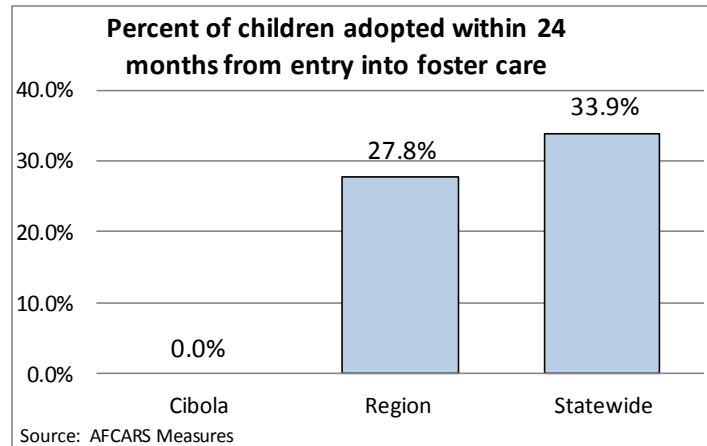
Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

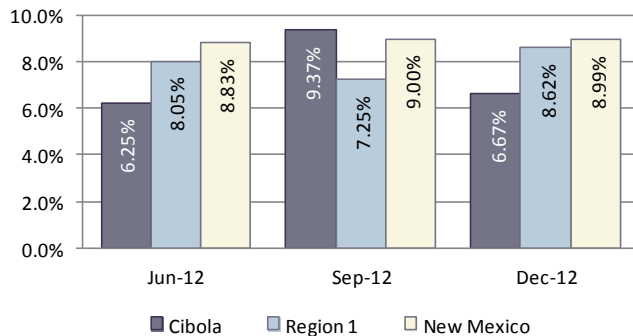

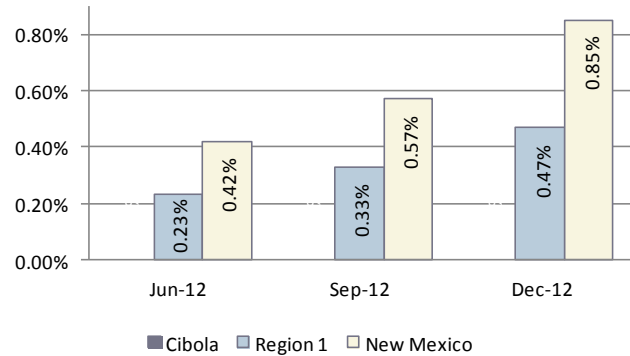


### National Child Abuse and Neglect Data System (NCANDS) Safety Measures

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

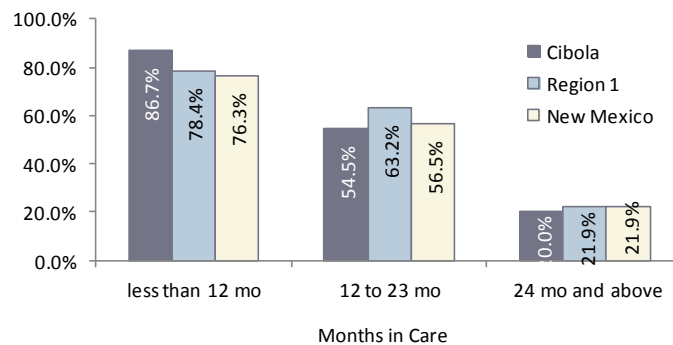


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

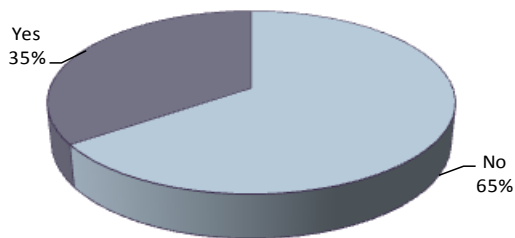

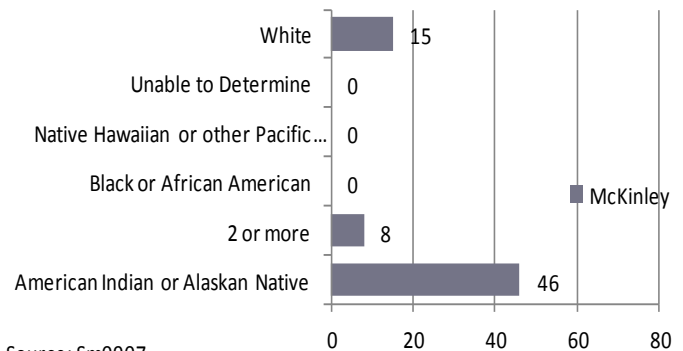
## Hispanic Children in McKinley County In Care N = 69

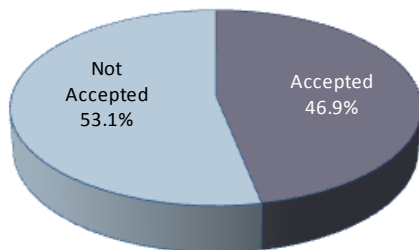

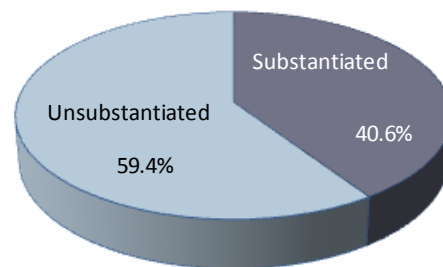

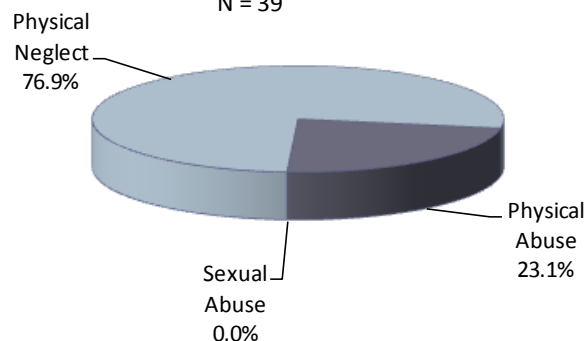
CPS Investigations in McKinley

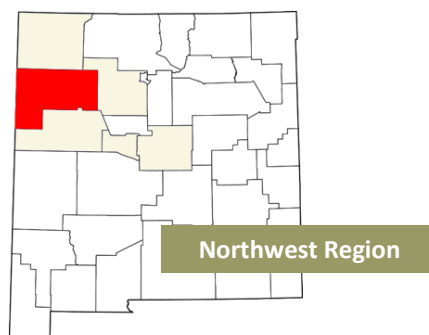

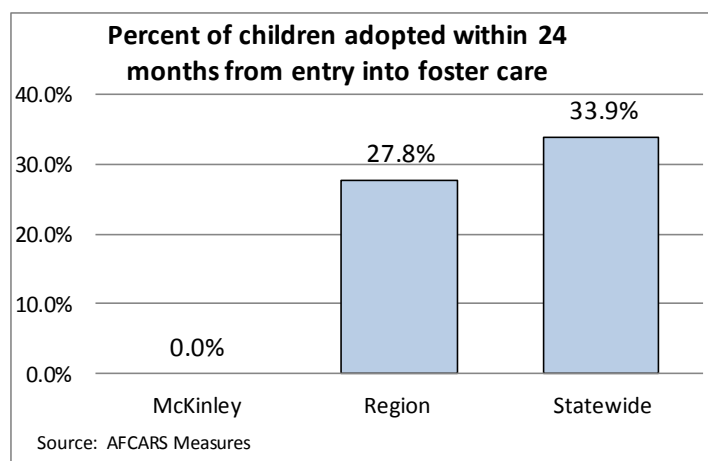
Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

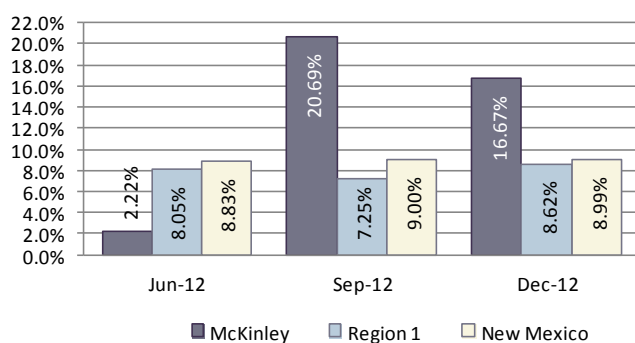

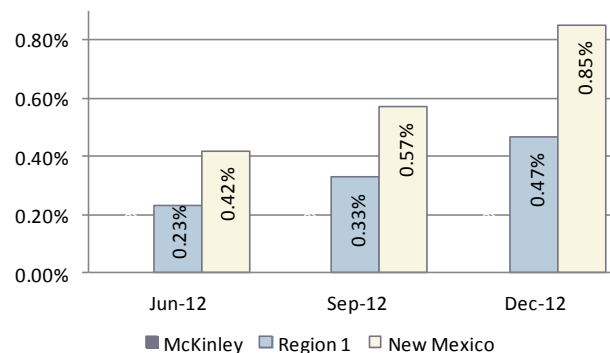


## National Child Abuse and Neglect Data System (NCANDS) Safety Measures

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

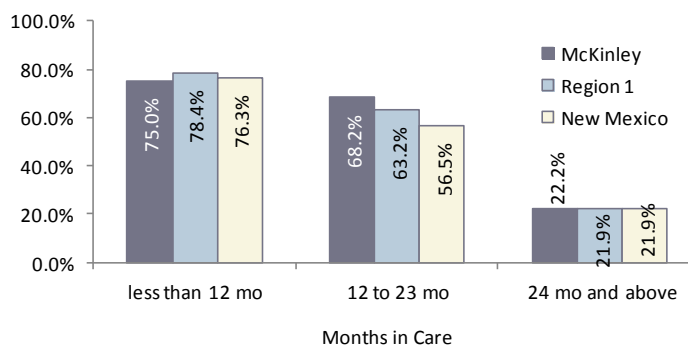


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

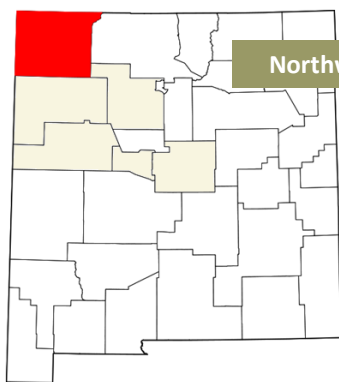

total children under 20, San Juan County had 4.9% of NM Protective Service's total children "in care" as of December 31, 2012, which is less than expected, based on population alone.

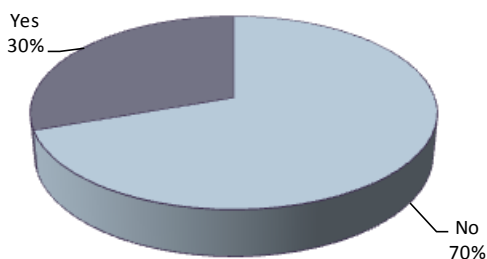

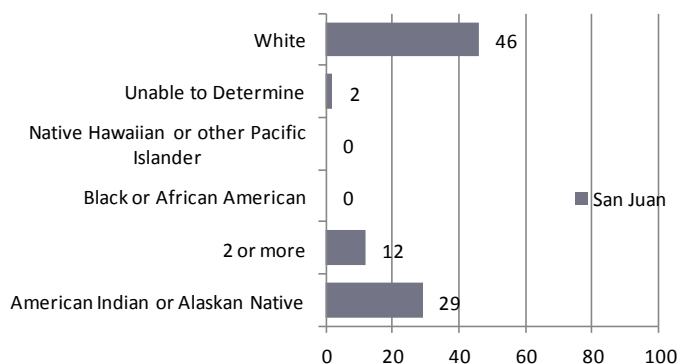

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

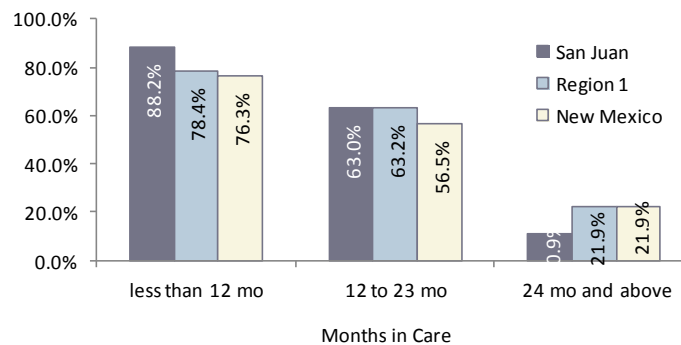


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

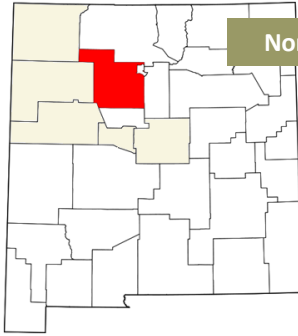

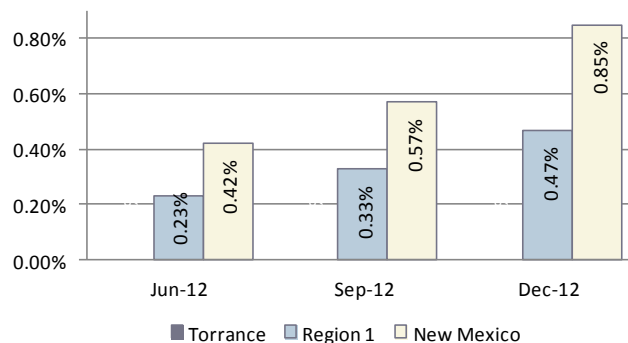

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

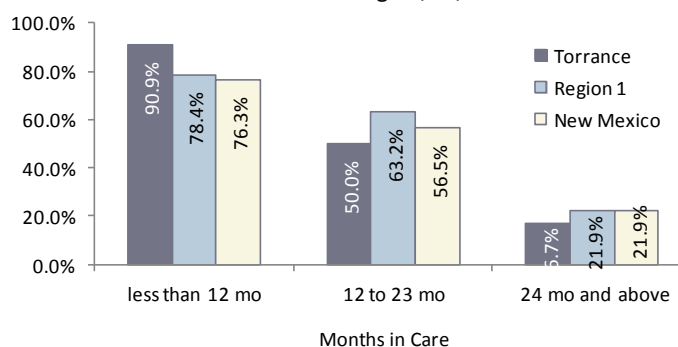


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

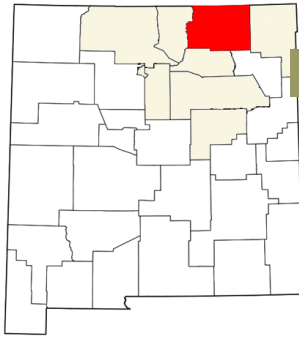

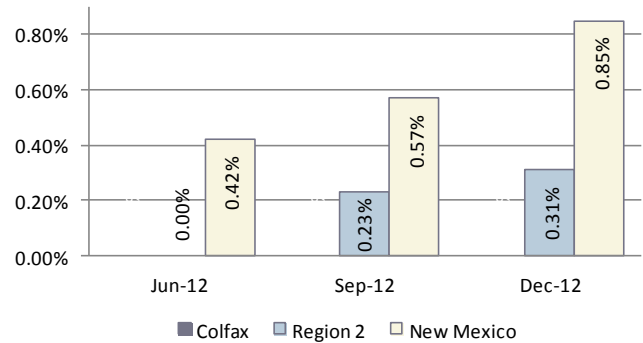

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

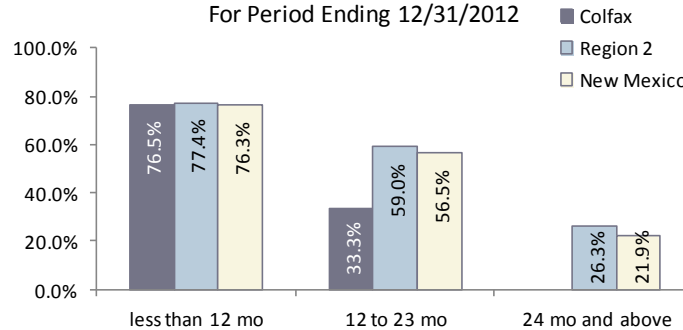


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

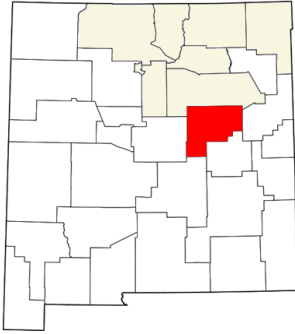

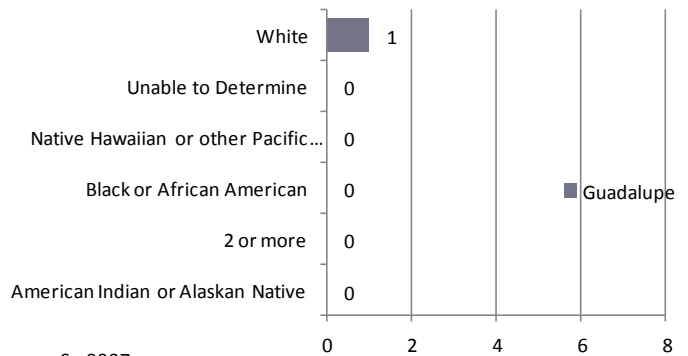

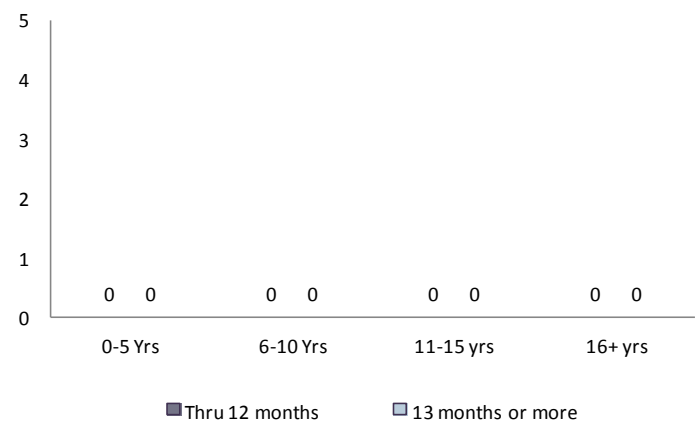


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

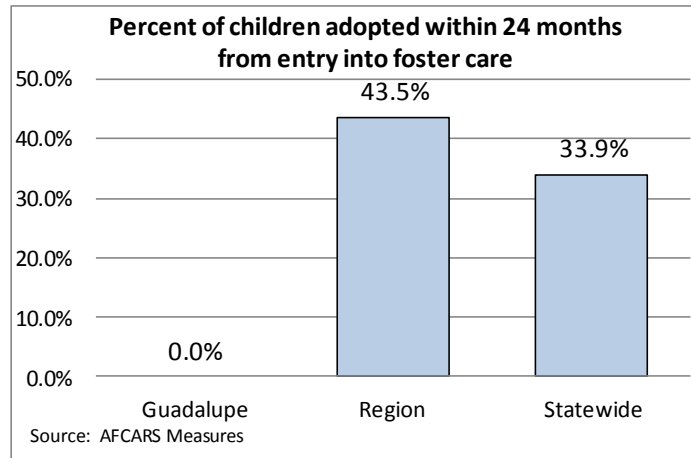

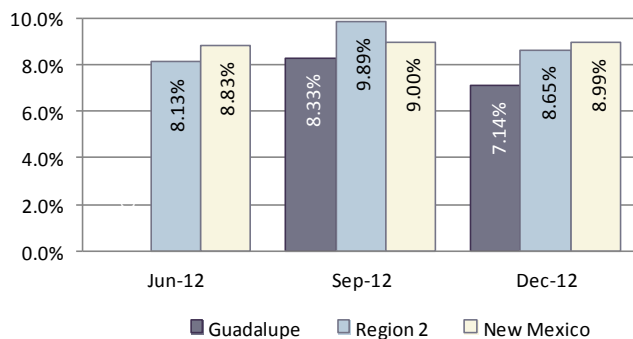

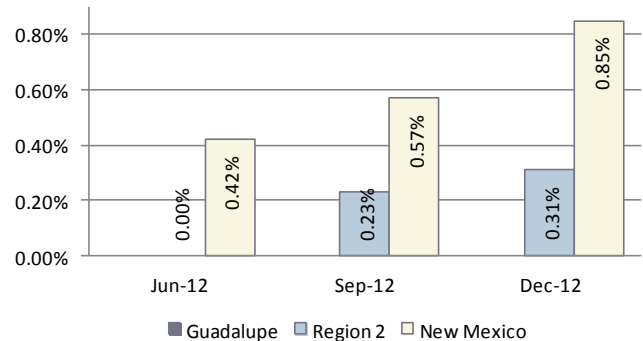

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

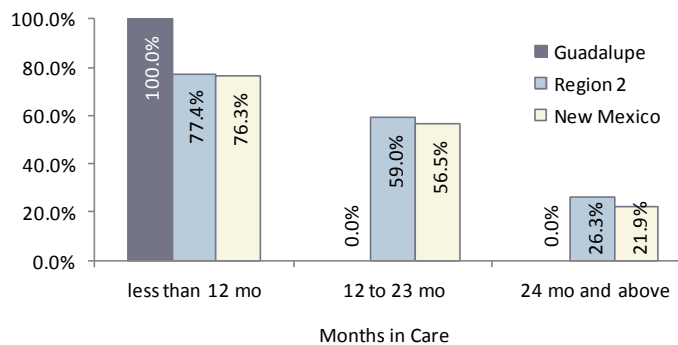

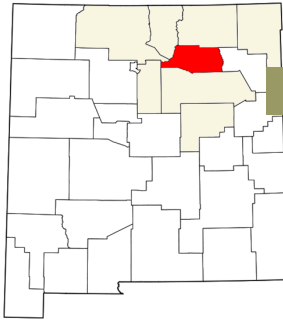

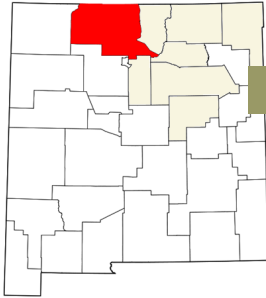

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

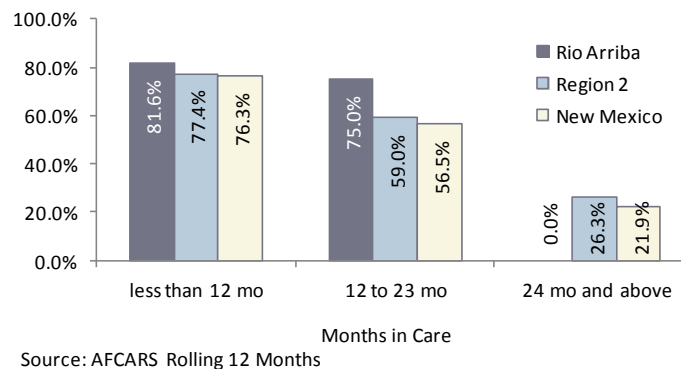


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%

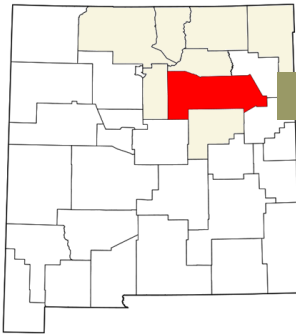

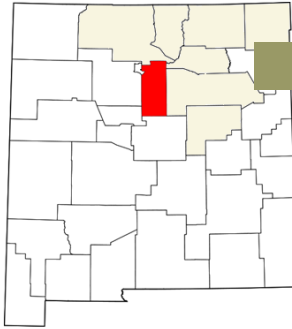

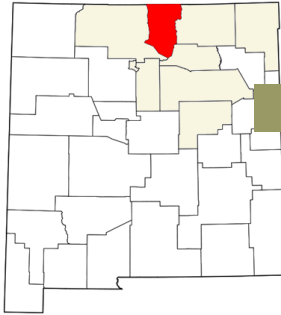

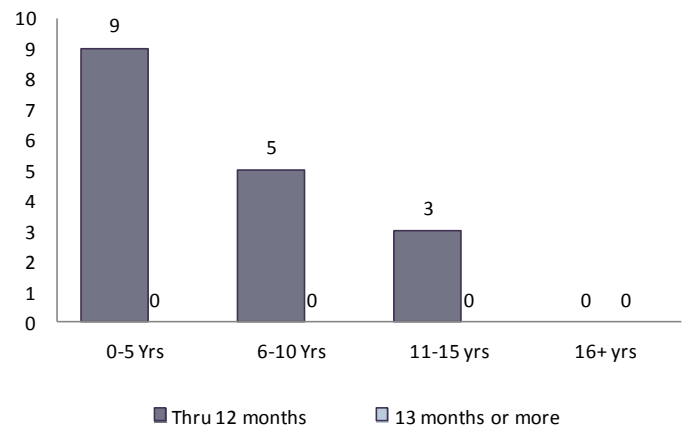


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

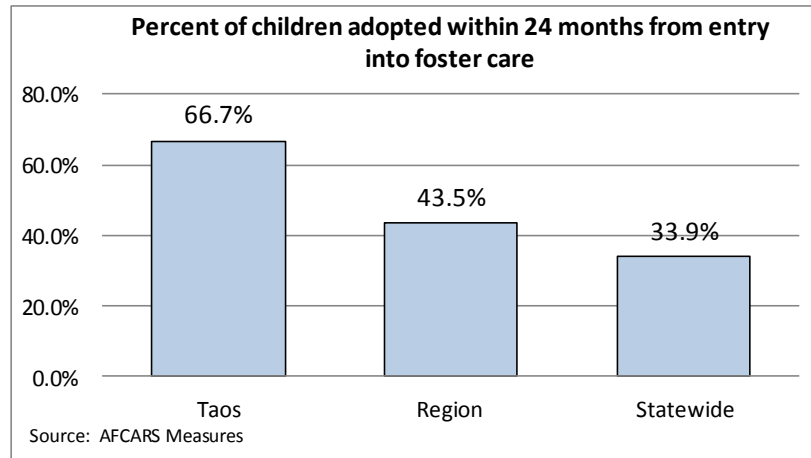

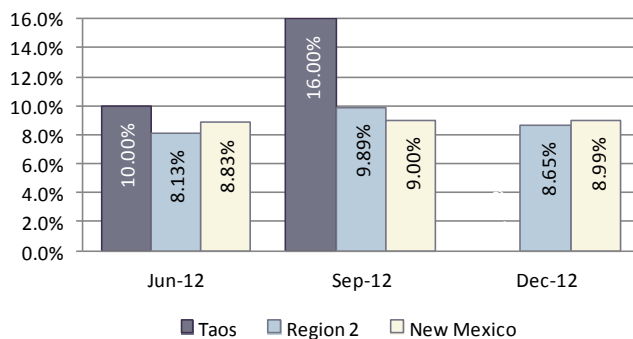

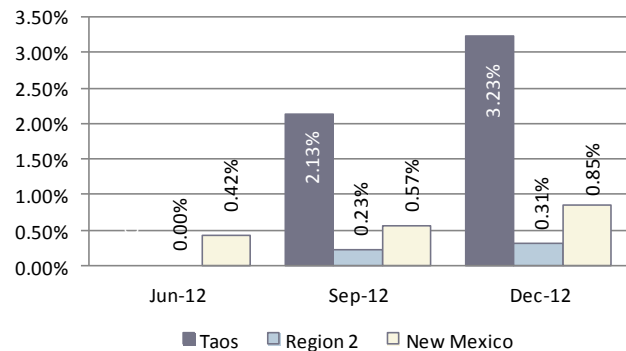

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

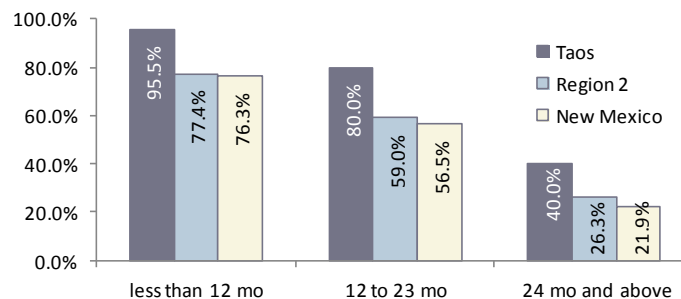


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%

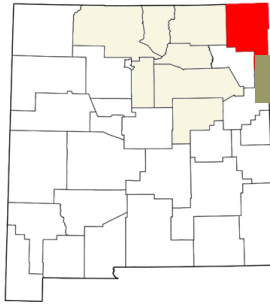


### Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System (AFCARS) Permanency Measures

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

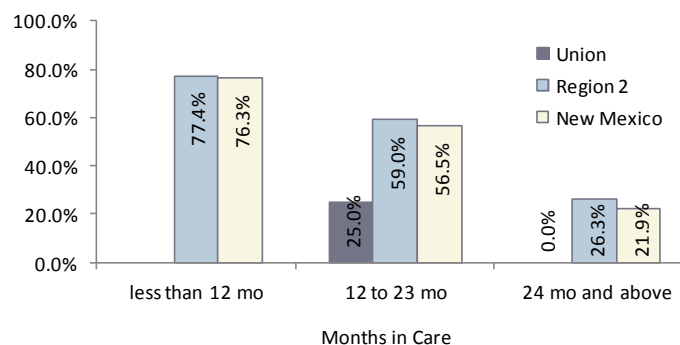

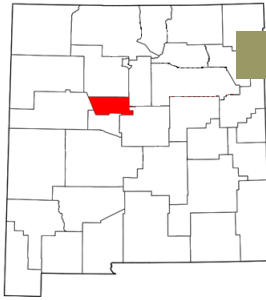

**Percent of Children With 2 or Fewer Placements For Period Ending 12/31/2012**



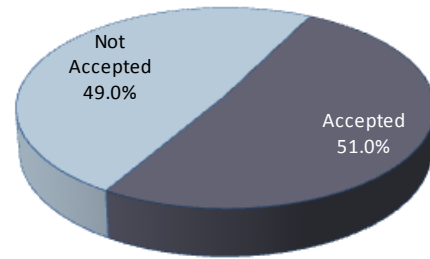

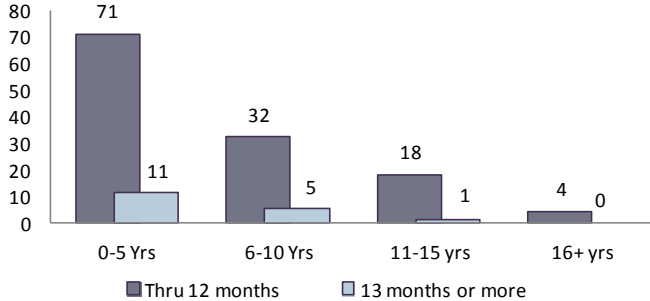
### CPS Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Bernalillo Qtr 2 SFY 13 October - December 2012 N = 2,762

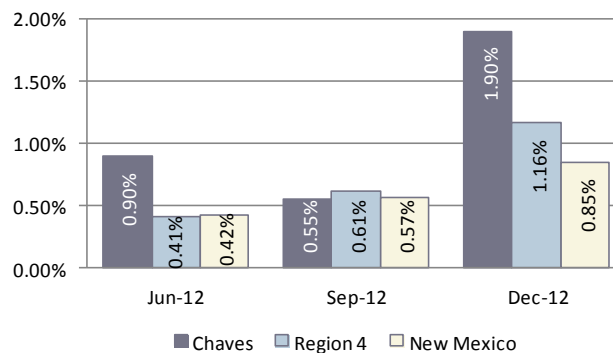

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

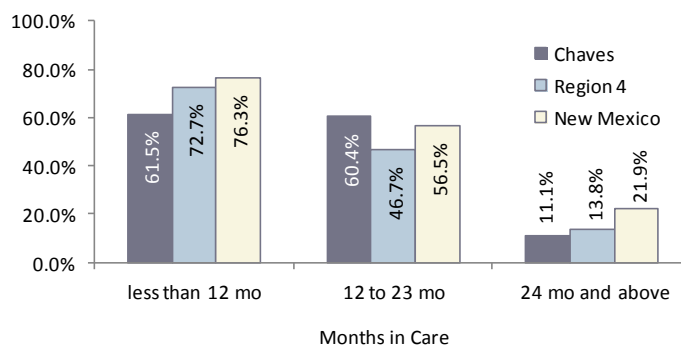


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%

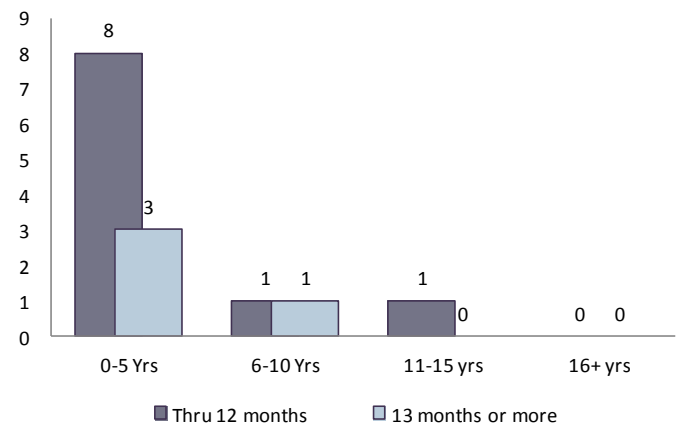


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

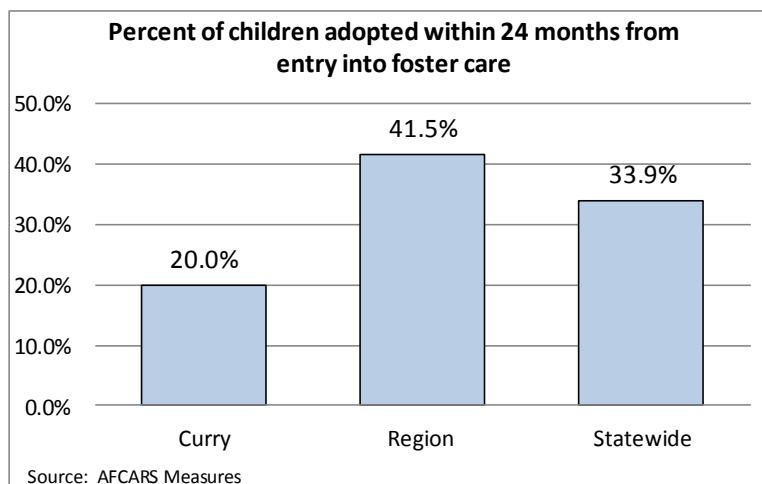

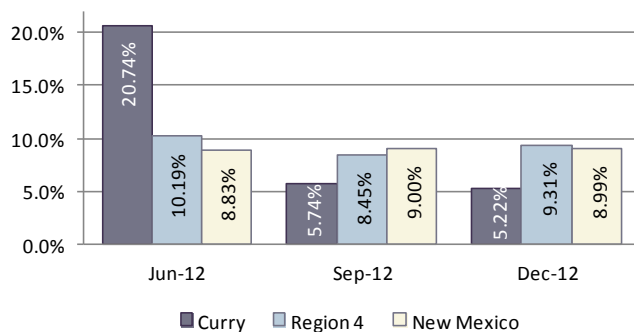

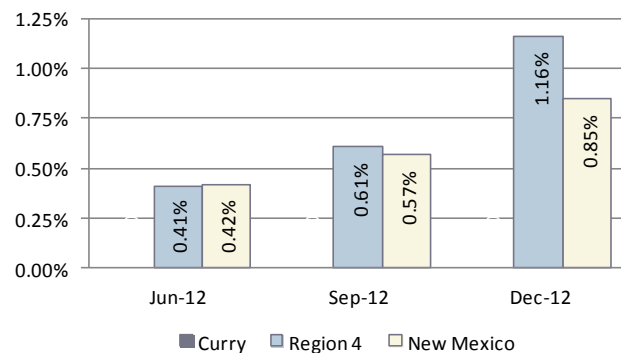

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

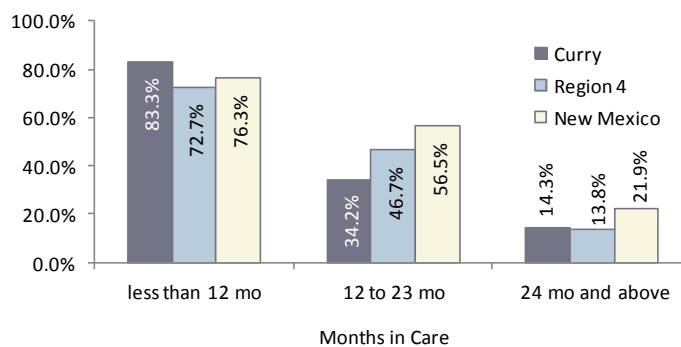

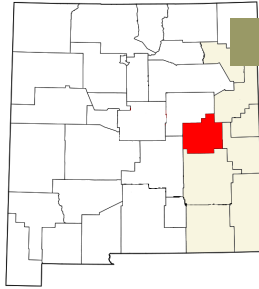

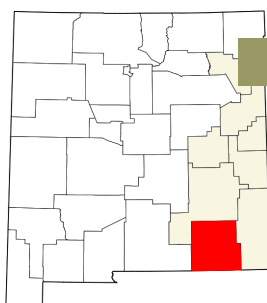

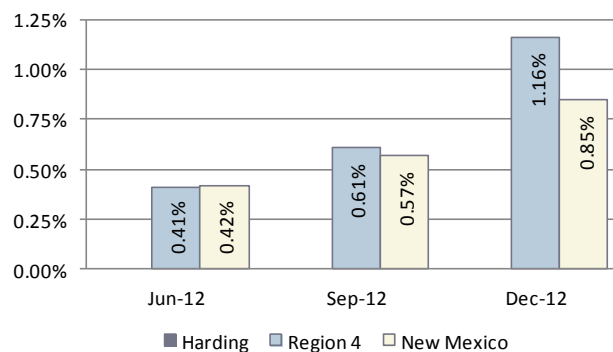

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

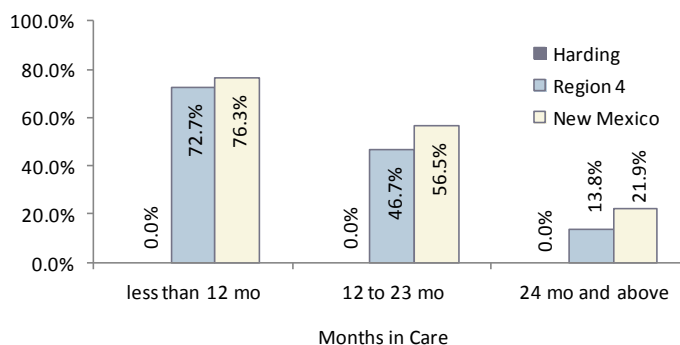


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

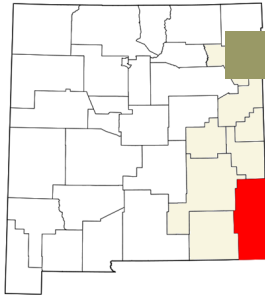

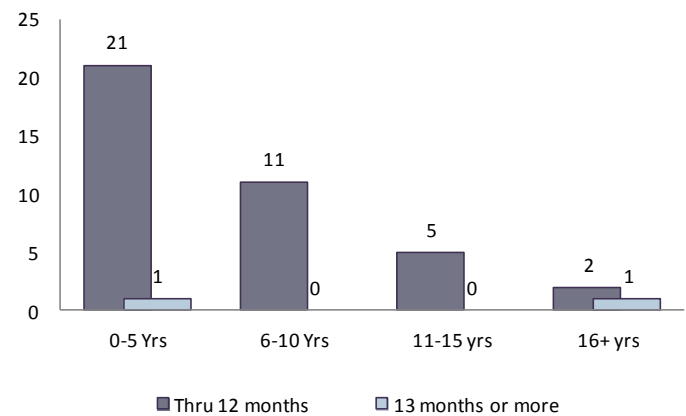


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

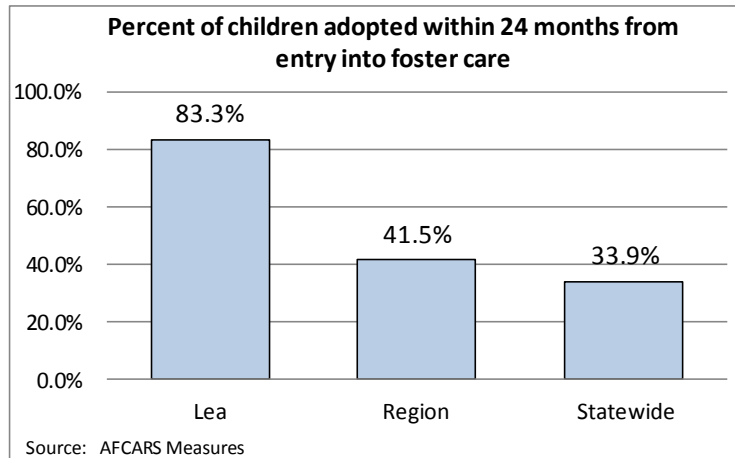

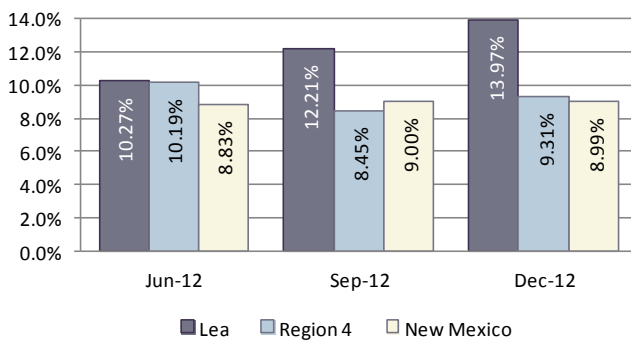

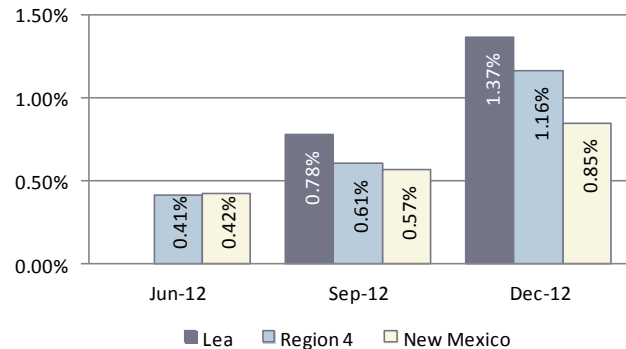

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

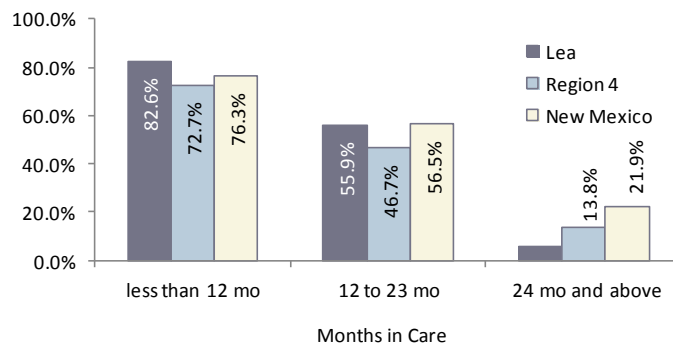


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%



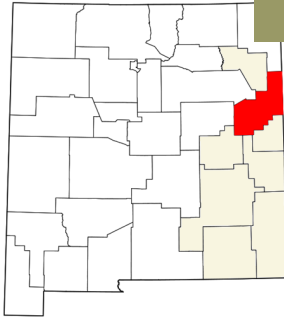

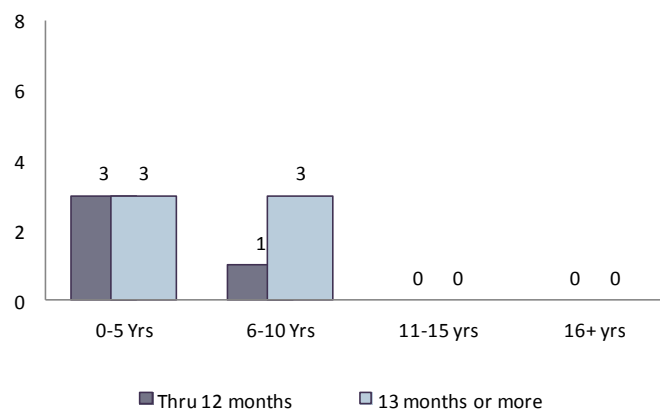


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

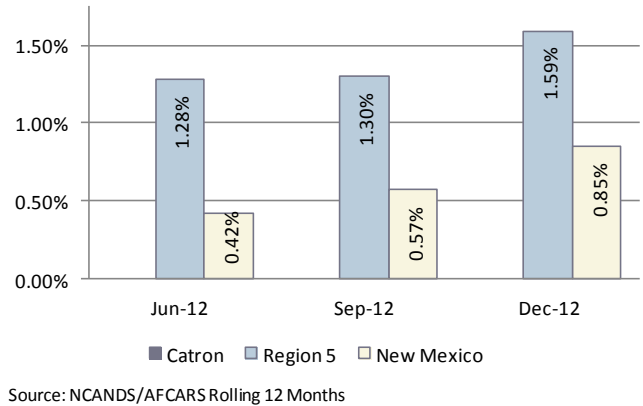

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment National Standard = 5.4%**

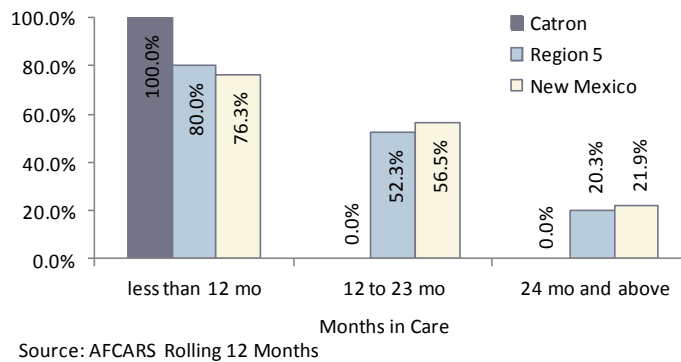


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**

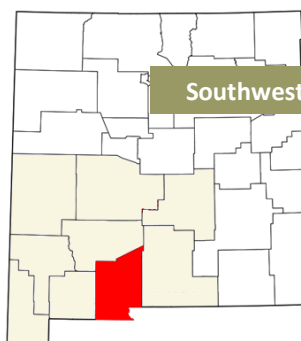


### Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System (AFCARS) Permanency Measures

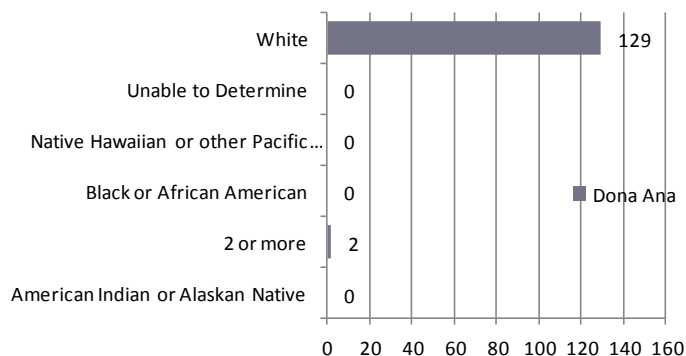

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

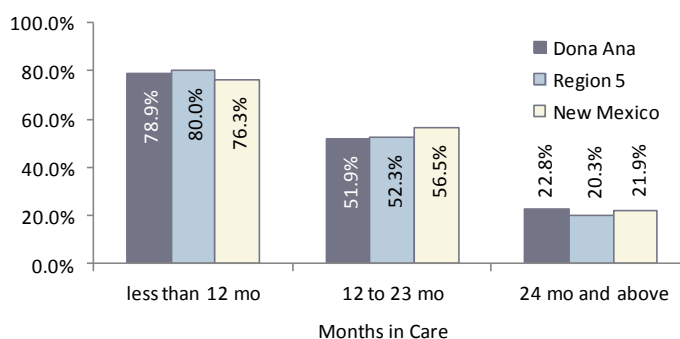


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%

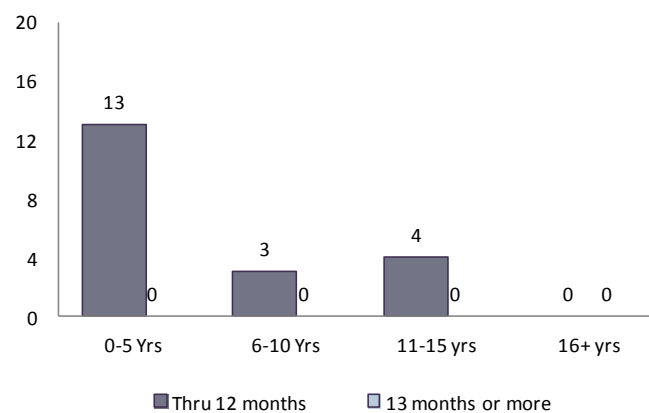


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

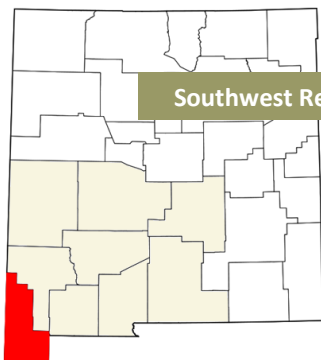

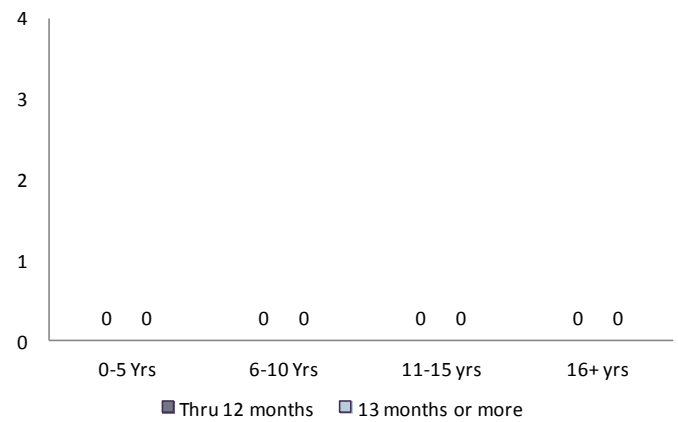


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

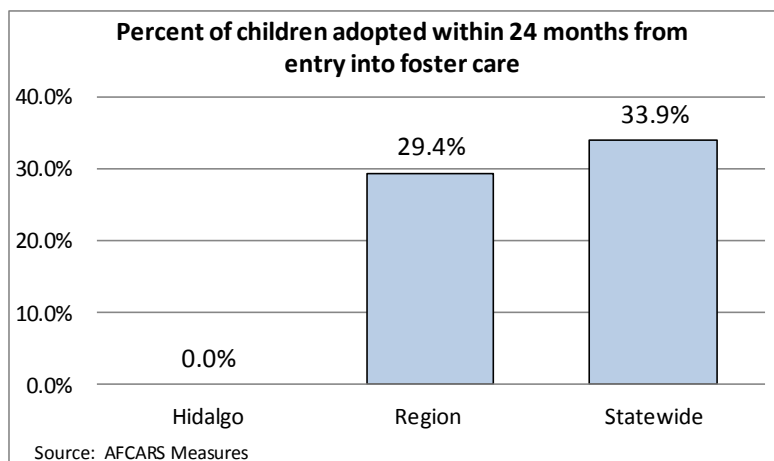

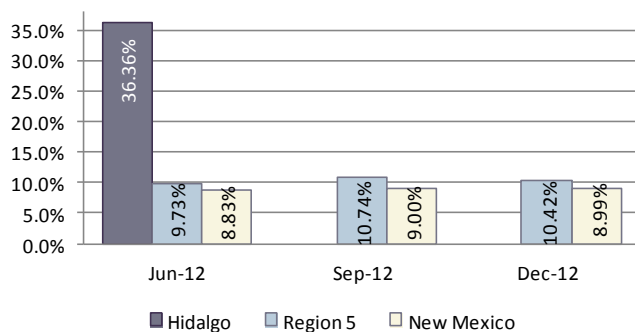

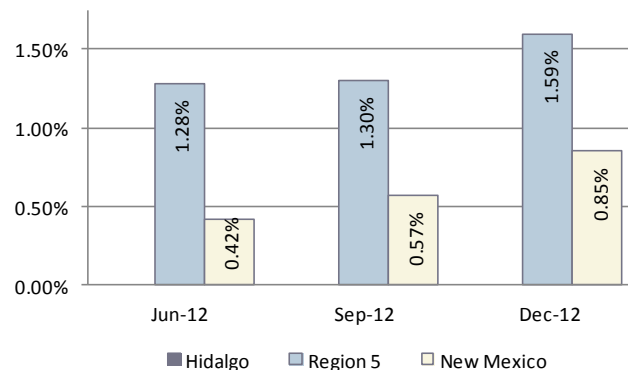

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

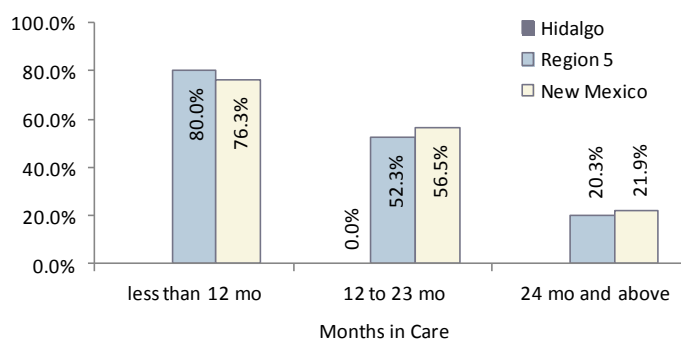


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%

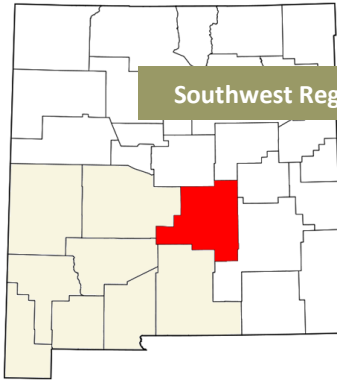

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

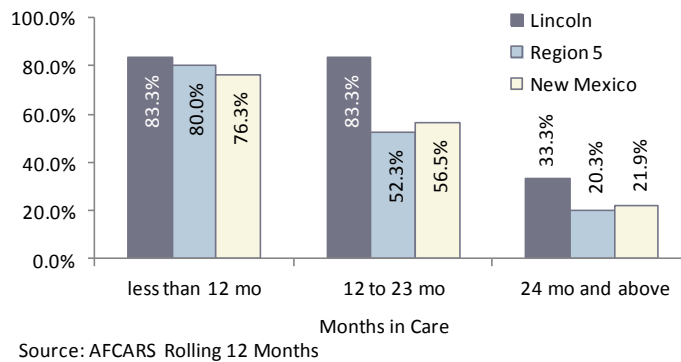

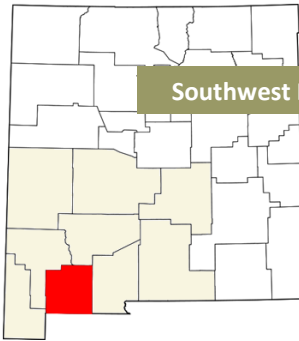

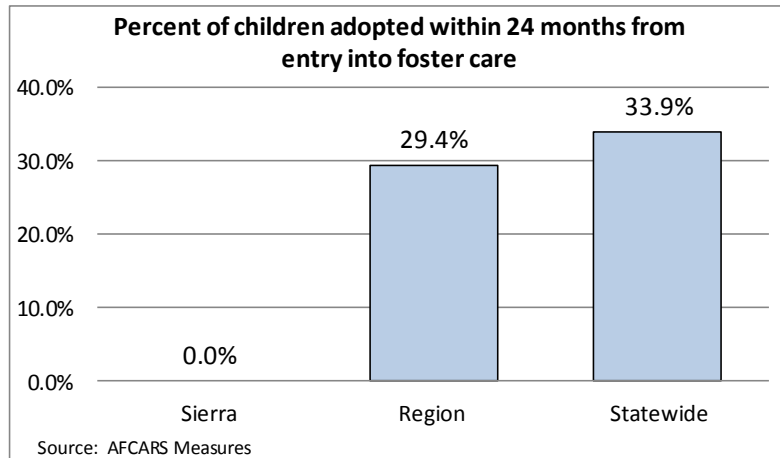
Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

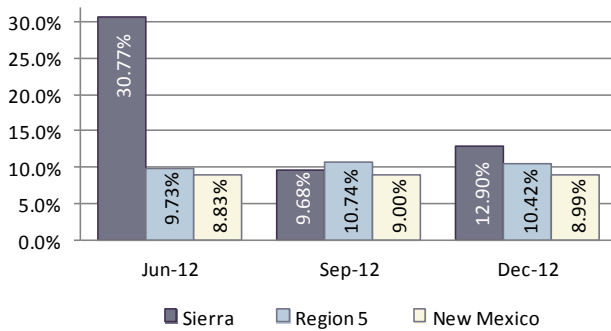

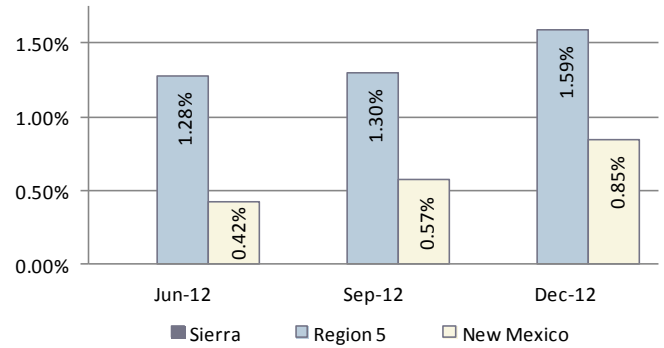


## National Child Abuse and Neglect Data System (NCANDS) Safety Measures

**Trends of Recurrence of Maltreatment Within 6 Months of a Previously Substantiated Report of Maltreatment** National Standard = 5.4%

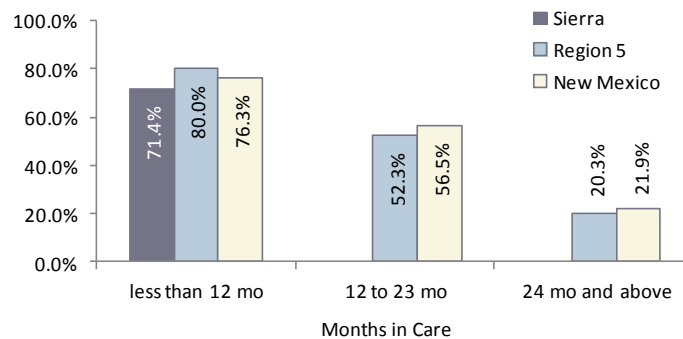


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care** National Standard = 0.32%

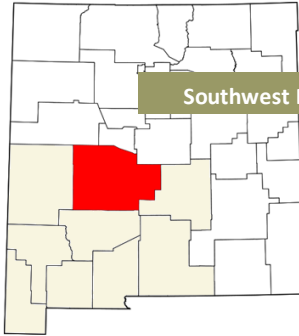


## Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System (AFCARS) Permanency Measures

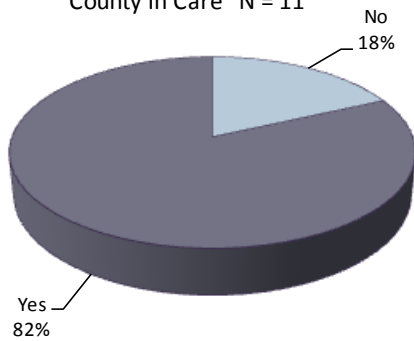

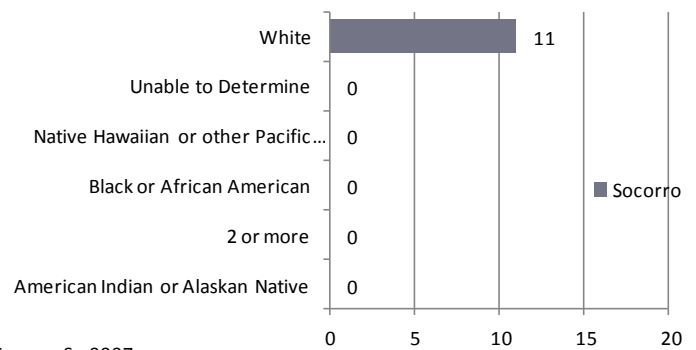

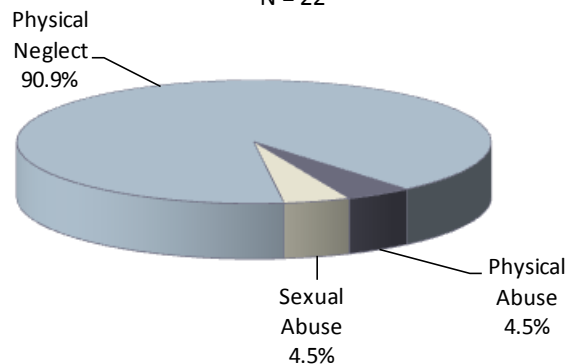
PS Investigations in Socorro

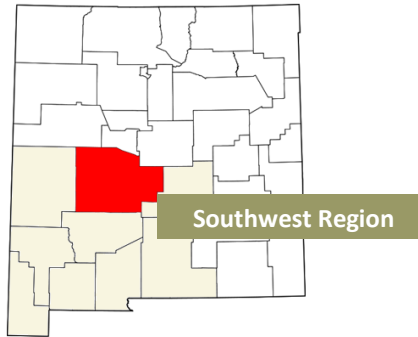

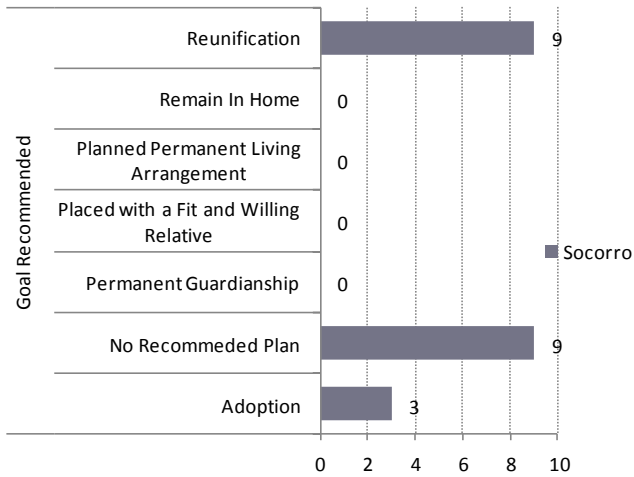

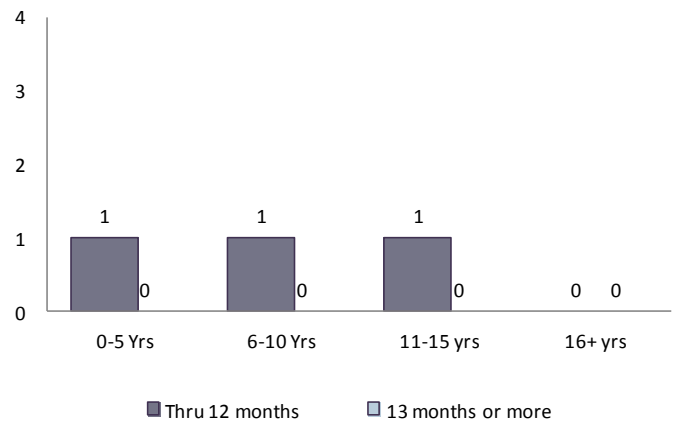


Permanency Plan Goals of Children In Custody

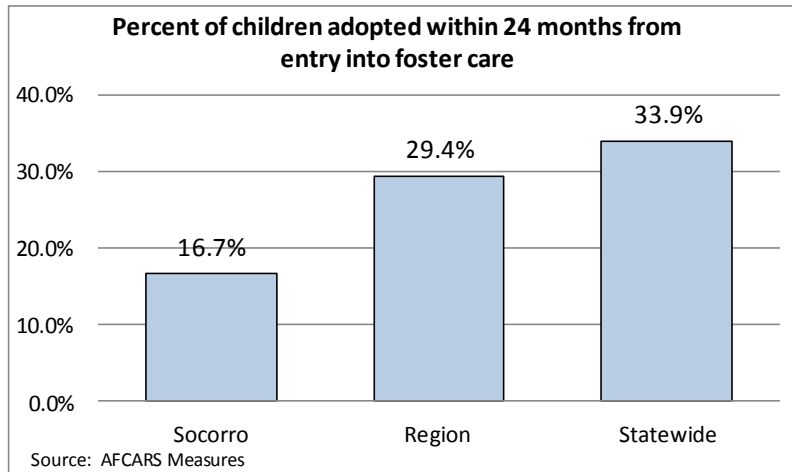

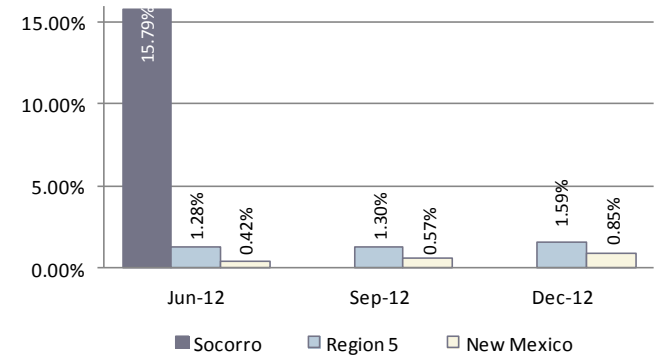


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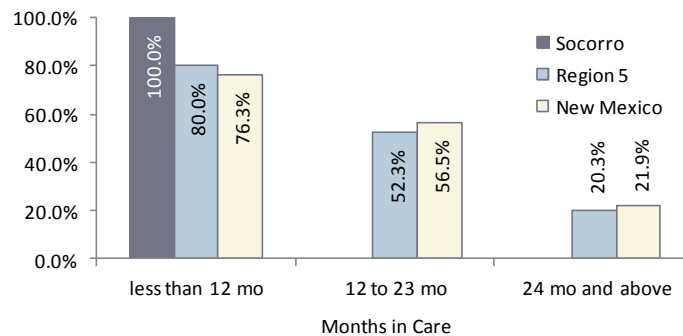


**Trends of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 0.32%**
